(Rev. 1:1) The <u>Revelation</u> (open—show) of <mark>Jesus Christ...</mark> (11) What thou (John) seest, write in a book, and send it unto the <u>seven churches</u> which are in Asia; unto **Ephesus**, and unto **Smyrna**, and unto **Pergamos**, and unto **Thyatira**, and unto **Sardis**, and unto **Vergamos**, and unto **Christia**, and **Christia**,

(Rev 1:19) Write the things which thou hast seen, and <u>the things which are</u>, and the things which shall be hereafter;

\*All that John sees/hears is to be given to each of the seven churches, but there is also a specific message (2-3) for each church.

\*Chapters 2-3 are *"the things which are"* (Church Age) and is a description of the various churches now.

### **1. The Church of Ephesus**



(Rev 2:1) Unto the angel of the church of Ephesus [John] write; These things saith he that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks;

\*<u>Jesus></u> gives each ><u>angel></u> a message for a specific church to give to ><u>John></u> to write and send to that ><u>church</u>.

\*Jesus sends His messengers/angels (stars)

\*Jesus is with His churches (candlesticks)



(Rev 2:2) *I know thy works* (doings), and thy labour (hard work), and thy patience (not quit), and how thou canst not <u>bear</u> (accept) them which are evil: and thou hast tried (tested) them which say they are apostles, and are **not**, and hast found them liars: (3) And hast borne (accept work), and hast patience, and for my name's sake (goal) hast laboured, and hast not fainted (quit).

\*The <mark>church of Ephesus</mark> tested the words of the false <mark>apostles</mark> with the words of the <mark>true</mark> apostles. The <mark>Holy Spirit</mark> led the <mark>church of Ephesus</mark> to gather the 27 Books of the N.T. keeping all that was written by <mark>Christ's</mark> true <mark>apostles</mark> and rejecting all that was written by false <mark>apostles</mark>. (Rev 2:4) Nevertheless (but) / have somewhat against thee, because thou hast left thy first love [NO heart— NO excited feeling adoring Jesus]. (5) **Remember** therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent (change thinking), and **do** the first works; or else *I* will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place [no more light, no more witness, no more true church], except thou repent.


- 1. **Remember** the Joy and Peace you are missing.
- 2. **Repent** (change) your <u>priorities</u> (important list).
- 3. Do love the Lord with all your heart, mind, and strength

(Rev 2:6) But this thou hast [good], that thou hatest the deeds (doings) of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.

# "Nicolaitans" = Rule over people

[Greek]

- "Nico" = Conquer—rule
- "Laity" = The people



# "Nicolaitans"


#### The Hierarchy of the Roman Catholic Church



"Nicolaitans" do opposite of Bible teaching for church leaders (1 Peter 5:1) The elders (pastors) which are among you (church) (Peter) exhort, who (Peter) am also an elder, and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, and also a partaker (share) of the glory that shall be revealed: (2) Feed the <mark>flock</mark> of <mark>God</mark> which is among you, taking the oversight (care) thereof, not by constraint (force), but willingly (free); not for filthy *lucre* (money), but of a ready mind (happy want); (3) Neither as being lords (kings) over God's heritage (Own), but being ensamples (guide) to the flock.

(Rev 2:7) *He* that hath an ear, let him hear what the *Spirit* saith unto the churches; To him that <u>overcometh</u> (wins—by faith) will *I* give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the <u>paradise</u> (beautiful place [Heaven]) of God.

"overcometh" = our faith in Jesus gives us the victory and life eternal—Heaven [1 John 5:4-5].



# 2. The Church in Smyrna



(Rev 2:8) And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;

\*<mark>Jesus</mark> is in control of all.

\*Jesus knows the pains of death and has power over death.



(Rev 2:9) *I know thy works, and <u>tribulation</u> (trouble), and poverty (poor), (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy* (bad talk) of them which say they are Jews, and are **not**, but are the <u>synagogue</u> (group) of Satan.

\*Some liars said that their group (Jews) truly belonged to God.

God said, "No, the <mark>church</mark> is <mark>mine</mark>, these <mark>liars</mark> belong to <mark>Satan's group</mark>." (Rev 2:10) Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be <u>tried</u> (tested); and ye shall have tribulation <u>ten days</u> (short time): be thou faithful unto death, and will give thee a crown of life.

