1. Measuring the Temple of God

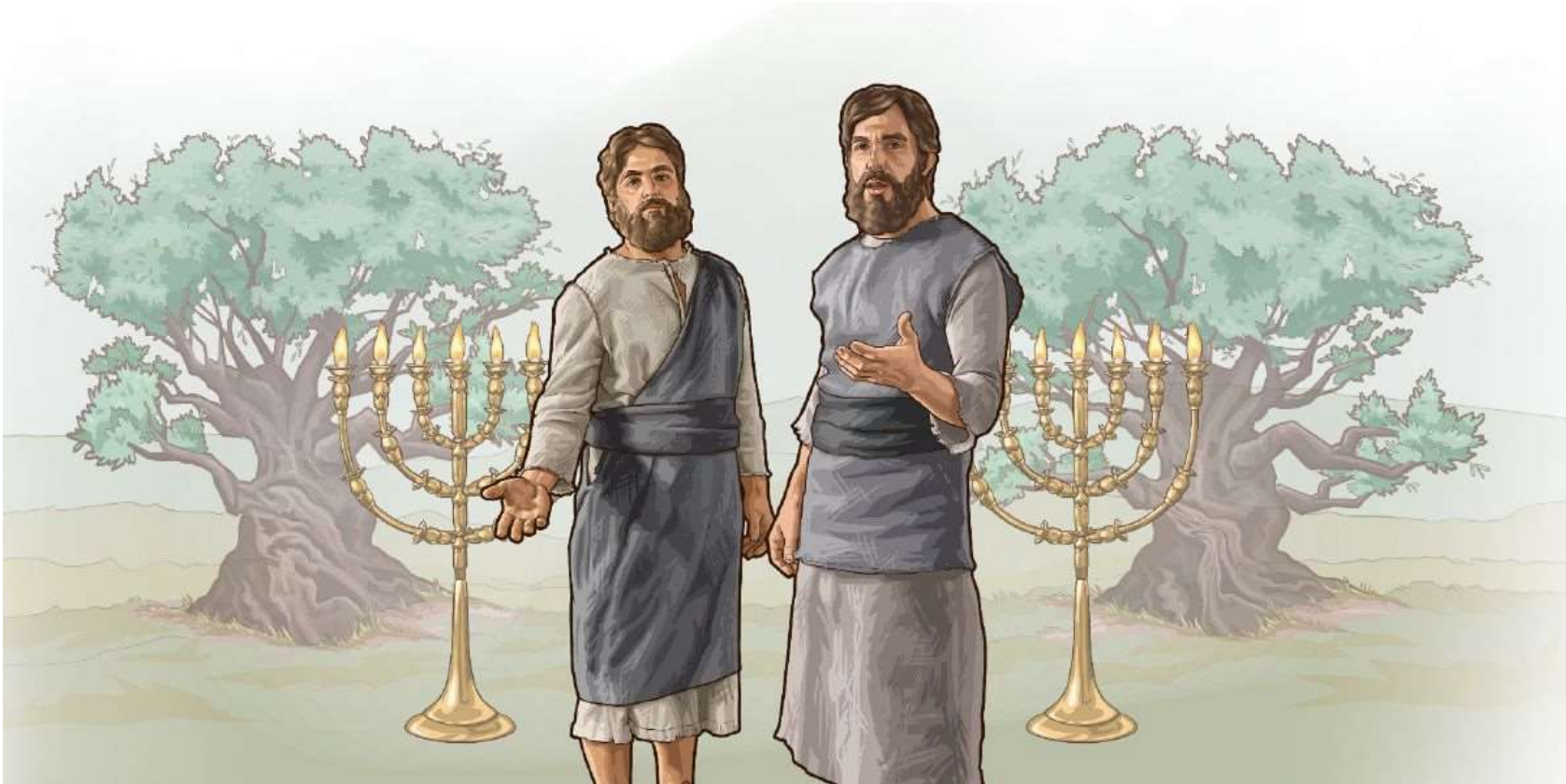


The Temple of Jesus' Day

(Rev 11:1) And there was given **me** (John) a reed like unto a rod (ruler): and the **angel** stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of **God**, and the altar, and **them** that worship therein [taking ownership]. (2) But the court which is without (outside) the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given unto the **Gentiles**: and the holy city (Jerusalem) shall **they** tread under foot (oppress) forty and two months (3 ½ years).



