God Saw a Difference Between <u>Moses</u> and the <u>Egyptians</u>. (Exodus 2; Heb. 11:24-27)



Moses Belongs to God (Hebrews 11:24-26) By faith Moses, when he was come to years (grown-age adult), refused (no) to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; Choosing rather (different) to suffer affliction (hurt) with the people of God, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season (short time); Esteeming (thinking) the reproach (shame) of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence (pay) of the reward. [see Rom. 6:23]

(Heb. 11:27) By faith <u>he</u> (Moses) <u>forsook</u> (left) Egypt, not fearing the <u>wrath</u> (anger) of the king: for <u>he</u> <u>endured</u> (continued), as seeing <u>him who</u> (God) is <u>invisible</u> (not seen).

*The Egyptians did NOT believe God. ~Egyptians chose to enjoy the pleasures of this world and to live fearing kings and gods they could see. *Moses YES believed God. ~Moses chose to suffer with God's people (Israel) and to live fearing the Invisible God.
