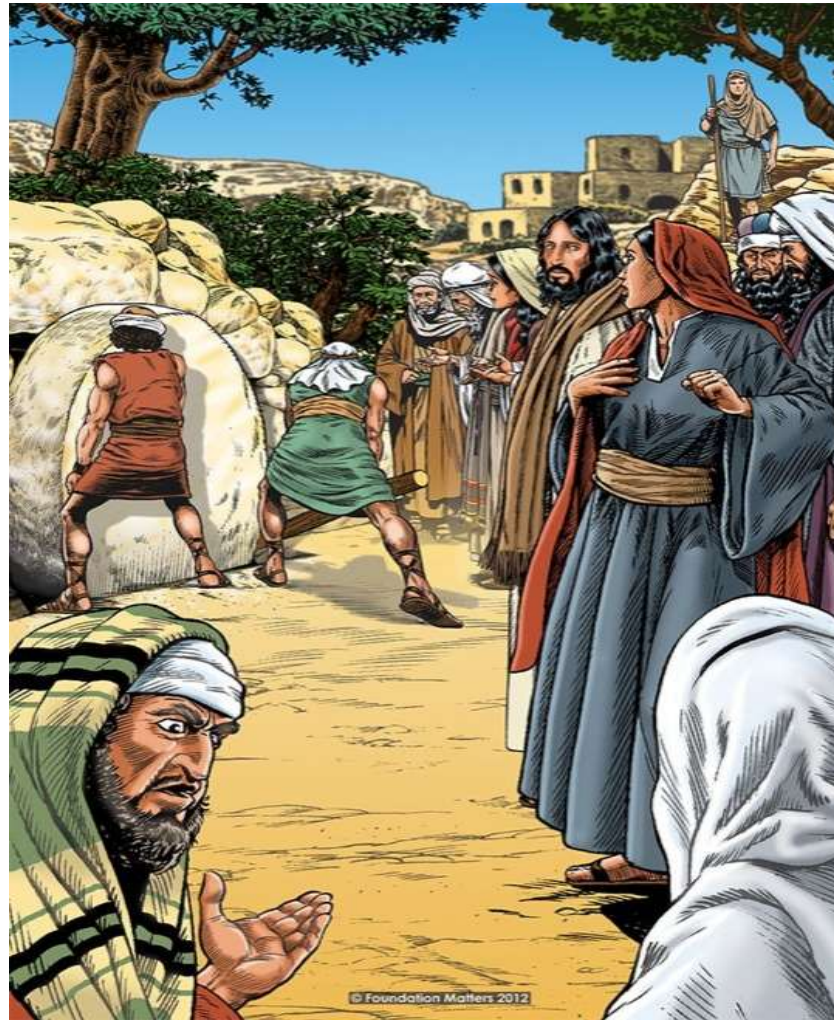


**Lesson 42**

# 1. Lazarus Became Sick and Died.

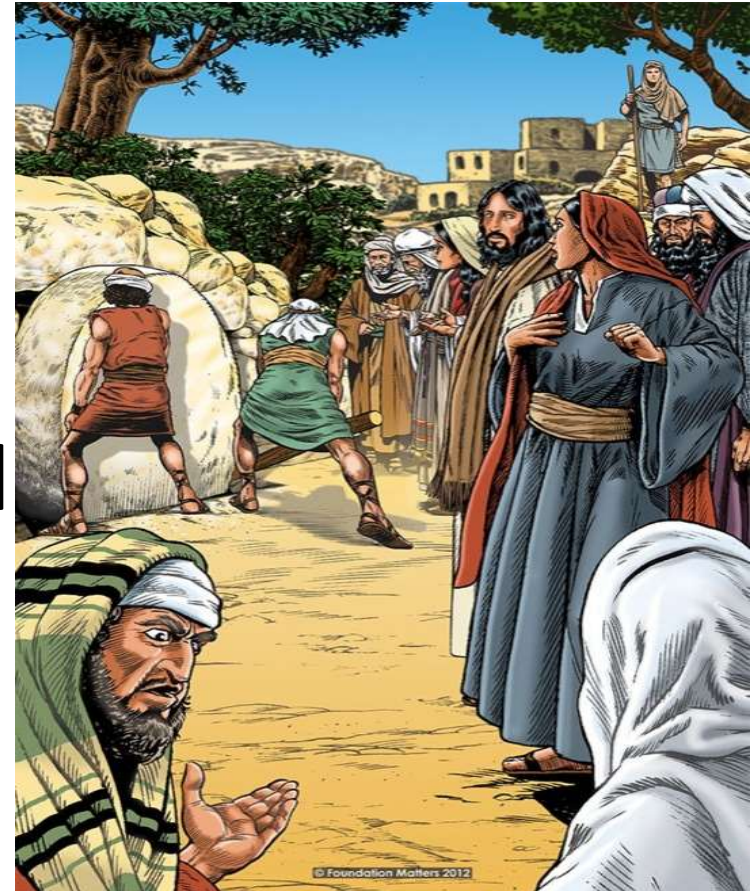


(John 11:1-6)

