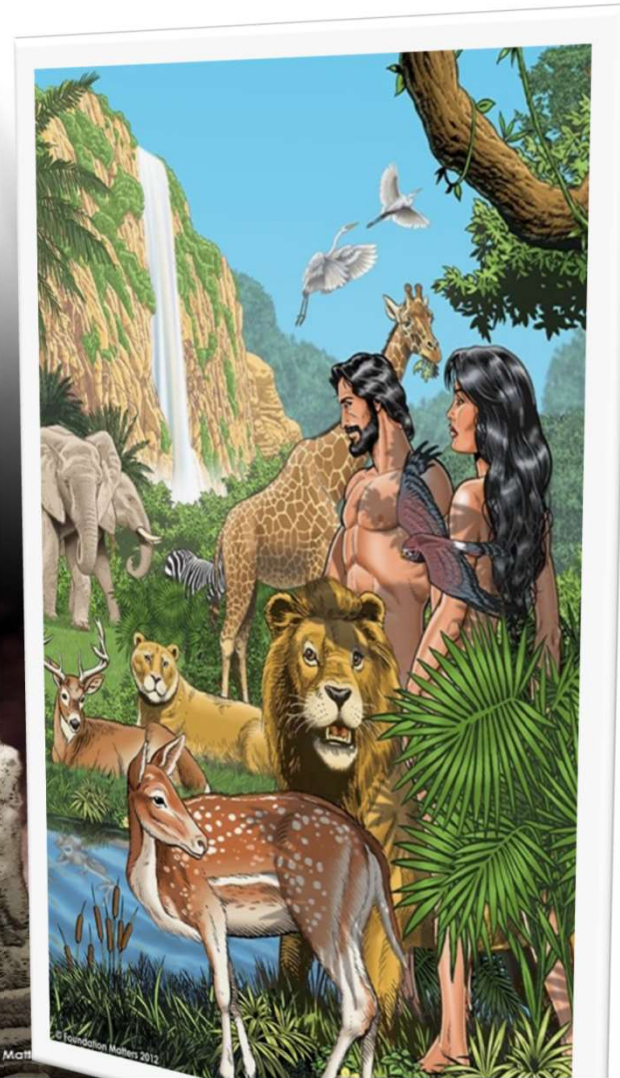
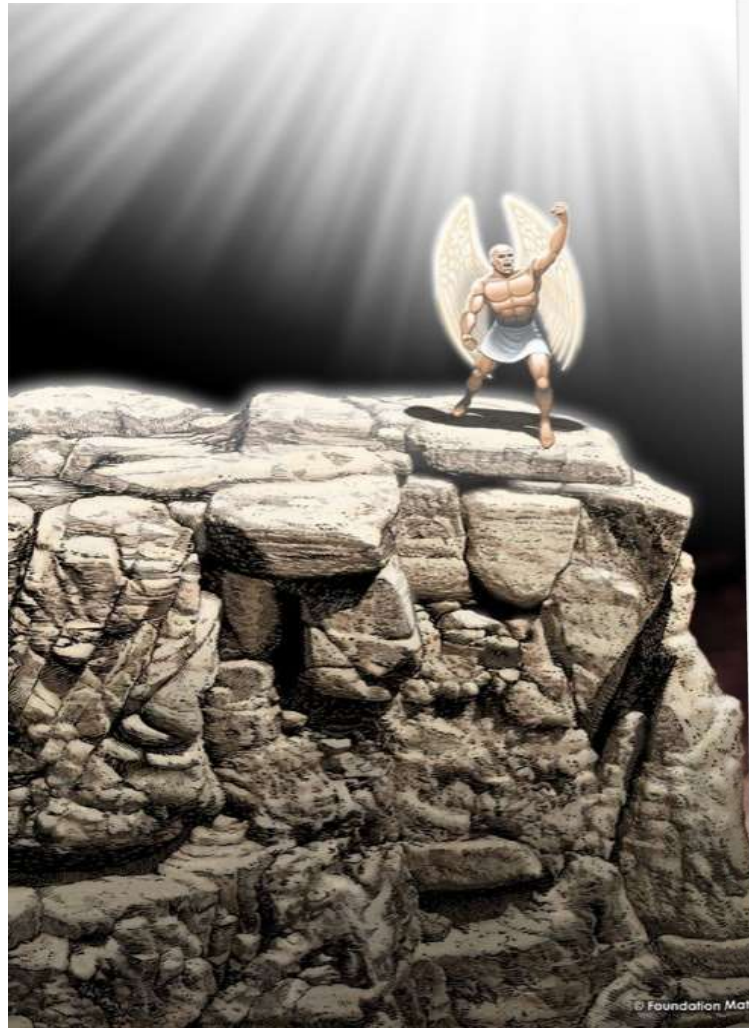