2. The Two Witnesses



(Rev 11:3) And **I** will give power unto **my two witnesses**, and **they** shall prophesy a thousand two hundred and threescore days (3 ½ years), clothed in sackcloth (bad clothes). (4) **These** are the **two olive trees**, and the **two candlesticks** standing before the **God of the earth** [Zechariah 4].



Zerubbabel and Joshua were two leaders who rebuilt the Temple by the power of the Holy Spirit.



Olive Trees give oil = The Two Witnesses have the continual power of the Holy Spirit.
(oil = the power of the Holy Spirit)

Candlesticks give light = Two Witnesses will give light by the power of the Holy Spirit.
(light = truth / witness to the world about Jesus Christ's Coming Kingdom)

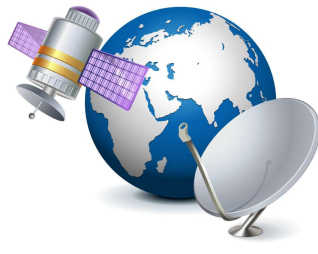
(Rev 11:5) And if any **man** will hurt **them** (Two Witnesses), fire proceedeth (goes) out of **their** mouth, and devoureth (destroys) **their enemies**: and if any **man** will hurt **them**, **he** must in this manner (way [with fire]) be killed. (6) **These** have power to shut heaven (sky), that it rain not in the days of **their** prophecy (speak God's Word): and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite (hurt) the earth with all plagues (destructions), as often as **they** will (want).



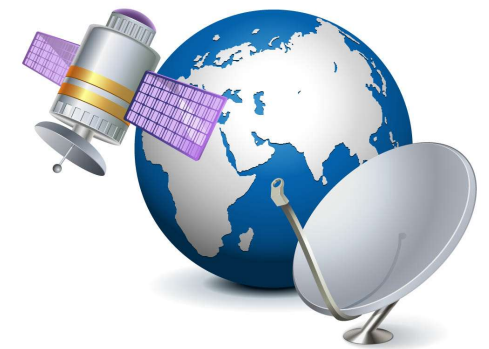
(Rev 11:7) And when **they** shall have finished **their** testimony (**witness**), the **beast** that ascendeth (**goes up**) out of the bottomless pit (**Hell**) shall make war against **them**, and shall overcome **them**, and kill **them**. (8) And **their** dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt (**Jerusalem**), where also **our Lord** was crucified.



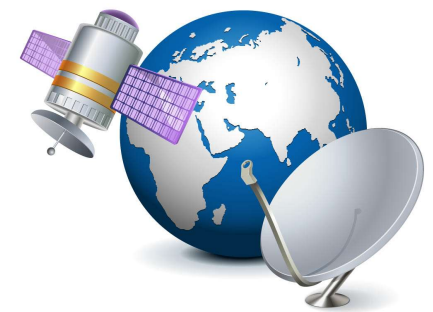
(Rev 11:9) And **they** of the people and kindreds (**families**) and tongues (**languages**) and nations shall see **their** dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer (**allow**) **their** dead bodies to be put in graves. (10) And **they** that dwell (**stay**) upon the earth shall rejoice over **them**, and make merry (**happy party**), and shall send gifts **one** to **another**; because **these two prophets** tormented (**hurt**) **them** that dwelt on the earth.



