

(Revelation 19:6-21 & 20:1-15)



1. The Marriage of the Lamb




(Rev 19:6) And (John) heard <u>as it were</u> (same) the voice (sound) of a great *multitude* (many people), and as the voice (sound) of many waters, and as the voice (sound) of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent (All-Powerful) *reigneth* (rules as king). (7) Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour to him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and his wife [the church] JESUS hath made *herself* ready.



Babylon and the **Bride**

False religion (worship): Love of self (proud) Unfaithful to God



True religion (worship): Love of God (humble) Faithful to God



(Rev 19:8) And to <u>her</u> (Bride) was <u>granted</u> (given) that she should be <u>arrayed</u> (clothed) in <u>fine</u> (good) <u>linen</u> (clothes), clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.



(Rev 19:9) And <u>he</u> (angel) saith unto me, Write, Blessed are <u>they</u> <u>which</u> (angels and O.T. saints) are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb. And he saith unto me, These are the true sayings of God.

BLESSED ARE THEY WHICH ARE CALLED TO THE MARRIAGE SUPPER OF THE LAMB"

(Rev 19:10) And (John) fell at his (angel's) feet to worship <mark>him</mark>. And <mark>he</mark> said unto <mark>me</mark>, <u>See</u> (careful) thou do it (worship me) not: am (same) thy fellowservant (equal servant), and [same servant] Of thy brethren (O.T. & N.T. Prophets and Apostles) that have the testimony (witness) of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy [Bible's focus].

Jesus Christ is God; Jesus did allow Himself to be worshipped. (Mat. 2:11; 8:2; 9:18; 14:33; 15:25; 20:20; 28:9, 17; Mk. 5:6; Lk. 24:52; Jn. 9:38).



2. Return of the King




(Rev 19:11) And [(John) saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he (Jesus) that sat upon him (white horse) was called (named) **Faithful** and **True**, and in righteousness he doth judge and make war. **Faithful** = can trust **True** = NO lies





(Rev 19:12) *His eyes were as* a flame of fire, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but <mark>he</mark> himself. (13) And he was clothed with a vesture (clothes) dipped (put) in blood: and his name is called **The Word of God**.

(Rev 19:14) And the **armies** which were in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in <u>fine</u> (good) linen (clothes), white and clean.



(Rev 19:15) And out of his mouth goeth a sharp sword, that with it (sword) he should smite (kill) the nations: and he shall rule them with a rod of iron: and he treadeth (step) the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of <mark>Almighty God</mark>. (16) And <mark>he</mark> hath on his vesture (clothes) and on his thigh (leg) a name written, KING **OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS**.





(Rev 19:17) And I (John) saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the <u>fowls</u> (birds) that fly in the midst of heaven, Come and gather yourselves (birds) together unto the supper of **the great God**;




(Rev 19:18) That ye (birds) may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them (men) that sit on them (horses), and the flesh of all men, both <mark>free</mark> and <mark>bond</mark> (slaves), both small and great.



Carnage = much death / killing

(Rev 19:19) And I (John) saw the beast (Antichrist), and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against <u>him</u> (Jesus) that sat on the horse, and against his army.




(Rev 19:20) And the beast (Antichrist) was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought (did) miracles before him (Antichrist), with which (miracles) he (False prophet) deceived (lied) them that had received the mark (666) of the **beast**, and **them** that worshipped his image (idol). These both were cast alive into <u>a</u> lake of fire (Hell) burning with brimstone (fire).




(Rev 19:21) And the <u>remnant</u> (continue alive people) were <u>slain</u> (killed) with the sword of <u>him</u> that sat upon the horse, which sword <u>proceeded</u> (went) out of <u>his</u> mouth: and all the fowls (birds) were filled with their flesh.





3. Reign of Jesus Christ (during the 1,000 years)



(Rev 20:1) And (John) saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of <u>the bottomless pit</u> (Hell) and a great chain in his hand. (2) And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent (snake), which is the **Devil**, and **Satan**, and bound him <u>a thousand</u> (1,000) years,



(Rev 20:3) [the angel] And cast him into <u>the</u> <u>bottomless pit</u> (Hell), and shut him up, and set a <u>seal</u> (lock) upon him, that he should <u>deceive</u> (lie) the nations no more, till **the thousand years** should be <u>fulfilled</u> (finished): and after that he must be <u>loosed</u> (free) a little <u>season</u> (time).






(Rev 20:4) And [(John) saw thrones, and they sat upon them (thrones), and judgment (rule) was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were <u>beheaded</u> (killed) for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast (Antichrist), neither <mark>his</mark> image (idol), neither had received his mark (666) upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned (rule) with Christ a thousand years.




(Rev 20:5) But <u>the rest</u> (other) of the dead lived not again until **the thousand years** were finished. This is the first resurrection. (6) Blessed and holy is he that <u>hath part</u> (join) in the first resurrection: on such <u>the</u> second death (Hell) hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall <u>reign</u> (rule) with him a thousand years.




4. Defeat of Satan (after the 1,000 years)



(Rev 20:7) And when **the thousand years** are <u>expired</u> (finished), Satan shall be <u>loosed</u> (freed) out of <u>his prison</u> (Hell), (8) And shall go out to <u>deceive</u> (lie) the nations which are in <u>the four quarters</u> (all) of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as <u>the sand of the sea</u> (too many).



(Rev 20:9) And they went up on the breadth of the earth (come from all places), and compassed (surrounded) the camp (stay place) of the saints about (around), and the beloved city (Jerusalem): and fire came down from God out of heaven, and <u>devoured</u> (destroyed) them.



(Rev 20:10) And the devil that <u>deceived</u> (lied) them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone (Hell), where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be <u>tormented</u> (suffer) <u>day and night</u> (always) <u>for ever</u>

and ever (no end).



5. The Great White Throne (Judgment of the Condemned) (after the 1,000 years)



(Rev 20:11) And (John) saw a great white throne, and him (Jesus) that sat on it, <u>from whose</u> face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. [nothing can escape the knowledge or

reach of God; None can hide from the judgment of God]



(Rev 20:12) And saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to **their works**.



(Rev 20:13) And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell <u>delivered</u> (gave) up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to **their works**.



(Rev 20:14) And death and hell were cast into <u>the</u> <u>lake of fire</u> (Hell). This is <u>the second death</u> (Hell—eternal separation from God). (15) And whosoever was [name] not found written in the book of life was cast into <u>the</u> <u>lake of fire</u> (Hell).
