(The love of money, fame, pleasure...)



(Luke 12:15)

Jesus said, "Covetousness" = danger

Covetousness (greedy)

Always wanting / NOT thankful

NOT satisfied (content)

Many people focus (think) only on things in this life.

(Luke 12:16)

Jesus told parable (story) to teach the foolishness of thinking that money results in happiness and safety.




(Luke 12:16-21)

- *A rich man made plans to become greater and richer.
 - *The rich man made wrong <u>future</u> <u>plans...</u> focused on his own <u>pleasure</u> and <u>pride.</u>
 - *God planned for the rich man to die immediately (now).
- *God said the rich man was a fool... WHY?
- *Because the rich man <u>focused</u> on his own <u>pleasure</u> and <u>pride</u> and did <u>NOT focus</u> on <u>God.</u>




2. The Rich Man and Lazarus (poor man)



Jesus Told a Story About a rich man and a poor man (Lazarus).

(Luke 16:19-23)

The <u>rich man</u> looked very <u>happy</u>, and the <u>poor man</u> (<u>Lazarus</u>) looked very <u>sad</u>.



(Luke 16:22-23)

After death, Lazarus was taken to Heaven. Abraham was with Lazarus in Heaven.




A person's eternity is decided before the person dies; NOT after death.

(Hebrews 9:27)

*The rich man's <u>body</u> was <u>buried</u>, but his <u>spirit</u> went quickly to <u>Hell</u>.

*In Hell the rich man's money was NO help.



(Luke 6:24-25)

*In Hell the rich man <u>wanted</u> mercy and comfort.

*But when living the rich man did **NOT believe** God = **Hell**

*Lazarus believed God = Heaven





(Luke 16:26-28)

- *There is no escape from Hell.

 *Hell is forever.
- *In Hell people remember their life on earth.
- *The rich man wanted to <u>warn</u> (danger) his family about Hell.






(Luke 16:29)

- *People will not believe a person <u>risen from the dead</u> or an <u>angel</u>.
- *God has given the <u>Bible</u> for people to believe.
- *The <u>Bible</u> is <u>more important</u> than miracles and dreams.
- *People did not believe Jesus when Jesus raised Lazarus (different person) from the dead.
