Jesus Can Forgive Sins.

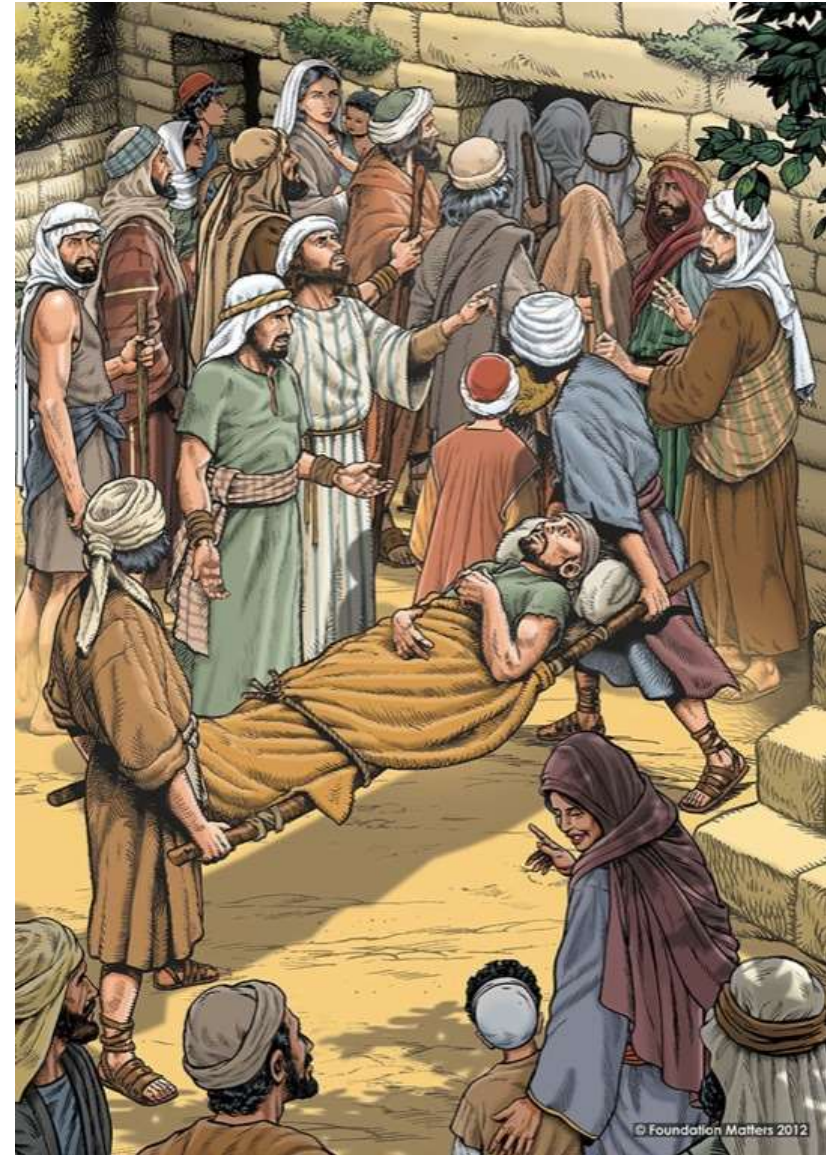


1. Jesus Healed the Body and Forgave the Sins of a Lame Man.



(Mark 2:1-2)