\*Satan uses this world to attack Christians.

\*God comforts by saying that these persecutions will not continue a long time, and that there is a **reward** to Christians that are faithful, even those who die for Jesus' sake.

(Rev 2:11) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that <u>overcometh</u> (wins—by faith) shall not be hurt of the <u>second death</u> (eternal death in Lake of Fire).

\*Christians have some hurt now for a short time in the world.

\*The world that rejects Jesus will have eternal hurt.

### 3. The Church in Pergamos



(Rev 2:12) And to the angel of the <mark>church in Pergamos</mark> write; These things saith <mark>he which</mark> hath the sharp sword with two edges;

\*Jesus' Word destroys and condemns Satan's liars and lies.



(Rev 2:13) / know thy works, and where thou <u>dwellest</u> (stay), even where Satan's <u>seat</u> (place of power) is: and thou <u>holdest fast</u> (keep strong) my name, and hast not <u>denied</u> (say, "not know") my faith, even in those days <u>wherein</u> (happen) Antipas was my faithful **martyr**, who was <u>slain</u> (killed) among you, where Satan dwelleth.

\*Satan's power is very strong in places. Faithful Christians witnessing in these places sometimes are killed. Antipas was a famous Christian witness (martyr), who was killed in a place where Satan had great power.

(Rev 2:14) But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that <u>hold</u> (keep) the <u>doctrine</u> (teaching) of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a <u>stumblingblock</u> (tempt to fall) before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to <u>commit</u> (do) <u>fornication</u> (sexual sin).

\*Balaam was a false prophet that taught to **mix** the worship of God with the worship of idols; to **mix** God's way and Satan's way. ...**NOT** Holy (Rev 2:15) So hast thou also them that hold the <u>doctrine</u> (teaching) of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate. (16) Repent; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

\*Nicolaitans taught that some men in the church should rule over all other men.

God hates this teaching, but the Pergamos church failed to hate it.

\*It is shameful for a church to fail to reject false teaching. It is a shame for a church when Jesus must use others to rebuke an erring church with the Bible (the sword of my mouth).

(Rev 2:17) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; To him that <u>overcometh</u> (wins by faith) will I give to eat of the hidden manna (bread), and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth <u>saving</u> (only knows) he that receiveth <u>it</u> (stone).

*"hidden manna"* and *"white stone"* = close fellowship with Jesus



### 4. The Church in <u>Thyatira</u>



(Rev 2:18) And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet are like fine brass;

\*Jesus is the wise judge. He sees through the hypocrisy of "good works" and "love".



(Rev 2:19) <mark>I</mark> know thy works, and <u>charity</u> (love), and service, and faith, and thy patience, and thy works; and <u>the last to be more than the first</u> (meek).

\*The church was meek, busy, showing love to many people. This is all very good. (Rev 2:20) <u>Notwithstanding</u> (but) I have a few things against thee, because thou <u>sufferest</u> (allow) that woman Jezebel, which calleth herself a prophetess, to teach and to <u>seduce</u> (tempt) my servants to commit (do) <u>fornication</u> (spiritual adultery), and to eat things sacrificed unto idols.

(1 Kings 16:31-33; 19:1-2; 21:7-16)

\*Jezebel was a wicked queen of Israel. She encouraged King Ahab and all Israel to do the sin of idolatry.

\*\* Same any person encouraging the church to follow Satan's lies.


(Rev 2:21) And I gave her space (time) to repent of her fornication (spiritual adultery); and she repented not. (22) Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they repent of their deeds. (23) And I will kill her <mark>children</mark> with death; and all the <mark>churches</mark> shall know that I am he which searcheth the reins (mind) and hearts: and I will give unto every one of you according to your works.

(1 Kings 18-19; 2 Kings 9-10)

\*All that go Jezebel's way and do idolatry, God will "kill" same as Elijah and Jehu killed all Jezebel's false prophets and family. (Rev 2:24) But unto you I say, and unto the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the <u>depths</u> (deep filth) of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden. (25) But that which ye have <u>already</u> (finished) <u>hold</u> <u>fast</u> (keep strong) till I come.

