1. The <u>Revelation</u> (open—show) of Jesus Christ





(Rev. 1:1) The Revelation (open-show) of Jesus Christ, which God gave unto him, to shew (show) unto his servants things which must shortly (soon) come to pass (happen); and he sent and signified (tell meaning) it by his angel unto his servant John: (2) Who (John) bare record (witness) of the word of God, and of the testimony (witness) of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he (John) saw. (3) Blessed (happy / good) is he that **readeth**, and **they** that **hear** the words of this prophecy, and keep (believe—obey) those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand (near).




(Rev 1:4) John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him which is (now), and which was (before), and which is to come (after); and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne; (5) And from Jesus Christ, who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten (to come) of the dead, and the prince (Ruler) of the kings of the earth. Unto <mark>him</mark> that **loved <mark>us</mark>, and washed <mark>us</mark> from <mark>our</mark> sins in** <mark>his <mark>own</mark> blood,</mark>







(John 8:57-59) Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? (58) Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Before** Abraham was, **I am**. (59) Then took they up stones to cast at him:

(John 10:33) The Jews answered <mark>him</mark>, saying, For a good work we stone <mark>thee</mark> not; but for blasphemy; and because that <mark>thou</mark>, being a man, **makest <mark>thyself</mark> God**.

2. John's Vision of Jesus Christ



(Rev. 1:9) I John, who also am your brother, and companion (person sharing) in tribulation (trouble), and [sharing] in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, [John] was in the isle (island) that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ. (10) [John] was in the Spirit on the Lord's day (Sunday), and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,



(Rev. 1:11) Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto <mark>Ephesus</mark>, and unto <mark>Smyrna</mark>, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto <mark>Sardis</mark>, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea. (12) And I turned to see the voice that spake with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks; (13) And in the midst (middle) of the seven candlesticks <mark>one</mark> like unto the <mark>Son of man</mark> (Jesus), clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about (clothed) the paps (chest) with a golden girdle (belt).

(Rev. 1:14) *His head and his hairs were white like* wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire; (15) And his feet like unto fine (pure) brass (metal), as if they burned in a <u>furnace</u> (oven / fire place); and his voice as the sound of many waters (river—fast sound). (16) And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged *sword*: and *his countenance* (look how) was as the sun shineth in his (sun's) strength (bright power).

(Rev. 1:17) And when I (John) saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last: (18) I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, <mark>I</mark> am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell (grave) and of death. (19) Write the things which thou hast seen (before—vision of Jesus [chapter 1]), and the things which are (now [chapters 2-3]), and the things which shall be hereafter (after [chapters 4-22]);

(Rev. 1:20) The mystery of the seven stars which thou sawest in <mark>my</mark> right hand, and the <mark>seven golden candlesticks</mark>. The seven stars are the angels of the seven churches: and the seven candlesticks which thou sawest are the seven churches.
