
# Lesson 48 Jesus Appeared to His Disciples; Jesus Ascended into Heaven


#### 1. Jesus Appeared to His Disciples.



(Mark 16:11-13)

When the women told the disciples that Jesus had risen from the dead, they did not believe them.

(Luke 24:12)
Peter and John ran to Jesus'
tomb and found it empty.




(Mark 16:14)

Jesus appeared to the disciples in a room.

(John 20:24-25)

One disciple—Thomas—was not there, and he missed Jesus.


\*Thomas did not believe that Jesus appeared to the other disciples.



(Mark 16:14)


After eight days, Jesus again

appeared to the disciples with Thomas there—
Thomas saw and believed.



(Lk. 24:36-43; Acts 1:1-3; 1 Cor. 15:5-7)

Jesus spent 40 days with His disciples and proved many times in different ways that He bodily rose from the dead... He was not only a spirit.



#### 2. Jesus Gave a Final Command to His Disciples.

(Mark 16:15)

Jesus commanded, Go into all the world and tell all people the Gospel (good news)—that Jesus died for their sins and rose from the dead.




#### 3. Jesus Ascended (went up) into Heaven.



(Mark 14:61-62)


Jesus said that He would return with glory as the Mighty King of kings.

\*Jesus first coming:

Born as a baby— died to save people from their sins.

\*Jesus second coming:

Come as the Mighty God.



## (Revelation 20:10-15) When Christ returns, non-believers will be cast into Hell.








(2 Peter 3:9)
