


1. God's Promises to Abraham Were Given to Isaac.

(Genesis 25:19-20)




2. Isaac Had Two Sons, Esau and Jacob.



(Gen. 25:23)


"And the LORD said unto her, Two nations (peoples—Jacob [Israel] and Esau [Edom]) are in thy womb (belly)"

3. Esau and Jacob Were Very Different.




(Genesis 25:27)

Jacob believed and loved the promises of God.


Esau did not believe nor love the promises of God.

Esau = Cain Did not believe God




(Genesis 27:42-44)

Esau planned to kill Jacob.


(Genesis 28:10)

Jacob escaped.




4. God Gave Jacob a Dream.

God promised to protect Jacob and complete His promises.




(Genesis 29:1)
