


## 1. Many Jews Believed Peter's Preaching.



#### (Acts 2:37-40)


\*Many Jews agreed they were wrong to reject Jesus.

\*The Jews asked, "What must we do?"

## \*Peter answered, "<u>Repent (change), and</u> <u>be baptized".</u>



## 2. Before John Baptized <u>Repentant</u> Jews.



\*All the Jews knew meaning of baptism = **repent** (Matthew 3:1-2, 5-6) (1) ... John the Baptist, preaching... saying, **Repent.** ...all Judaea... were **baptized** of him in Jordan, confessing ("Yes, I am a sinner") their sins. \*John baptized people who repented.

## 3. Jesus Commanded to Baptize All Believers.



#### (Matthew 28:18-20)

## (18) And Jesus came and spake...

# Go ye therefore, and <u>teach</u> all nations, <u>baptizing</u> them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of

the Holy Ghost:




## Baptism <u>shows faith in God</u> the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Trinity)

John's baptism and Jesus' baptism had different meaning.

John's baptism = showed people had repented of their sins and were waiting for Jesus coming to save them.

**Jesus' baptism** = showed people had repented of their sins and had finished trusting in Jesus, Who had finished saving them in His death, burial, and resurrection.

## (John 1:14-34) Promise finished: Jesus is God come



## (Matthew 28:18-20) **Jesus' Command:** Go ye therefore, and <u>teach</u> all nations,

- We finished **teaching**: -God is holy
- -We are sinners



- -Jesus died for our sins and resurrected
- -Believe in Jesus and be saved

#### If you <u>finished believing in Jesus</u>, we can **now teach** you about baptism.

# 4. Jesus Was Baptized by John to Show About His <u>Death</u>, <u>Burial</u>, and <u>Resurrection</u>.




#### (Matthew 3:13-15)

Jesus did <u>not</u> need to repent. Jesus wanted to show people that John's teaching was good and to **teach** people about His <u>Death</u>, <u>Burial</u>, and <u>Resurrection</u>.



#### 5. Believers Should Be Baptized to Show that They Have (Finished) Died, Been Buried, and Raised with Jesus.




#### --Tree (Jesus) dies; the branches (Christians) die. --Tree (Jesus) lives; the branches (Christians) live.



#### Faith (inward):

# We believe we died <u>with Jesus</u>, were buried <u>with Jesus</u>, and were raised <u>with</u>

Jesus. (spiritual baptism)



**Baptism** (outward):

Witness of our inward (heart) faith.

#### 6. Baptism Does <u>Not</u> Save People.

- --Baptism is not part of our salvation (Eph. 2:8-9)
- --- Only "through faith ... not of works"
- --Baptism does **not** make anyone a child of God (John 1:12-13)
- ---Only "believing on His (Jesus') name"
- --Baptism canNOT wash away our sins (1 John 1:7)
- ---only Jesus' blood
- --Baptism canNOT pay God for our sins (1 John 2:2)
- ---Only Jesus is the payment (propitiation)

#### 7. God Wants Believers to Be Baptized

 --Believers should (yes) be baptized in obedience/love to the Lord Jesus Christ. (John 14:15)

 --Believers should (yes) be baptized as a <u>witness</u> to other people.

(Acts 2:41)

# 8. Kolkata Baptist Deaf Church Will Baptize All <u>Believers</u>, Who Ask for Baptism.

A believer should **only** be baptized **to** <u>**obey**</u> <u>**Jesus'**</u> **commandment**.