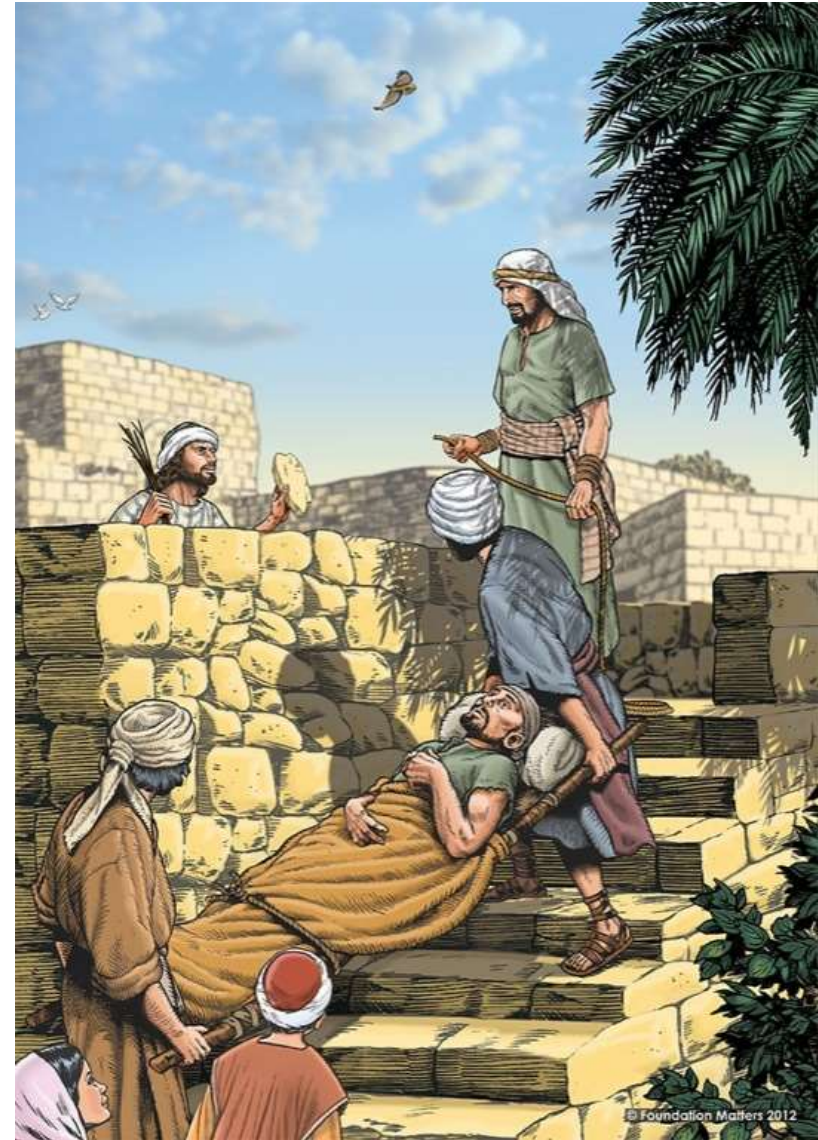
Many people came into a house to hear Jesus teach.



(Mark 2:3-4)

The house was too crowded.

Four men broke open the roof
and lowered the lame man
down to Jesus.

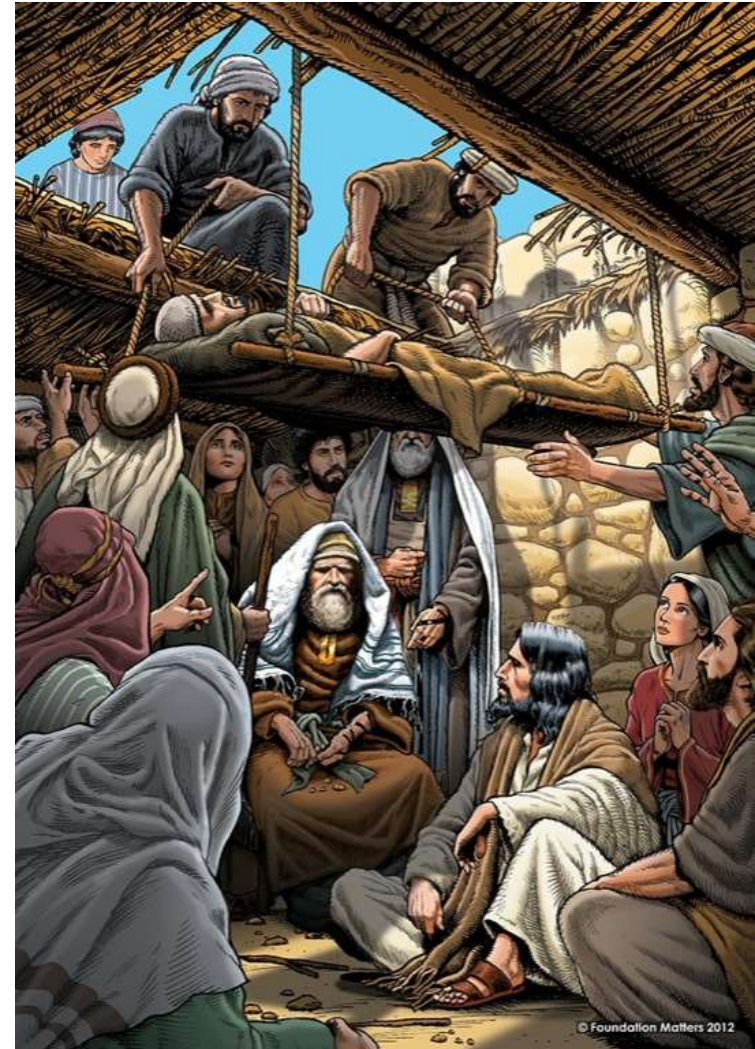


(Mark 2:5-7)

Jesus forgave the sins of the lame man when Jesus saw his faith.