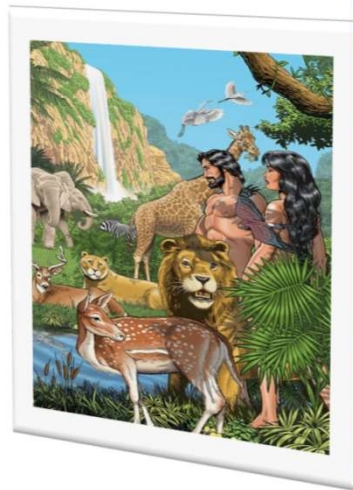


# 1. Satan Planned To Destroy Adam and Eve.



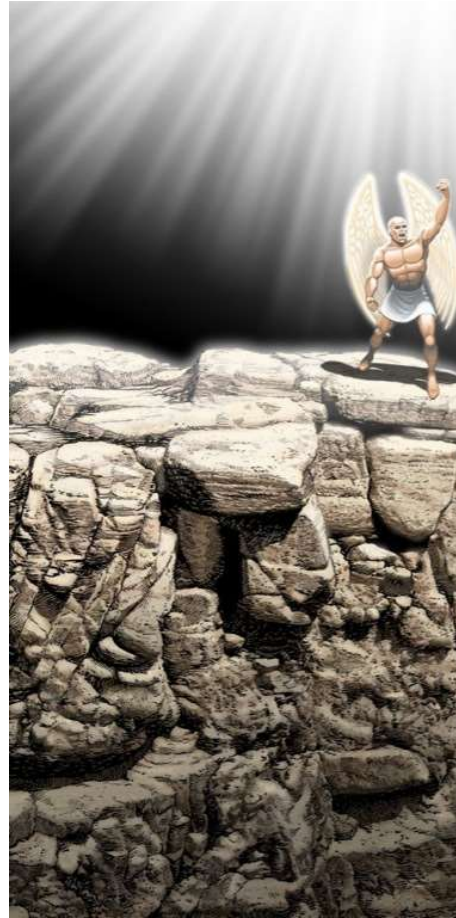


Adam and Eve had a  
good life;  
...good food, beauty,  
and no problems;  
...good friendship  
with God



Satan disguised (**hid**) himself  
so Satan could deceive (**lie**) Eve.

(Genesis 3:1)



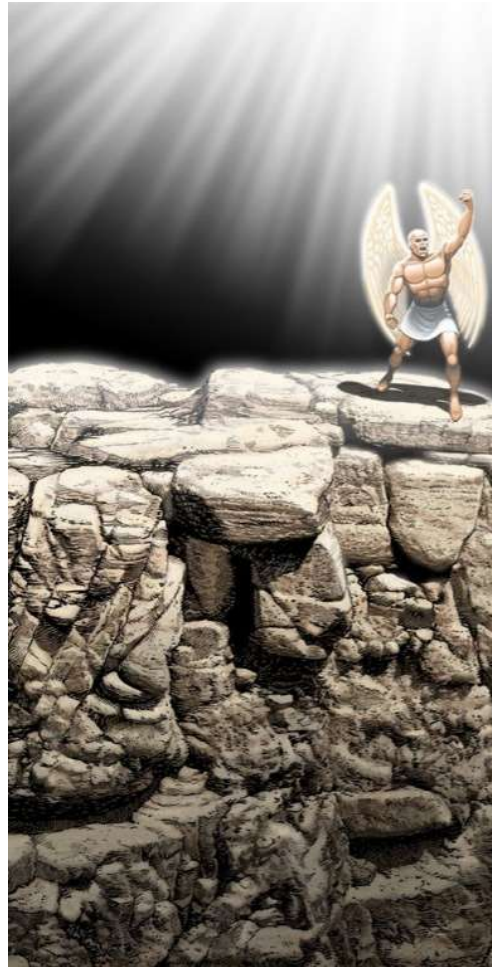
(2 Corinthians 11:13-15)

\*Satan deceives (**lies**) people everywhere.





