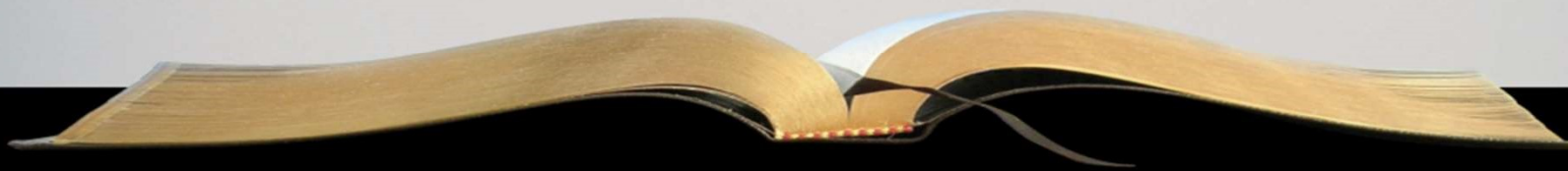


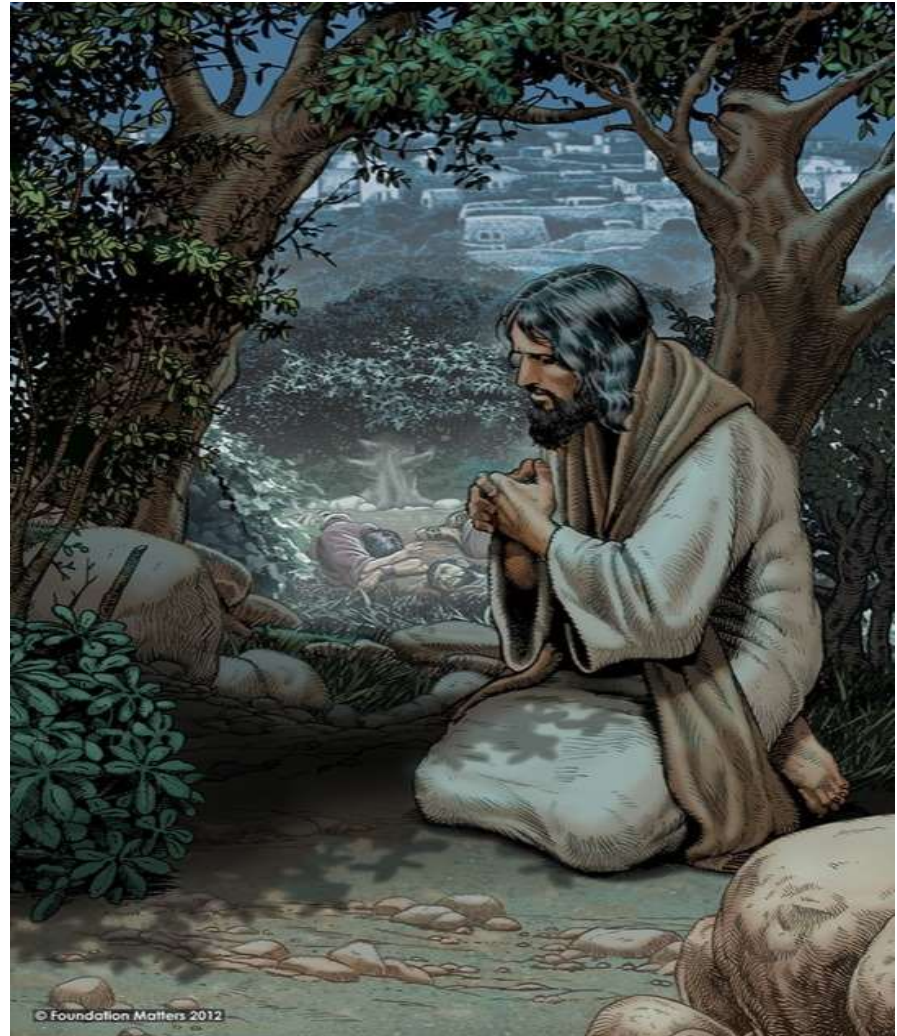
Lesson 46
Jesus Was Rejected.