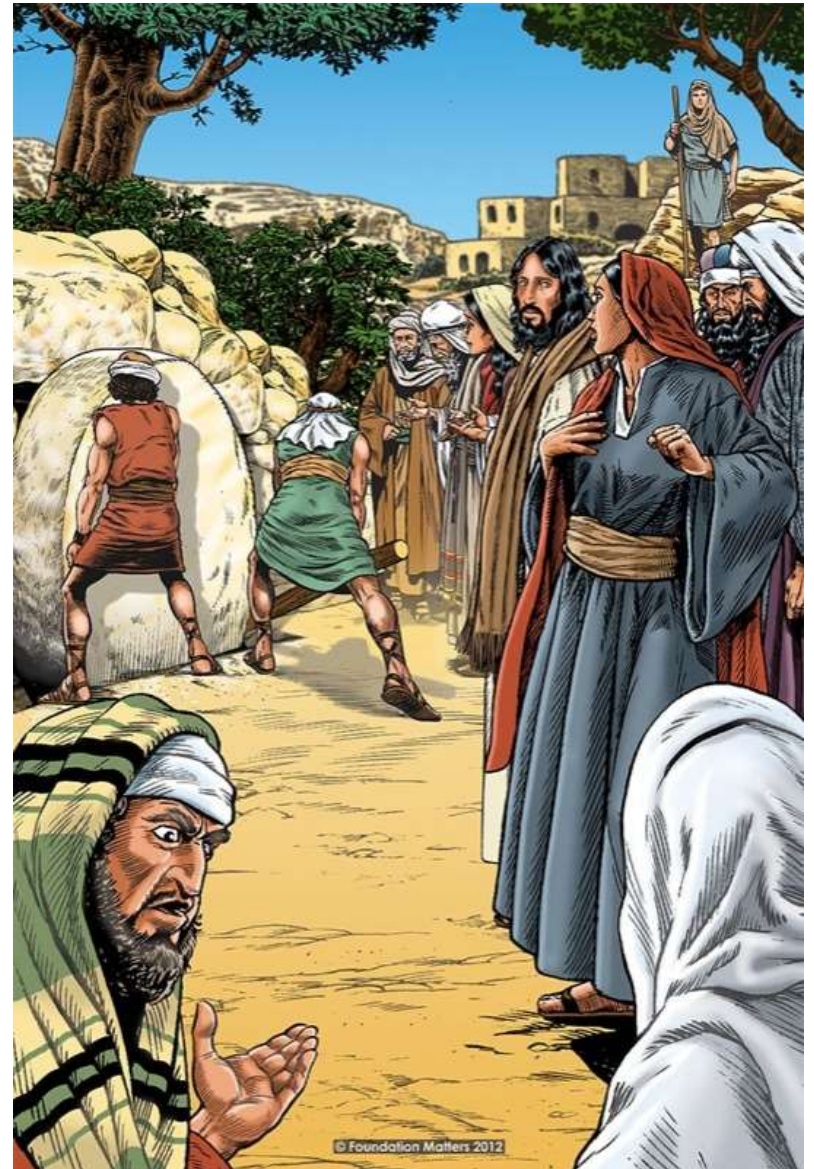
\*Jesus was friends with Lazarus, Mary, and Martha. Mary and Martha were Lazarus's sisters.

\*Jesus allowed Lazarus to die.