## 2. Satan Tempted (**push sin**) and Deceived (**lied**) Eve.



(Genesis 3:1)

Satan tempted (**push sin**) Eve to **not** believe God's Word.

Today also, Satan's plan is to tempt people to not believe God's Word.



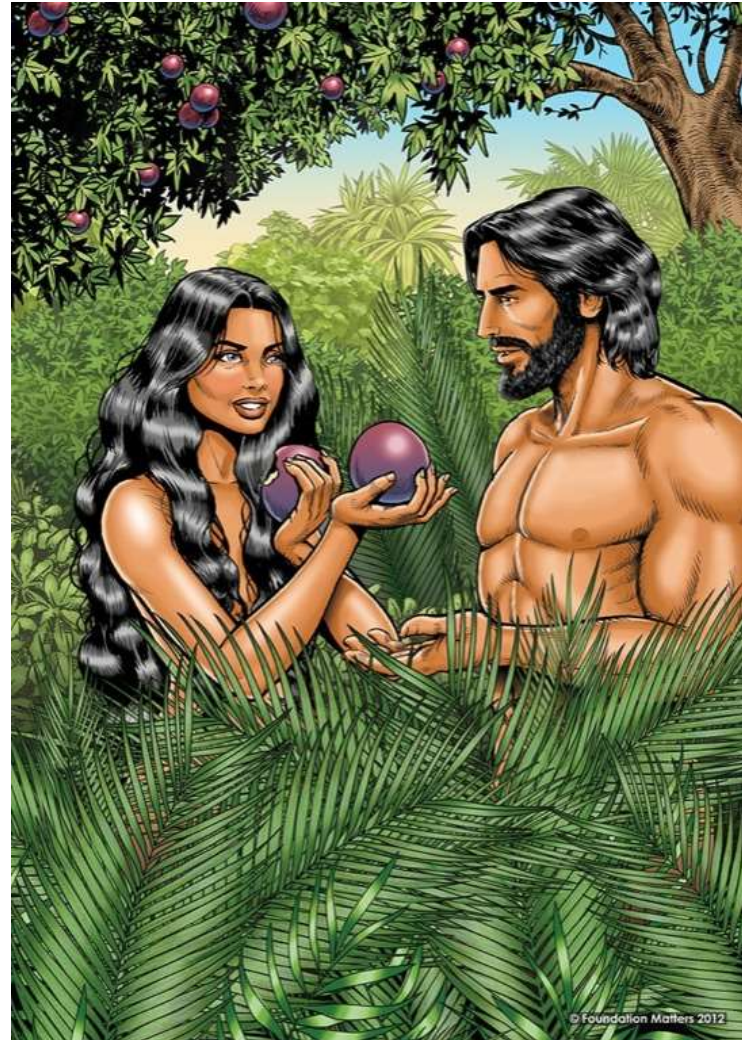
(Genesis 3:2-5)

- \*Satan said God is a liar.
- \*Satan said it is better to be independent (**separate**) of God.
- \*Satan said Eve could be equal (**same**) with God.
- \*God always tells the truth and gives life... Satan tells lies and tries to destroy.





