


1. God Gave a Son to Abraham and Sarah.

(Genesis 21:1-3)


God completed His promise to Abraham and Sarah by giving them a son.

They named their son Isaac.




2. God Commanded Abraham to Sacrifice Isaac.

in Isaac would not fail.




(Genesis 22:6-8)

(Heb. 11:6)


Abraham believed God would provide a sacrifice.



(Genesis 22:9-10)


Abraham put Isaac on the altar

to sacrifice him to God.




4. God Gave a Ram (male sheep) Instead (trade) Isaac.

(Genesis 22:10-13)
God told Abraham,
"Stop! Don't kill Isaac.
You have proved that
you fear (love/obey) Me."



5. Abraham Believed That God Would Send Saviour (Jesus).




(Genesis 22:14)

And Abraham called the name of that place **Jehovahjireh**:

"Jehovah" = LORD

"Jireh" = provide



"Jehovahjireh" = The Lord will provide

(Genesis 22:15-18)

And in thy seed (Jesus)
shall all the nations
(people) of the earth be
blessed; because thou
hast obeyed my voice.

God promised to send Jesus through Isaac.