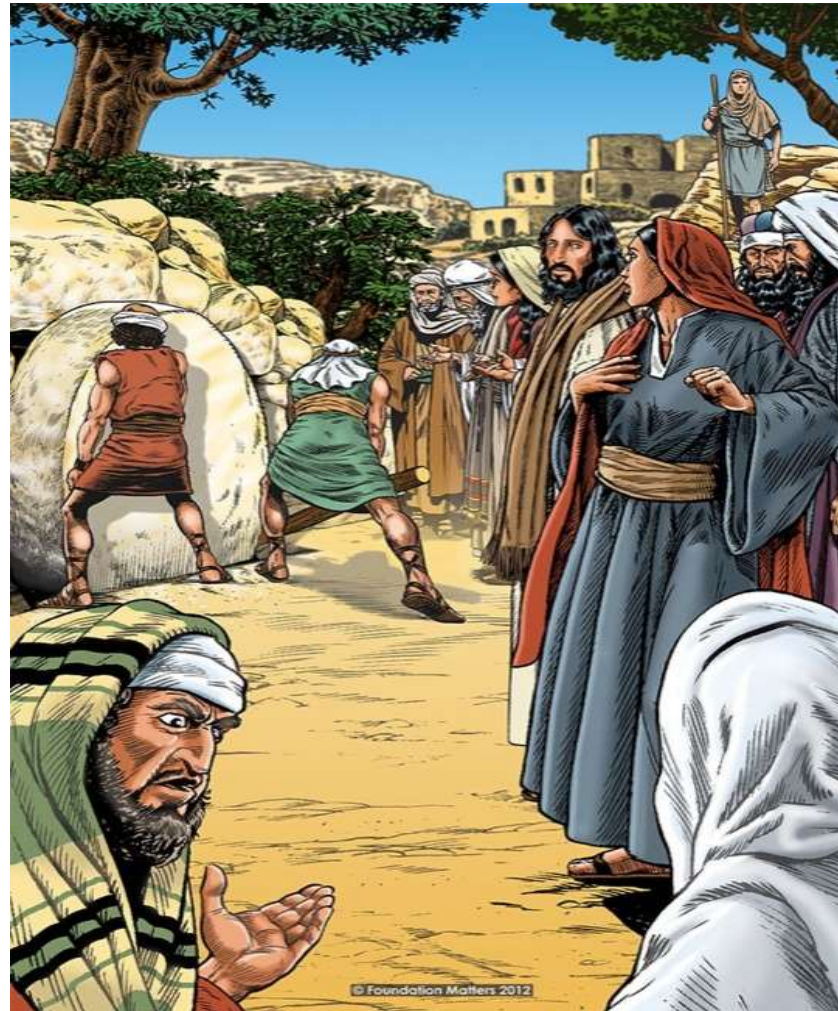
\*People thought maybe Jesus did not love Lazarus and his sisters, but Jesus had a plan to teach people that He is Son of God.



(John 11:14-15)  
Jesus knew the future.  
Jesus was in control.  
Jesus had a plan.



## 2. Jesus Planned to Raise Lazarus from the Dead.



(John 11:17-22)

\*Lazarus was dead 4 days.

\*Many Jews were there at the funeral.

\*Martha believed Jesus before could have healed Lazarus.

\*Martha believed God the Father would do anything Jesus asked.



(Exodus 3:14)

*“And God said unto Moses,  
**I AM THAT I AM.**”*

God is independent and eternal.

God has in Himself ALL POWER.

(John 11:25)

\*Jesus wanted Martha to know that He had the power to give life, even to dead people.

\*Only God can give life.

\*Jesus said,

**“I am the resurrection  
and the life.”**

\*Jesus was saying, “I am God.”





God can resurrect any person's body.

How?

Same as God made Adam from the dust of the ground.



(John 11:26)

Jesus told Martha that people that believe in Him will never die.

(John 11:27) Martha believed Jesus.

