


Lesson 19 Joseph




1. Joseph Believed God.



- (Genesis 37:2-3)
- Jacob loved Joseph more than his other sons.
- Jacob gave Joseph a beautiful coat.
- (Gen. 37:4)
- Joseph's 10 older brothers were jealous and hated Joseph.




- (Genesis 37:5-10)
- God gave dreams to Joseph.
- God told Joseph that he would be great and save Israel (Joseph's family). Joseph believed and loved God.
- (Gen. 37:11)
- Joseph's brothers hated him more because of his dreams.




2. Joseph Was Persecuted (attacked).

(Genesis 37:12-35) Joseph's brothers sold Joseph into slavery.







(Genesis 39:1-23) Joseph was sold in Egypt to Potiphar, but Joseph did good and obeyed God.



(Genesis 39:1-23) Potiphar's wife lied against Joseph, and Joseph was put into prison.




3. God's Plan for Joseph Continued.




(Genesis 40)

While in prison, Joseph correctly told two of Pharaoh's (Egyptian King) servants the meaning of their dreams.




- (Genesis 41:1-8)
- God gave Pharaoh dreams. (Daniel 4:35)
- God is sovereign (king/control).
- None of Pharaoh's servants could tell Pharaoh the meaning of his dreams.
- Pharaoh and the Egyptians did not believe in God. Egypt worshipped idols.




(Genesis 41:14-16, 25-37)

- Joseph told Pharaoh the meaning of his dreams.
- Joseph told Pharaoh that God gave him the power to tell the meaning of dreams.



(Genesis 41:38-49) Joseph became ruler (2nd) in Egypt.


God kept His promises to Joseph.



(Genesis 42:1-20)

Joseph's brothers came into Egypt looking for food because there was a famine (no food/no rain) in all the land.

(Gen. 43:1-5, 11-17; 45:1-11) Joseph showed himself alive and ruler over Egypt.



- (Gen. 45:3)
- Joseph forgave his 10 older brothers.
- Joseph explained that this was God's plan; God is in control.

Joseph brought his family, Israel, to live in Egypt and gave them food.
