

(Genesis 4:7) If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and

thou shalt rule over him.

- Thou = Cain
- **Doest** = does
- Well = good / right
- Accepted = God will receive you / praise you
- "lieth at the door" = wait to attack and destroy
- **Desire** = want
- "unto thee shall be his desire" = sin wants to destroy you
- "thou shalt rule over him" = you must control sin
- [We all have sin inside of us. We must not allow sin to control us. The Holy Spirit can help us to control (stop) sin.]