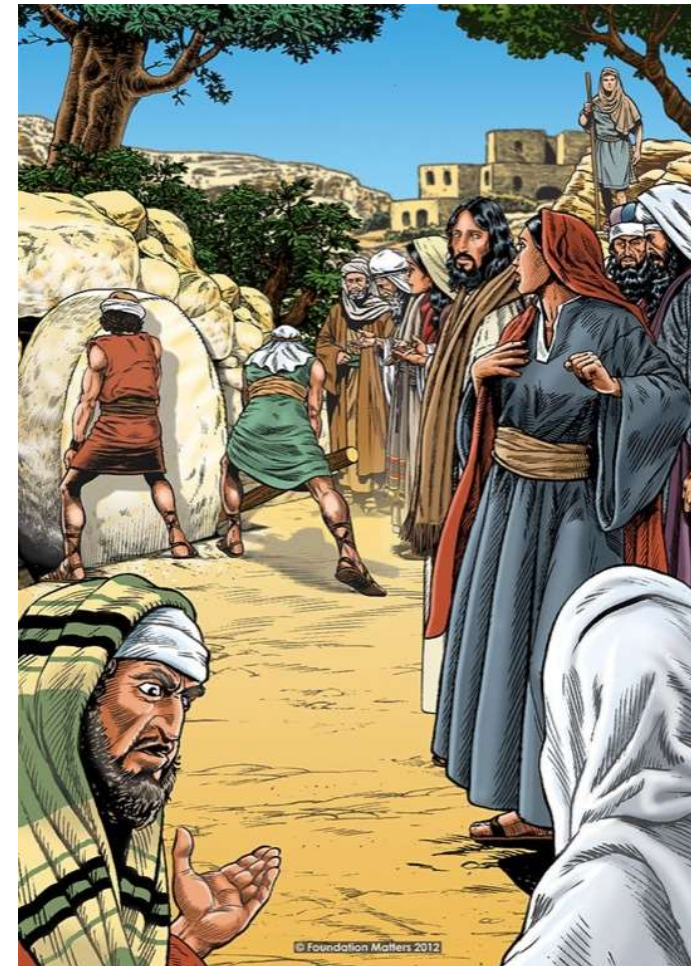


(John 11:33-35)

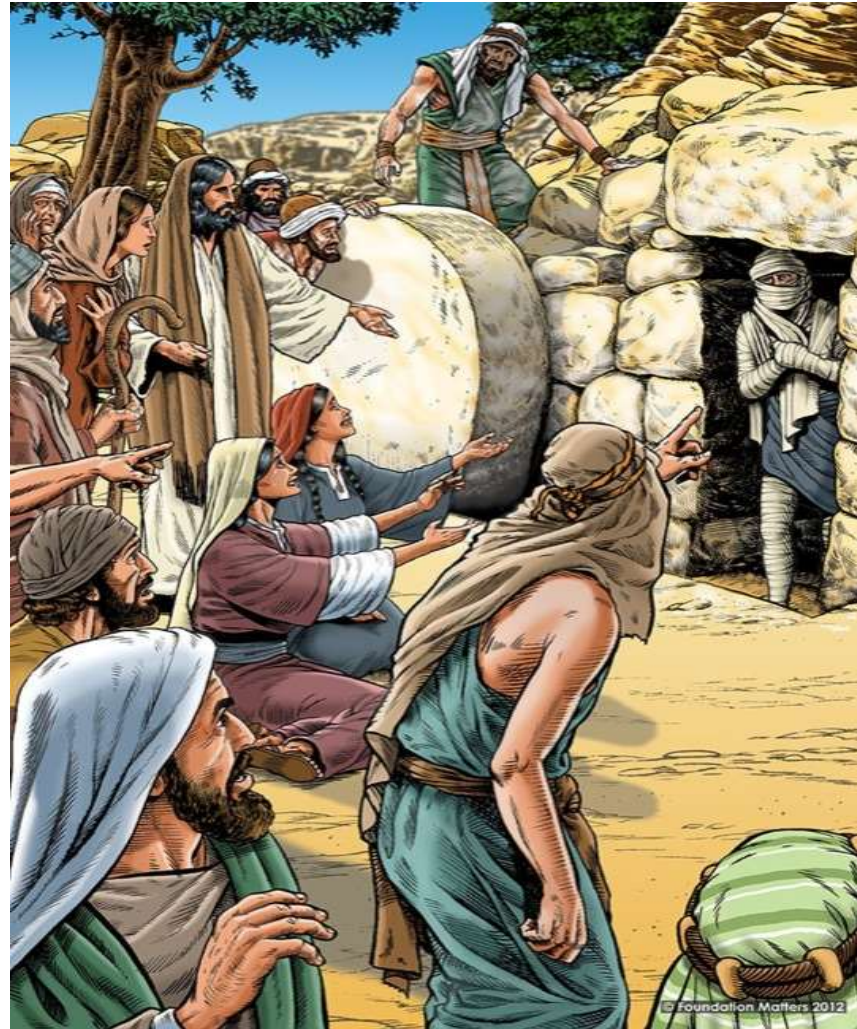
\*Mary came crying to Jesus.

\*Jesus wept (**cried**).

\*Jesus cried because He shared people's pain and sadness.



