## God Saw a Difference Between Jacob and Esau.

(Gen. 25:19-34; Heb. 12:16-17; Rom. 9:13)



Jacob Belongs to God (Hebrews 12:16-17) <u>Lest</u> (so NOT happen) there be any fornicator (person—sex sin), or profane (worldly) person, as Esau, who for one <u>morsel</u> (piece) of <u>meat</u> (food) sold his <u>birthright</u> (inheritance). For ye know how that afterward (later), when he would (want) have inherited (received) the blessing, he was rejected: for *he* found no place (opportunity) of repentance, though he <u>sought</u> (asked for) it carefully with tears.

\* Esau did NOT believe God. ~Esau hated God's Word/Promises; God hated Esau. \* Jacob Yes believed God. ~Jacob loved God's Word/Promises; God loved Jacob.
