

God Saw a Difference Between Jacob and Esau.

(Gen. 25:19-34; Heb. 12:16-17; Rom. 9:13)



Jacob Belongs to God (Hebrews 12:16-17)

Lest (so NOT happen) there be any fornicator (person—sex sin), or profane (worldly) person, as **Esau**, **who** for one morsel (piece) of meat (food) sold **his** birthright (inheritance). For ye know how that afterward (later), when **he** would (want) have inherited (received) the blessing, **he** was rejected: for **he** found no place (opportunity) of repentance, though **he** sought (asked for) it carefully with tears.

* **Esau** did NOT believe God.

~Esau **hated** God's Word/Promises; God **hated** Esau.

* **Jacob** Yes believed God.

~Jacob **loved** God's Word/Promises; God **loved** Jacob.