### 3. Jesus Raised Lazarus from the Dead.



(John 11:39)

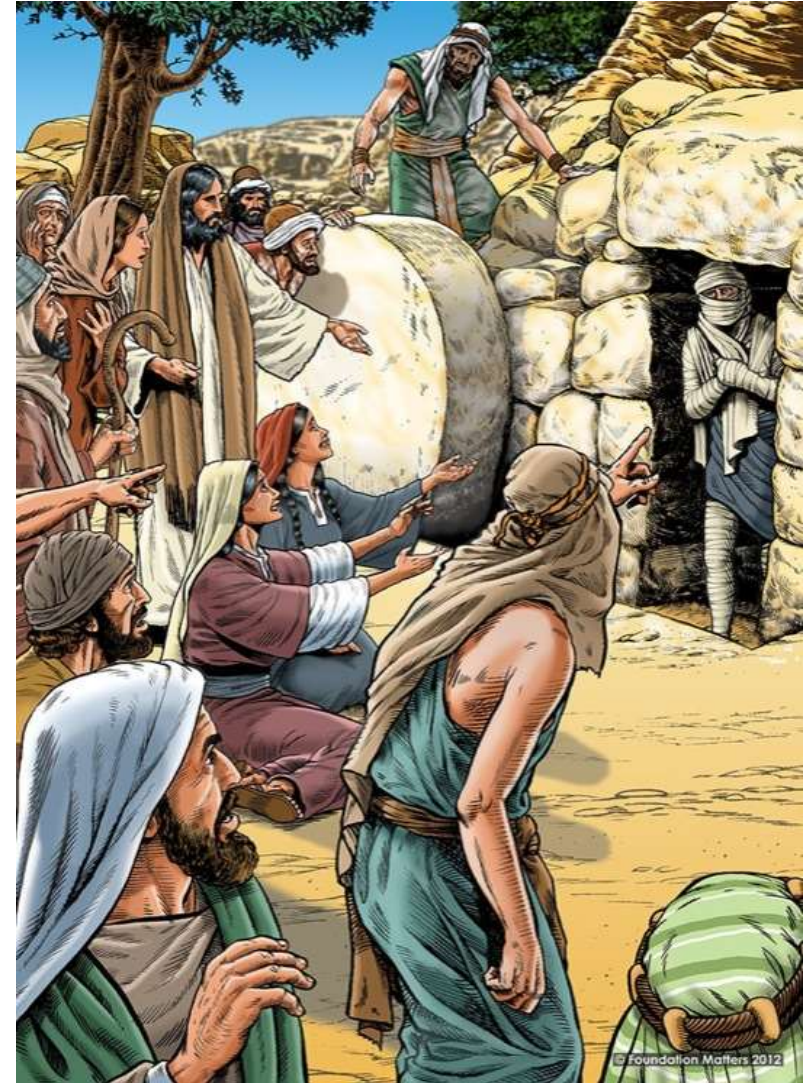
\*Jesus commanded  
that the tomb be opened.

\*Four days dead = stinking body

(John 11:43-44)

\*Jesus commanded that Lazarus  
come out.

**Lazarus came out.**



God created all things... How?

**God only commanded.**

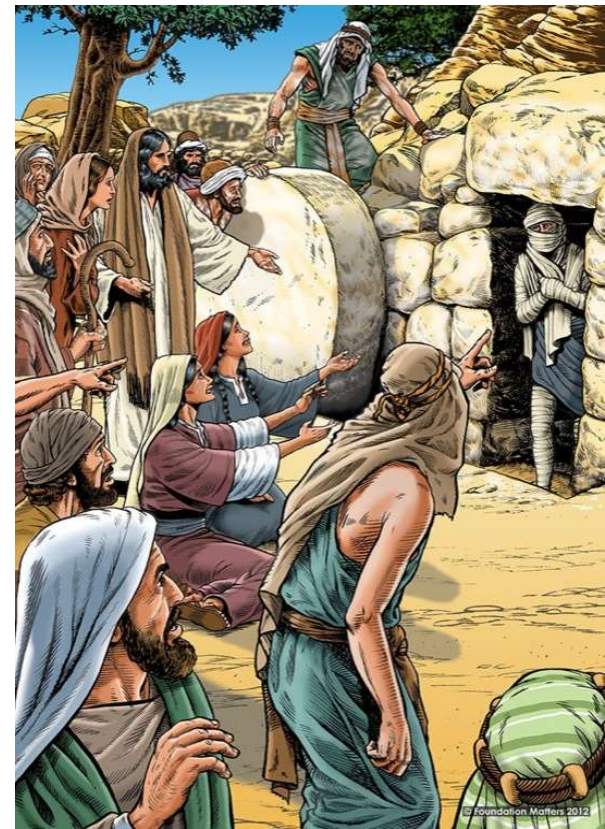
Jesus commanded Lazarus to rise  
from the dead.

Lazarus quickly became alive again!

Jesus is God. Jesus is Almighty.

Jesus is **I AM**.

Many people saw Jesus' great power.



(John 11:45-48)

Many people believed on Jesus, but the Jewish leaders continued against Jesus.
