# 1. The **Lamb** and the **1,44,000**



(Rev 14:1) And I (John) looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion (Jerusalem), and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads.

(Rev 14:2) And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: (3) And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed (saved) from the earth.



(Rev 14:4) These are they which were not defiled (sin) with women; for they are virgins (holy). These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever (everywhere) he goeth. These were redeemed (saved) from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb. (5) And in their mouth was found no guile (lies): for they are without (no) fault (wrong) before the throne of God. 144,000 REVEL

(Rev 14:6) And I saw another angel fly in the midst (middle) of heaven (sky), having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred (family), and tongue (language), and people, (7) Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

(Rev 14:8) And there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen (destroyed), is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath (anger) of her fornication (spiritual adultery).




"Wine of wrath" > Just as a drunkard or adulterer drinks or fornicates to the destruction of his own body and life.

## The Wrath of God = Eternity in Hell


(Rev 14:9) And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image (idol), and receive his mark (666) in his forehead, or in his hand...(10) he shall be tormented (suffer) with fire...

(Rev 14:10) The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which [wrath] is poured out without mixture [no mercy] into (prepared) the cup of his indignation (anger); and he shall be tormented (suffer) with fire and brimstone (fire) in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:



(Rev 14:11) And the smoke of their torment (suffering) ascendeth up (goes up) for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image (idol), and whosoever receiveth the mark (666) of his name.

Revelotion 14



(Rev 14:12) Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. (13) And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth (now and after time): Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours (works); and their works do follow [bring with] them.

#### 3. The Harvest for Destruction




(Rev 14:14) And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a

sharp <u>sickle</u> [tool for harvest/reap].



(Rev 14:15) And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust (put) in thy sickle, and reap (harvest) [judge]: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe (ready). (16) And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped.

(Rev 14:17) And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. (18) And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire (judgment); and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters (grapes) of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe (ready for judgment).



(Rev 14:19) And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress (place—crushing grapes) of the wrath of God. (20) And the winepress was trodden (stepped on / crushed) without (outside) the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles (rope control), by the space (measure) of a thousand and six hundred furlongs (300KM).