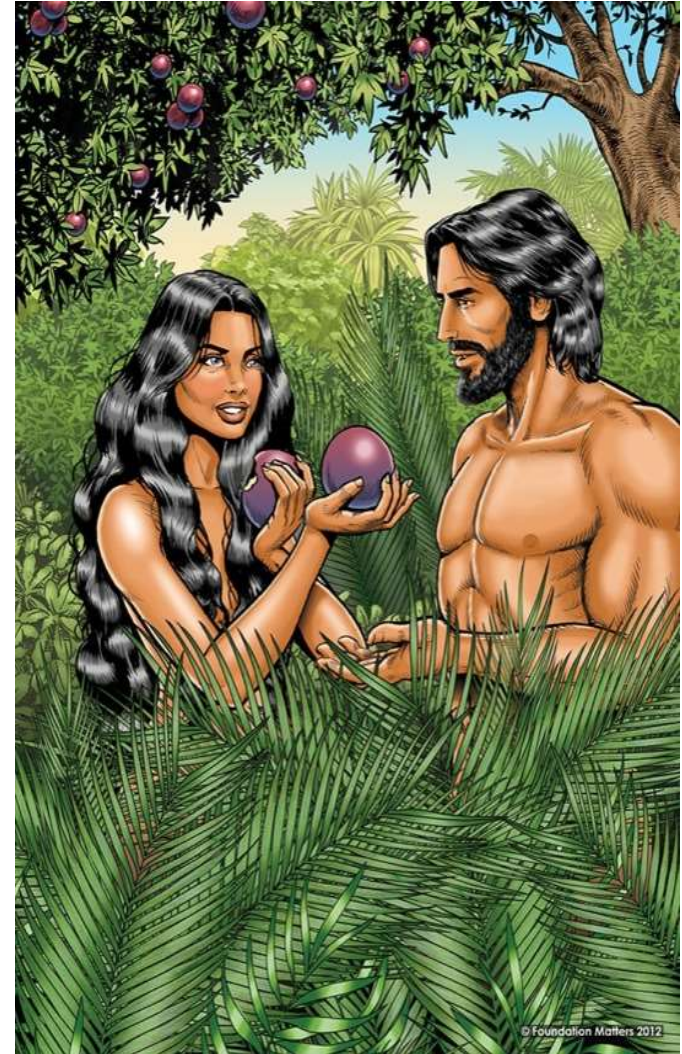
### 3. Adam and Eve Disobeyed God.



(Genesis 3:6)

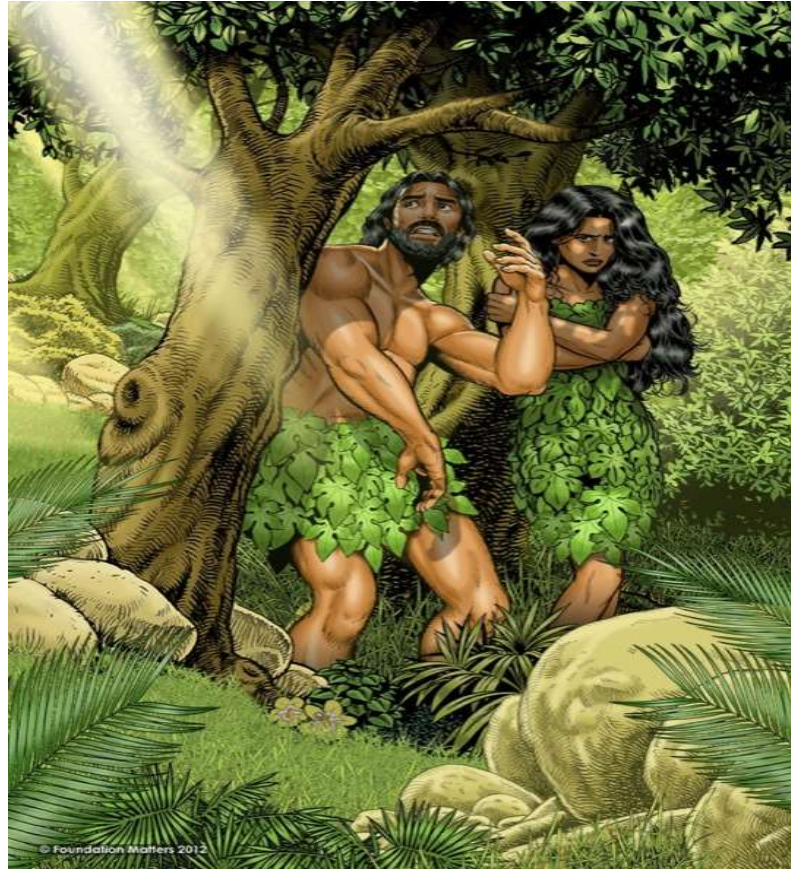
\*Satan deceived (**lied**) Eve, and Eve believed Satan.

\*Adam, same as Eve, ate the fruit, choosing to disobey God's command.