(Rev 11:11) *And after three days and an half the Spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell (happened) upon them which saw them. (12) And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither (here). And they ascended up (went up) to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld (saw) them.*



(Rev 11:13) *And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part (1/10) of the city (Jerusalem) fell, and in the earthquake were slain (killed) of men seven thousand: and the remnant (people alive) were affrighted (afraid), and gave glory to the **God** of heaven. (14) The second woe (danger) is past; and, behold, the third woe cometh quickly.*



3. Heaven's Joy and the World's Anger

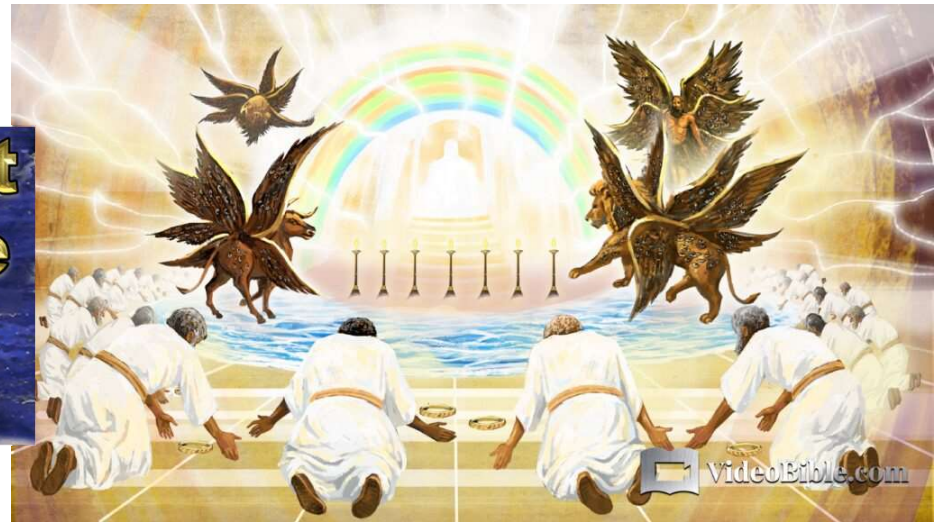


(Rev 11:15) *And the seventh **angel** sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our **Lord**, and of **his Christ**; and **he** shall reign for ever and ever.*

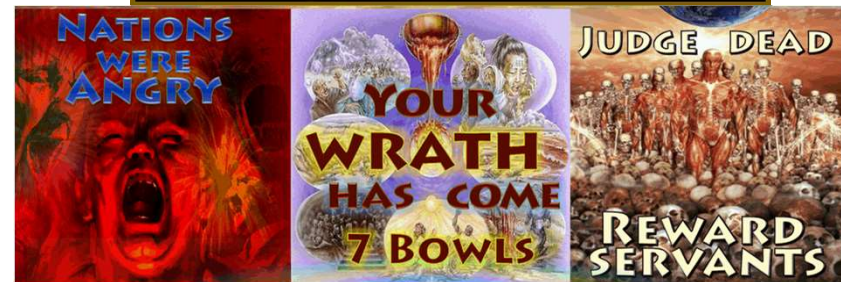


[This is what the Lord told us to pray for in the “**Lord’s Prayer**” (Mat. 6:10)... that the Father in Heaven’s Kingdom would come to earth. Jesus is the anointed (**Christ**) of God... anointed to reign forever.]

(Rev 11:16) And the **four and twenty elders**, **which** sat before **God** on **their** seats, fell upon **their** faces, and worshipped **God**, (17) Saying, **We** give **thee** thanks, O **Lord God Almighty**, **which** art (is), and wast (was), and art to come (future); because **thou** hast taken to **thee** **thy** great power, and hast reigned (king—ruled).



(Rev 11:18) And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead [Revelation 20:11-15], that they should be judged, and that thou shouldst give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldst destroy them which destroy the earth.



(Rev 11:19) And the temple of **God** was opened in heaven, and there was seen in **his** temple the ark of **his** testament (covenant—promise): and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail.