(1 Kings 19:14-18) \*Even if <mark>we</mark> are <mark>few</mark> as <mark>Elijah</mark> thought, and <mark>Jezebel's group</mark> is many, we must continue faithful. (Rev 2:26) And he that overcometh (wins by faith), and keepeth my works unto the end [end of life on earth], to him will I give power over the nations: [1,000 year rule of Jesus on earth—Jesus had made us kings and priests unto God] (27) And he shall rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father. (28) And I will give him the morning star (Jesus). (29) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

\*Jesus gives Himself and all that He has to His people. We will rule with Jesus.



# 5. The Church in Sardis



(Rev 3:1a) And unto the angel of the <mark>church in Sardis</mark> write; These things saith <mark>he</mark> that hath the seven Spirits of God, and the <u>seven stars</u> [angels];

\*<mark>Jesus</mark> gives the Holy Spirit, Who</mark> makes life with the Word of God.

\*Jesus sends His messengers ("seven stars" [angels]) bringing His Word, Which makes alive.



(Rev 3:1b) <mark>I</mark> know <mark>thy</mark> works, that <mark>thou</mark> hast a name that <mark>thou</mark> <u>livest</u>, and <u>art dead</u>.

\*The church had a great history—*"a name that thou livest"* ! They had the Word of God and before they used It.

\*They had received much, but now they were in danger of losing all because they were lazy—spiritually asleep—"dead".



(Rev 3:2) Be watchful (awake), and strengthen (make strong) the things which remain (spiritual life), that are <u>ready</u> (soon) **to die**: for <mark>I</mark> have not found thy works perfect before God. (3) Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard [God's Word], and hold fast (keep strong), and repent. If therefore thou shalt not watch, *I will come on thee as a thief, and thou* shalt not know what hour *I* will come upon thee.

\*The Word of God must be used for spiritual life to remain strong. \*A sleeping church is useless for Jesus and will be surprised by its end. (Rev 3:4) Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not <u>defiled</u> (made dirty) their <u>garments</u> (clothes); and they shall walk with me in <u>white</u> [clothes]: for they are <u>worthy</u> (good).

\*No one in this world—dirty with sin—should think they can please God or serve Him.

\*Only those with "white garments"—washed in the Blood of the Lamb (Jesus)—are acceptable to Jesus. They can now and forever be in His service and fellowship.

\*Also, the Word of God when used is as water to help us keep our lives clean. (Rev 3:5) *He* that <u>overcometh</u> (wins by faith), the <u>same</u> shall be clothed in white raiment; and <mark>I</mark> will not <u>blot</u> (remove) out his name out of the book of life, but <u>I</u> will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. (6) *He* that hath an ear, let him hear what the <u>Spirit</u> saith unto the <u>churches</u>.

\*Only with an invitation from Jesus and the white raiment provided by Jesus can we enter Heaven. Jesus will declare ("*confess*") to all, we belong to Him.

\*All are invited to come to Heaven, all have their names written as guests in the *"book of life"*, however if you refuse Jesus' invitation and refuse His white raiment, your name will be removed (*"blotted"*) from the *"book of life"*.



## 6. The Church in Philadelphia



(Rev 3:7a) And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true,

\*Jesus as God is perfectly **holy** (above / separate). >No one and nothing is like Jesus / God.

\*Jesus as God is perfectly **true** (original). >Jesus is the only true God. All truth is from Jesus.



(Rev 3:7b) ... *he* that hath the <u>key of David</u> [Isa. 22:22], <u>he</u> that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

\*Jesus, having the "*key of David*", has the power/right to rule the Kingdom of Israel—God's kingdom on earth.

\*As God's chosen king, Jesus even now has all authority (power) and has given the Great Commission (command) (Mat. 28:18-20)—The command to preach the Gospel to all nations of the world.



(Rev 3:8) I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.

\*Jesus opens the doors of the nations that the Gospel may be spread, and <mark>His</mark> Kingdom increased, and <mark>Jesus</mark> has made possible for all people to have entry into <mark>His</mark> eternal Kingdom.

\*We don't need much strength we just need to be faithful to the Word of God and faithfully proclaim that Jesus is Lord / King. This is the Mission of the <mark>churches</mark>. (Rev 3:9) Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship (humble / show respect) before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee.