## 4. Adam and Eve Sinned and Immediately (quick) Were Separated from God.





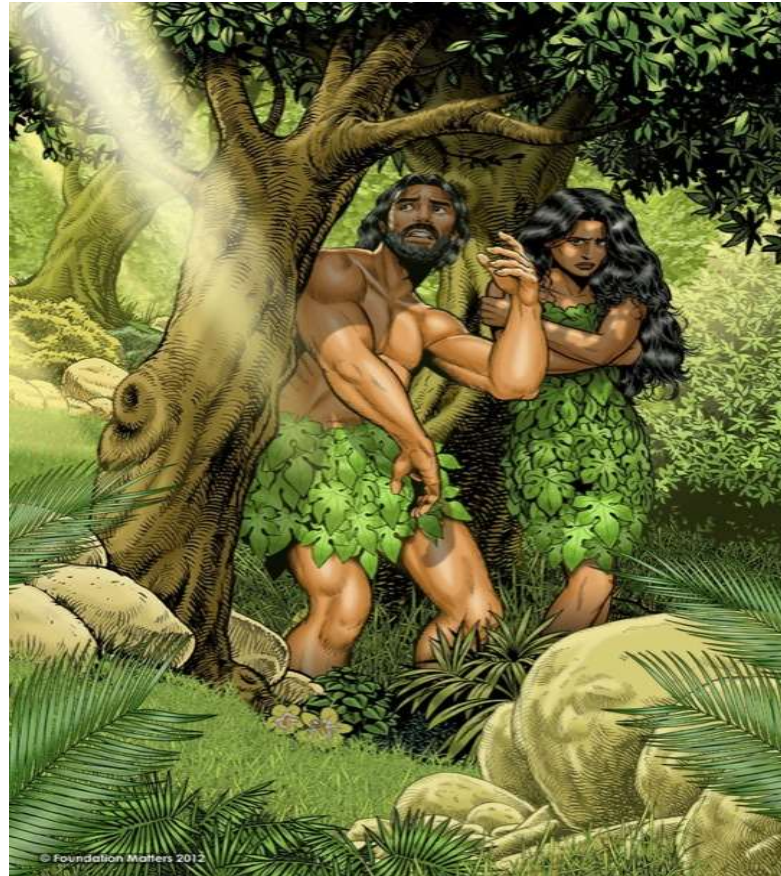
(Genesis 3:7-8)

\*Adam and Eve immediately (**quick**) died – **separated from God**... No friendship with God (**spiritual death**)

\*Death did not happen in Adam and Eve's bodies the same day (**physical death**)



## 5. Adam and Eve's Separation from God

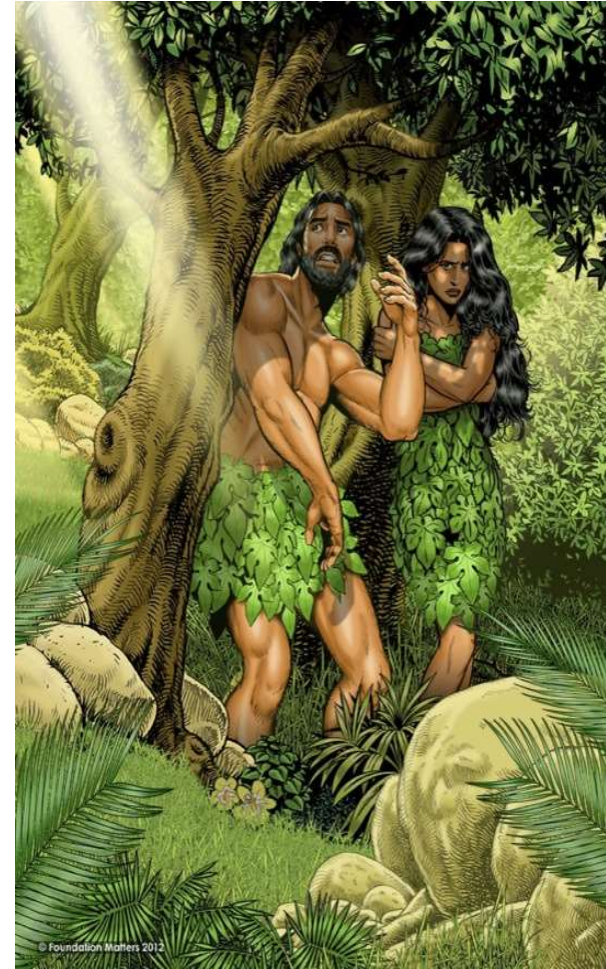




(Genesis 3:7-8)

Adam and Eve were ashamed (afraid) by their nakedness... their **thinking became evil/sinful**. Adam and Eve were now under Satan's control.

