(Exodus 20:3)

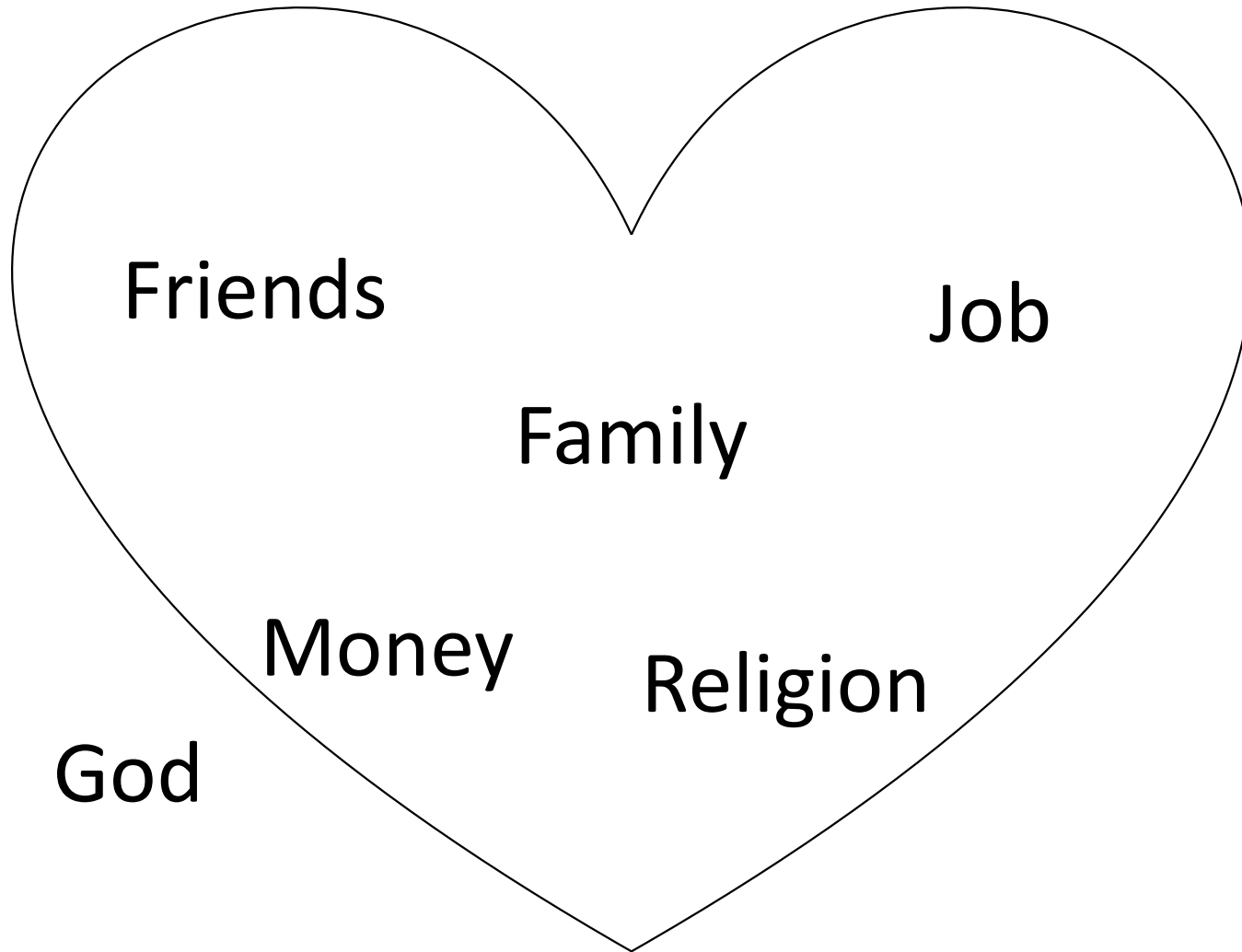
*“Thou shalt have no other gods before me (**God**).”*

