



1. Mount Sinai

God led Israel to Mount Sinai.






God Made an Agreement with Israel.

Kingdom of priests =


(Israel will teach the world about God.)

(Exodus 19:9-13)


God wanted Israel to fear Him and know that He is holy, so God showed Himself to Israel.




(Exodus 19:16-19)

All the people heard God speak, but they were afraid and asked Moses to go and speak with God instead of them.




2. Moses Received God's Covenant for Israel.

(2 Peter 1:20-21)


All the words in the Bible were given by God to holy men He chose.

And God spake all these words,




3. God Gave the Law to Moses for Israel to Obey.




(Romans 3:19-20)

The Law shows that all people are sinners.





Sin can be outweighed by good deeds.

God sees things differently than man.






Even one sin outweighs a lifetime of good deeds.