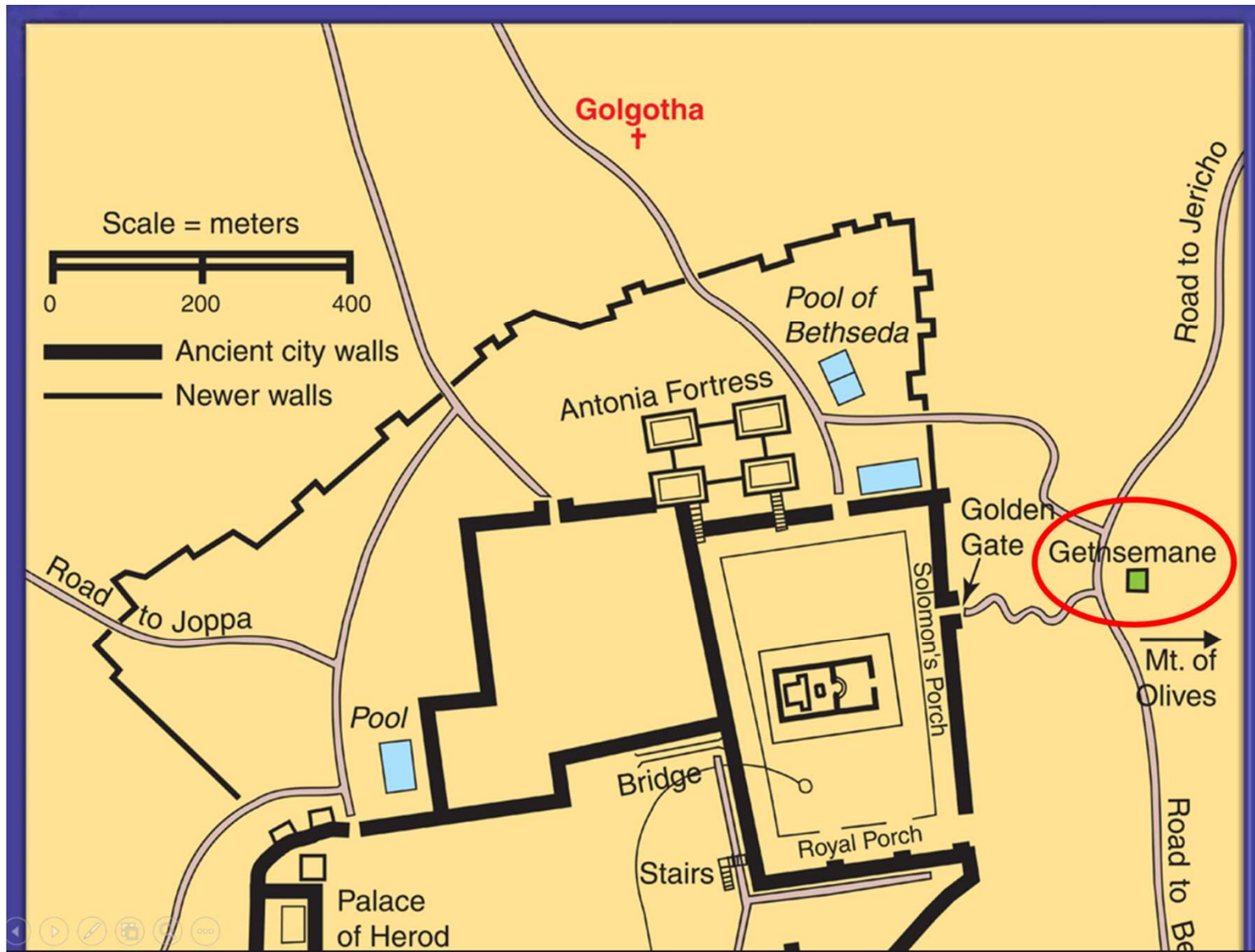


1. Jesus Prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane.

(Mark 14:32-33)

Jesus prayed, but
His disciples slept.