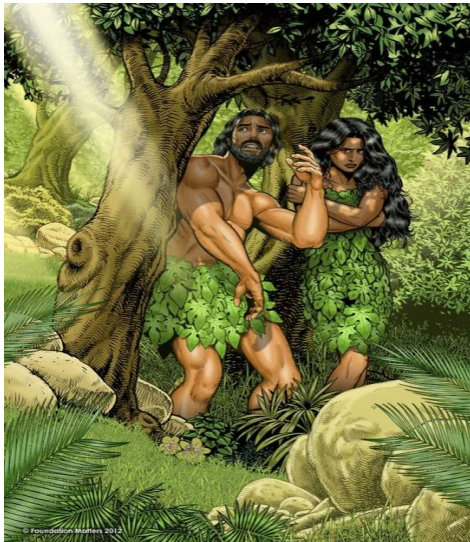
Adam and Eve tried to work for own needs and made clothes from leaves.



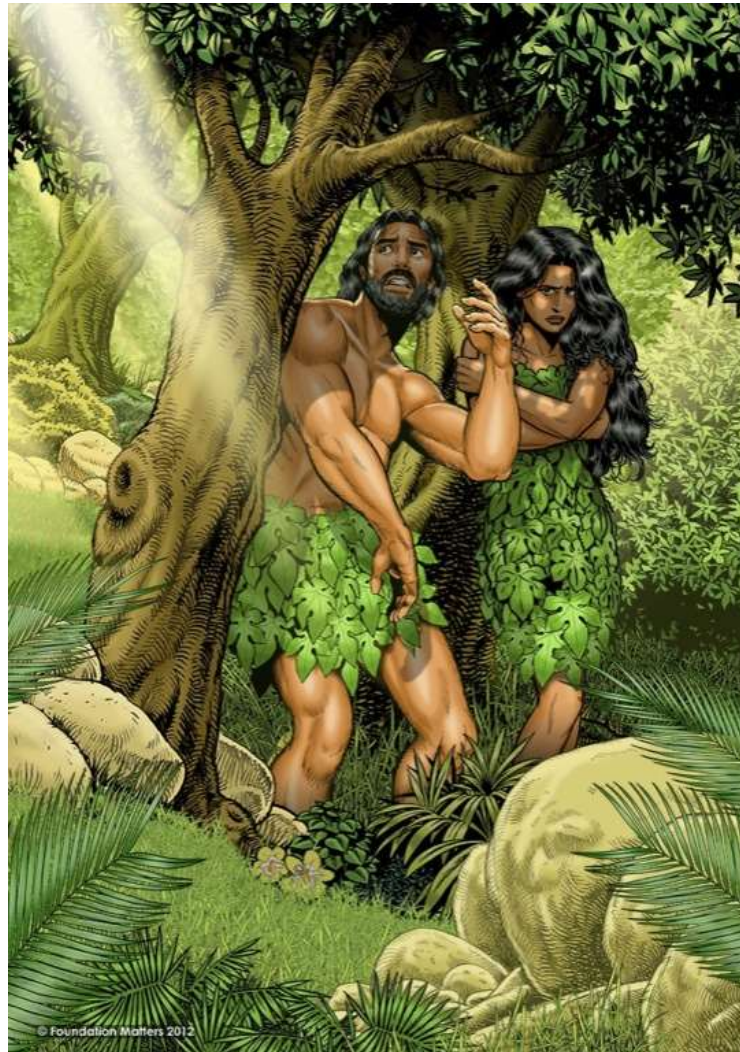


(I Samuel 16:7)

\*Working to make yourself outwardly acceptable to God will fail (**lose**) because God looks at your heart.



## 6. Adam and Eve Were Afraid of God.





\*Before Adam and Eve sinned,  
they were never afraid.  
\*Now Adam and Eve knew fear.  
\*Today, because people have sin, all  
people have fear of different things.

(Jer. 23:23-24; Ps. 139:1)

**God is everywhere** at the same time;  
Adam and Eve couldn't hide from God.