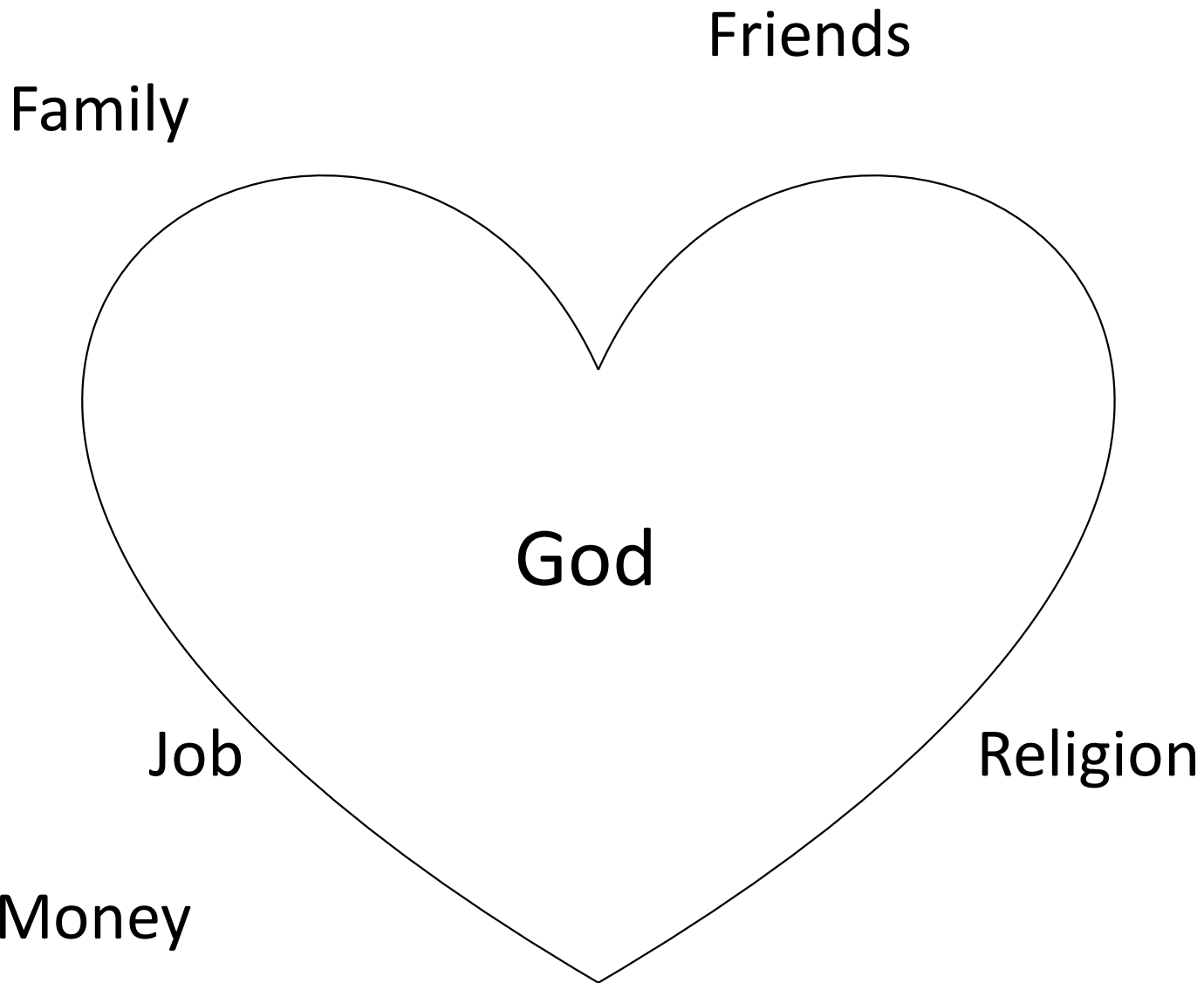
God only must be worshipped because:

1. God is only true and living God.
2. God is only Creator of all.
3. God is only King of all.

# The 2nd Commandment

(Exodus 20:4-6)

Do **NOT** make or worship idols.



