



## 1. Pharaoh Wanted to Destroy the Israelites.




(Exodus 1:1-6)

Israel became many people.





(Exodus 1:8, 11)

Israel became many more people even as slaves.







(Exodus 1:22)


Pharaoh wanted to hurt Israel.


Pharaoh commanded that all boy Israelites be killed by casting them into the river.




### 2. God Protected Moses.











(Exodus 2:1-4)

Moses's mother and sister (Miriam) hid Baby Moses in an ark and put him in the river.




(Exodus 2:5)

Pharaoh's daughter saw Moses's ark and took Moses as her own son.




(Exodus 2:10)

(Acts 7:22)


Moses became very wise and powerful in Egypt.




(Exodus 2:11-12)

(Exodus 2:15-21) Pharaoh tried to kill Moses, but Moses escaped to the land of Midian and married Zipporah.







(Exodus 2:23-25)

# 3. God Spoke to Moses from the Burning Bush.




(Exodus 3:1-4)

Moses was watching sheep.


He saw a bush continuing to burn.

(Exodus 3:5-6)


God said, "I am the God of your fathers (Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob)."



(Exodus 3:7-10)


God told Moses, "I will save Israel out from slavery in Egypt.

God told Moses, "Go to Pharaoh and tell him that God said to free the Israelites from slavery in Egypt."




(Exodus 3:11-12, 20)

# 4. God Is "I AM."




(Exodus 3:13-14)


Moses asked God, "What is Your name?"

God is the place from which all life comes. God is All-powerful, All-knowing, and Everywhere present.




# 5. Moses Was Afraid to Go Again to Egypt.




(Exodus 4:1)

Moses doubted God's plan to save Israel out from slavery in Egypt.




(Exodus 4:2-3)

(Exodus 4:6)


God made Moses's hand to become leprous, then again God cleansed Moses's hand.

Moses was afraid his own power was small.


God told Moses, "I made you, I made the blind, I made the deaf. I can help all people; I will help you."




(Exodus 4:14-17)
