## 1. Sealing of the 1,44,000 Israeli Evangelists



(Rev 7:1) And after <u>these things</u> [sixth seal] (John) saw four <u>angels</u> standing on the <u>four corners</u> (full control) of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that <u>the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on</u> the sea, nor on any tree [seven Trumpets].



(Rev 7:2a) And saw another angel ascending (go up) from the east, having the seal of the living God...

A seal shows **belonging** and **protects**.



(Rev 7:2b-3) ...and he (angel) cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given [responsibility] to hurt the earth and the sea, [angel] Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have **sealed** the **servants** of our **God** in **their** foreheads. (4) And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand (1,44,000) of all the tribes (families) of the children of Israel.

(Ephesians 1:13)

\*God has <u>now</u> sealed <mark>us (church</mark>) with the Holy Spirit.

\*God <u>will</u> seal <mark>His 1,44,000 servants</mark> (Israelites)

during the Tribulation.

### 1,44,000 <u>Israelites</u>

(Rev 7:5) Of the tribe of **Juda** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Reuben** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Gad** were sealed twelve thousand. (6) Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Nepthalim were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand. (7) Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Levi** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand. (8) Of the tribe of **Zabulon** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Joseph** were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of **Benjamin** were sealed twelve thousand.  $12 \times 12,000 = 1,44,000$  Israelites


#### 2. The Great Harvest of The Great Tribulation



(Rev 7:9) After this (John) beheld, and, lo, a great multitude (many people), which no man could <u>number</u> (count), of all nations, and kindreds (families), and people, and tongues (languages), stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; (10) And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.



# (Rev 7:9) ... palms in their hands; ["Palm Sunday"]



(Rev 7:11) And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God, (12) Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and

ever. Amen.

(Rev 7:13) And one of the elders answered, saying unto me (John), What are these which are arrayed (clothed) in white robes? and whence (where) came they? (14) And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.





(Rev 7:15) Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night (continually) in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them. (16) They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. (17) For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.