# The 3<sup>rd</sup> Commandment

(Exodus 20:7)

God said Israel must NEVER speak God's name without honour.

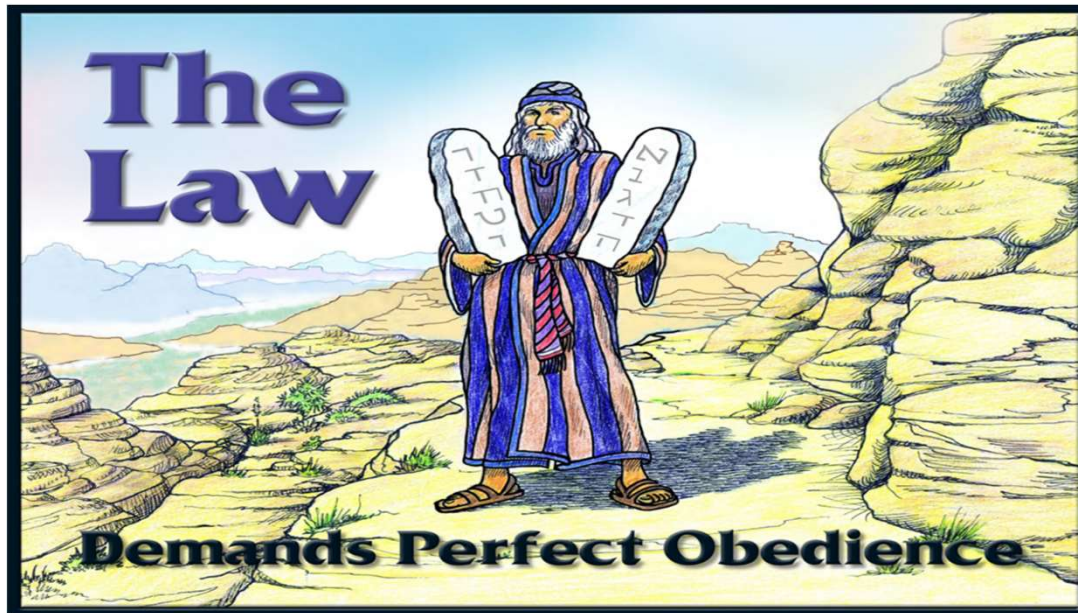




# The 4<sup>th</sup> Commandment

(Exodus 20:8-11)

God said Israel must have the Sabbath day (**Saturday**) as their rest day to show they were His special people.



# The 5<sup>th</sup> Commandment

(Exodus 20:12)

*“Honour thy father and thy mother.”*



# The 6<sup>th</sup> Commandment

(Exodus 20:13)

*“Thou shalt not kill.”*



# The 7<sup>th</sup> Commandment

(Exodus 20:14)

*“Thou shalt not commit (*do*) adultery.”*



God said **NO** sex with other person **NOT** your husband or wife.

# The 8<sup>th</sup> Commandment

(Exodus 20:15)

