




1. The Disciples Waited for the Holy Spirit.








(Acts 1:4-5)

Jesus commanded the disciples to wait in Jerusalem until they were baptized with the Holy Spirit.



(Acts 1:9, 12-14)

After Jesus' Ascension into Heaven, the disciples waited in Jerusalem and prayed together.



(Acts 2:1)

The disciples prayed together in Jerusalem on the **Day of Pentecost**.

Pentecost = 50 days after Passover (Crucifixion) **Pentecost** = 10 days after the Ascension



(Acts 2:2-3)

*As the disciples prayed, there was a sound from Heaven like a great wind.

*They saw like tongues of fire above one another's heads.



2. All the Believers Were Baptized (put into/joined) with the Holy Spirit.



(John 14:16-17)


Jesus promised that He would send the Holy Spirit to the disciples. Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would dwell inside the disciples.

- *Each believer (person) became the temple of God.
- *All the believers together (universal church) became the temple of God.
- *Each group (local church) of believers became the temple of God on earth.

God's first house on earth was the **Tabernacle**.



Then later God's house was the **Temple** in Jerusalem.



Now God's house is each local church.




The Church of the Lord Jesus Christ began on Pentecost (A.D. 30).

A.D. = <u>Anno Domini</u>, which means "in the year of our Lord."

- "Churches" = groups of called out people.

 *Churches have been called out
 (separated) from the world (Satan's family).
 - *Churches belongs to Jesus Christ.



3. All the Disciples Were controlled by the Holy Spirit.



(Acts 2:4)

The Holy Spirit gave the disciples the power to speak different languages.



4. The Disciples Spoke Different Languages.




(Acts 2:5-11)

- *Many Jews from all over the world came to Jerusalem for the Feast of Pentecost.

 *These Jews spoke
 - many different languages.
- *The Holy Spirit gave the disciples the power to speak in all the different language of these many Jews.

(Acts 1:8)

Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would give the disciples the power to be His witnesses in Jerusalem, Judaea, Samaria, and to all the world.




5. Some Jews Were Amazed; Some Jews Did Not Believe.



(Acts 2:7, 12)

The Jews thought how these disciples from Galilee knew so many different languages.




(Acts 2:13)

Local Jews did not understand all the foreign (other country) languages... They thought the believers were drunk.




6. Peter Preached to the People.



(Acts 2:14-15) Peter said the believers were NOT drunk.

(Acts 2:22) Peter reminded the people of Jesus' miracles.

(Acts 2:23) Peter Reminded them that the Jews rejected and crucified Jesus.



(Acts 2:24) Peter told the Jews that God had raised Jesus from the dead.

*Jesus had no sin...

Jesus had no penalty of death for Himself.

*Jesus died for our sins...

Jesus said, "It is finished."

*The payment for sin was finished... death has no more power.

*Therefore, Jesus rose from the dead.

(Acts 2:32) Peter said that the disciples were witnesses of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection and that Jesus is Saviour.

(Acts 2:33) Peter said Jesus had been

exalted by God.

Jesus is <u>liar</u> OR

Jesus is God, King, and Saviour

(Acts 2:36) Peter promised that all he said about what God and Jesus had done was true.

Jesus is Lord.


- *Jesus is the eternal Son of God.
- *Jesus conquered death by His resurrection.
- *All power in Heaven and Earth is given to Jesus
 - *Jesus is seated at right hand of Father in Heaven.

Peter said that the Jews should know that Jesus was their <u>Christ</u> (<u>chosen One</u> of God to save them).


Jesus is Christ

*Jesus is the greatest Prophet of God

- --shows God and teaches truly about God
- *Jesus is the great High Priest
- --gave His own blood to pay for our sins
- *Jesus is the great King
- -- Jesus is King of kings and Lord of lords



7. Many of the Jews Believed that Jesus Was Their Saviour.



(John 16:7-11) Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would convict all people of sin, righteousness, and judgment.

Sin = The <u>sin</u> is **rejecting Jesus**, who alone takes away sin.

Righteousness = The proof of right is **Jesus' resurrection.**

Judgment = The judgment is Satan
lost... also ALL with Satan lost.

(Acts 2:37-40)

The Jews asked, "What to do?!"

(38) Then Peter said unto them, <u>Repent</u> (<u>change</u>), and **be baptized...**

(41) 3,000 Jews believed in Jesus and were saved.
