

God Saw a Difference Between

Moses and the **Egyptians.**

(Exodus 2; Heb. 11:24-27)



Moses Belongs to God (Hebrews 11:24-26)

By faith **Moses**, when **he** was come to years (**grown—age adult**), refused (**no**) to be called the **son of Pharaoh's daughter**;

Choosing rather (**different**) to suffer affliction (**hurt**) with the **people of God**, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season (**short time**); Esteeming (**thinking**) the reproach (**shame**) of **Christ** greater riches than the **treasures in Egypt**: for **he** had respect unto the recompence (**pay**) of the reward. [**see Rom. 6:23**]

(Heb. 11:27) *By faith he (Moses) forsook (left) Egypt, not fearing the wrath (anger) of the king: for he endured (continued), as seeing him who (God) is invisible (not seen).*

*The **Egyptians** did NOT believe God.

~Egyptians chose to enjoy the pleasures of this world and to live fearing kings and gods they could see.

***Moses** YES believed God.

~Moses chose to suffer with God's people (Israel) and to live fearing the Invisible God.