\*The Jews were against the early churches, but truly Satan was using the Jews against the early churches.

\*"*and are not*" = <mark>Jesus</mark> said that <mark>Jews</mark>, <mark>which</mark> refused <mark>Him</mark>, were no more <mark>His</mark> chosen people</mark>.

\*At Christ's Second Coming, all these <mark>false Jews</mark> would be forced to confess that the churches are God's chosen people.

\*(Isaiah 60:14) After the Second Coming, the nations of the world will confess that Israel is God's chosen nation. But those Jews (Israelites) that have rejected Jesus will themselves confess that the Church is the "Israel of God" and NOT they (Galatians 6:16). (Rev 3:10) Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I also will keep thee from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try (trouble) them that dwell upon the earth. (11) Behold, I come quickly: <u>hold that fast</u> (stay faithful) which thou hast, that no man take thy <u>crown</u> (reward).

\*Jesus will preserve His Church from the Great Tribulation and from all judgment. \*ALL the world will endure the wrath of Jesus as He troubles the rebels, who remain in the earth, after the Rapture.

\*Now the churches are encouraged to remain faithful that they can be rewarded.

(Rev 3:12) *Him* that overcometh (wins by faith in Jesus) will <mark>I</mark> make a <mark>pillar</mark> in the <u>temple</u> of <mark>my</mark> God, and he shall go no more out: and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my **God**, which is new Jerusalem, which cometh down out of heaven from my God: and I will write upon <mark>him</mark> my new name. (13) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the <mark>Spirit</mark> saith unto the <mark>churches</mark>.

\*Believers from every nation of the world will forever belong to God—known as God's own.

## 7. The Church in Laodicea



(Rev 3:14) And unto the angel of the <mark>church of the Laodiceans</mark> write; These things saith the <u>Amen</u>, the <u>faithful and true</u> <u>witness</u>, the <u>beginning of the</u> <u>creation of God</u>;

\*"*Amen"* A Hebrew word translated in the O.T. as "*Truth*". Jesus is the Truth.

\*Jesus told the truth about the church.

\*"beginning" [Greek =  $\frac{\text{arche}}{\text{arche}}$ ] =  $\frac{\text{cause}}{\text{cause}}$  (start) and  $\frac{\text{ruler}}{\text{ruler}}$  of all God's Creation.



(Rev 3:15) *I* know thy works, that thou art neither cold nor hot: *I* would thou wert cold or hot. (16) So then because thou art <u>lukewarm</u> (medium temperature), and neither cold nor hot, *I* will <u>spue</u> (spit) thee out of my mouth.

\*Jesus said the church had a bad taste. \*Jesus rejected the church because He could NOT enjoy it. (Rev 3:17) Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art <u>wretched</u> (bad), and <u>miserable</u> (sad), and poor, and blind, and <u>naked</u> (shameful):

\*This church was a proud church believing lies about its greatness. >They trusted in themselves, were comfortable, and felt independent.

\*Jesus told them the truth: they were spiritually poor and shameful.

(Rev 3:18) <u>*i*</u> <u>counsel</u> (teach) thee to buy of <u>me</u> gold <u>tried</u> (become pure) in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and <u>anoint</u> (put on) thine eyes with <u>eyesalve</u> (eye medicine), that thou mayest see. (19) As <u>many</u> as <u>*i*</u> love, <u>*i*</u> <u>rebuke and chasten</u> (strictly teach): be <u>zealous</u> (busy) therefore, and repent.

\*All true spiritual riches come from <mark>Jesus</mark> and are given freely (Isaiah 55:1). All we need is provided by <mark>Jesus</mark> by <mark>His</mark> death on the Cross.

\*Our responsibility is to quickly trust and obey Jesus.

(Rev 3:20) *Behold, I stand at the door* [your heart], and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, <mark>I</mark> will come in to him, and will <u>sup</u> (eat) with him, and he with me. (21) To him that <u>overcometh</u> (win by faith in Jesus) will *I* grant to sit with me in my throne, even as a lass overcame (win by faith in the Father's will), and am set down with my Father in his throne. (22) He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches.

\*Only when we are humble and understand our need for Jesus' help, will we open our heart's door and be able to fellowship and rule with Jesus.

\*Jesus humbly submitted to the Father; we must copy Jesus' example.