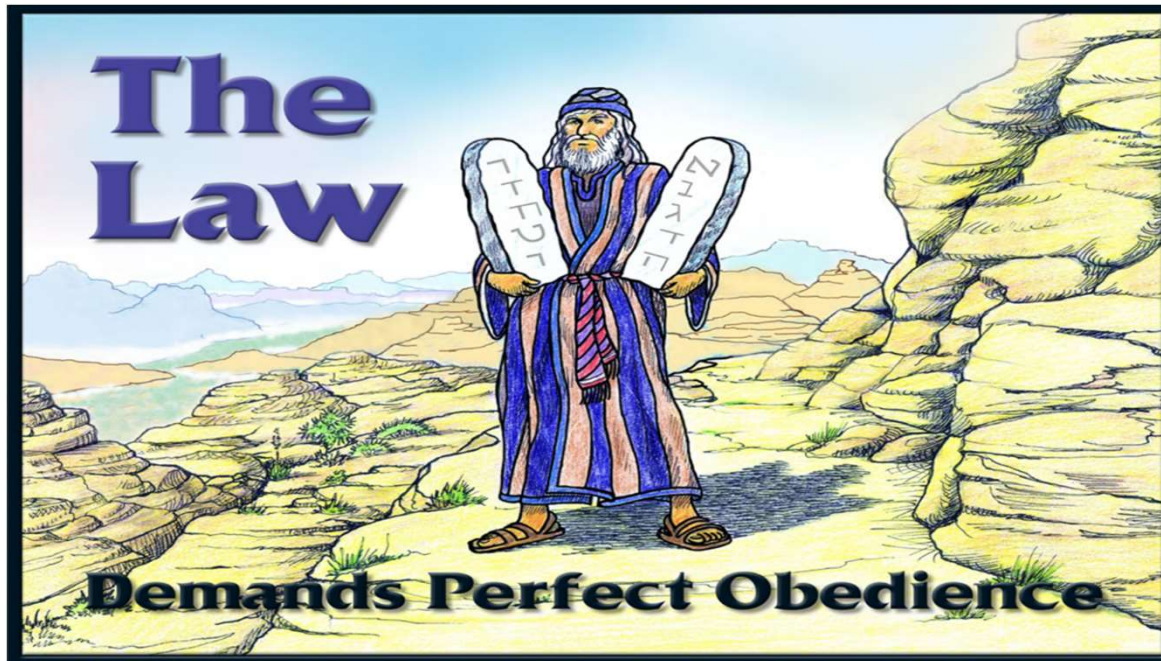
*“Thou shalt not steal.”*



# The 9<sup>th</sup> Commandment

(Exodus 20:16)

Do **not** speak lies about people.



# The 10<sup>th</sup> Commandment

(Exodus 10:17)

*“Thou shalt not covet (**want**) thy neighbour's house, ...wife, ...nor any thing that is thy neighbour's.”*

God said **NOT** want things other people have.  
We must be thankful; We must be content.

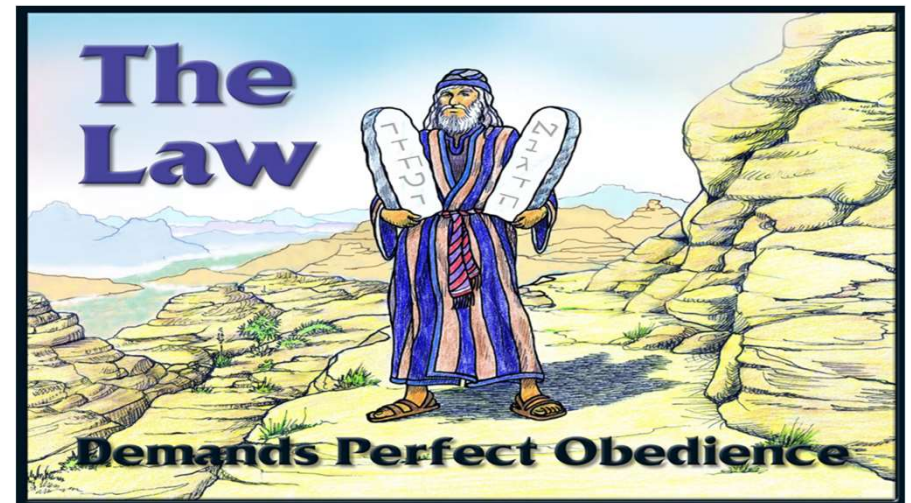
**NOT Thankful = covet**



# God's Commandments Show That All People Are Sinners.

God is the holy and righteous Judge.

God will not allow sin. God must punish sin.





(Romans 3:10-12)

As it is written (*Bible*), There is none (*no person*) **righteous, no, not one** (*person*): (11) There is none (*no person*) **that understandeth** (*knows God's way*), there is none (*no person*) **that seeketh** (*search*) **after God.** (12) They are all (*people*) gone out of the way (*wrong way*), they are together (*all people*) become unprofitable (*bad*); there is none (*no person*) **that doeth good, no, not one** (*person*).