*The religious leaders were angry against Jesus because only God can forgive sins.

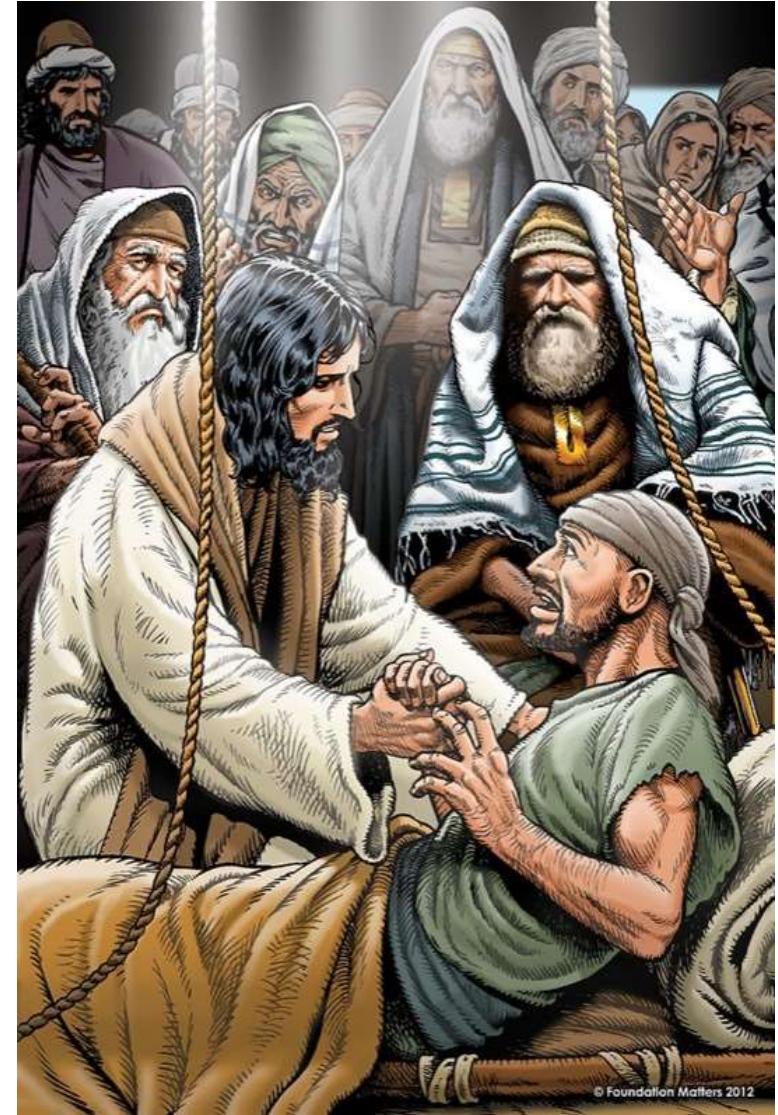
*Jesus is NOT ONLY a man;
Jesus is ALSO God.



(Mark 2:8-9)

Jesus healed the body of the lame man.

Jesus miracle proved He was God and could forgive sins.



2. Jesus Called Levi (Matthew) to Become His Disciple.

Matthew was a tax collector for Rome.

Jewish people hated tax collectors (**publicans**).

(Mark 2:14) Matthew became Jesus' disciple.



3. Jesus Came to Save Sinners.

(Mark 2:15-16) Jesus ate in Matthew's house.

*The religious leaders were against Jesus for eating in a “sinners” (**Matthew's**) house.



(Mark 2:17)

Jesus came to save those who
confess (**tell sorry**) their sins.



People who confess their sins
KNOW their **NEED** for Jesus.

4. The Pharisees and Herodians

(King Herod's people) **Wanted to Kill Jesus.**

(Mark 3:6)

Before Herodians
and Pharisees were
enemies.

Now Herodians and
Pharisees joined
together to kill Jesus.



5. Jesus Taught and Healed Many People.



(Mark 3:7-10)

(7) ...a great multitude (*many people*) from Galilee followed him (*Jesus*), and from Judaea, (8) And from Jerusalem, and from Idumaea, and from beyond Jordan; and they about Tyre and Sidon...



6. Jesus Chose the 12 Apostles.

“Apostle” = messenger
The Apostles would receive Jesus’ story and words and tell to all people.
(Mark 3:13-19)
Peter, James, John, Andrew, Philip, Bartholomew, Matthew, Thomas, James, Thaddaeus, Simon, and Judas