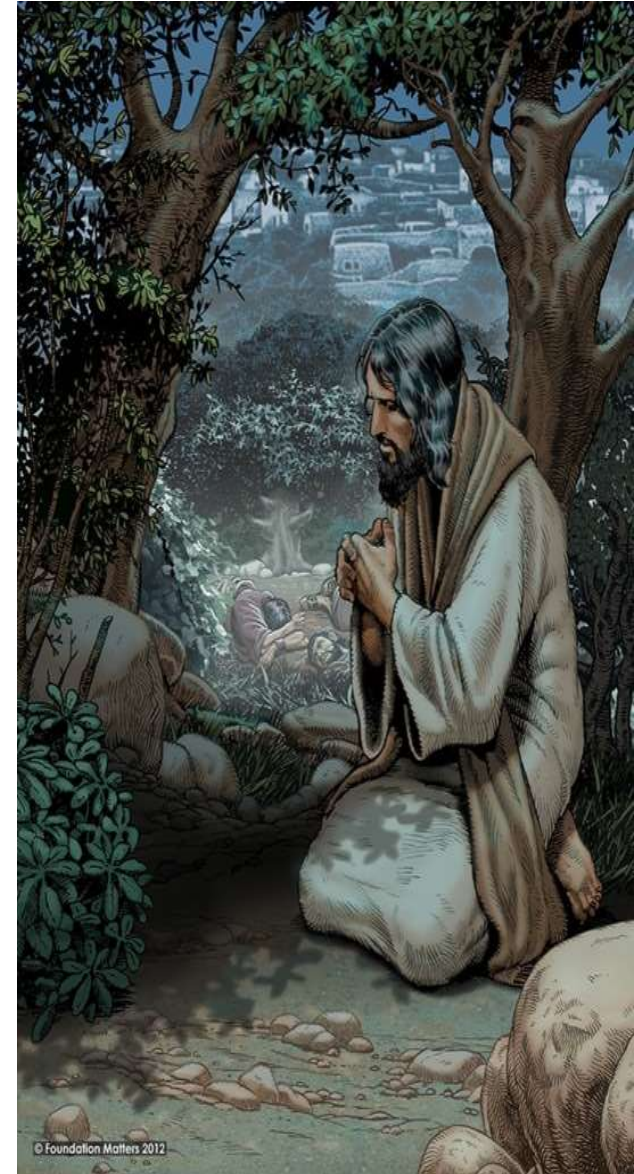




(Mark 14:34-36)

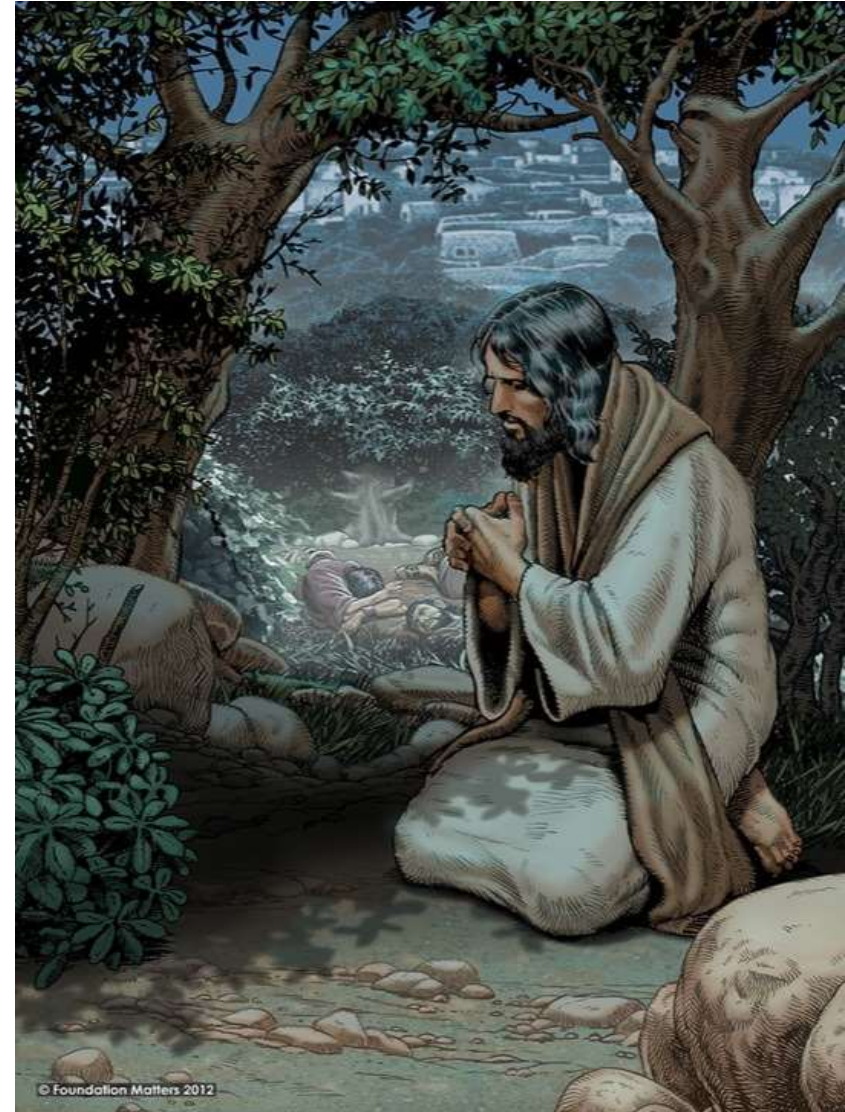
*Because Jesus was God, He knew that God had sent Him into the world to suffer and die for the sins of all people.

*Because Jesus was also man, His heart was very heavy and sad knowing that He would soon suffer death on the cross.

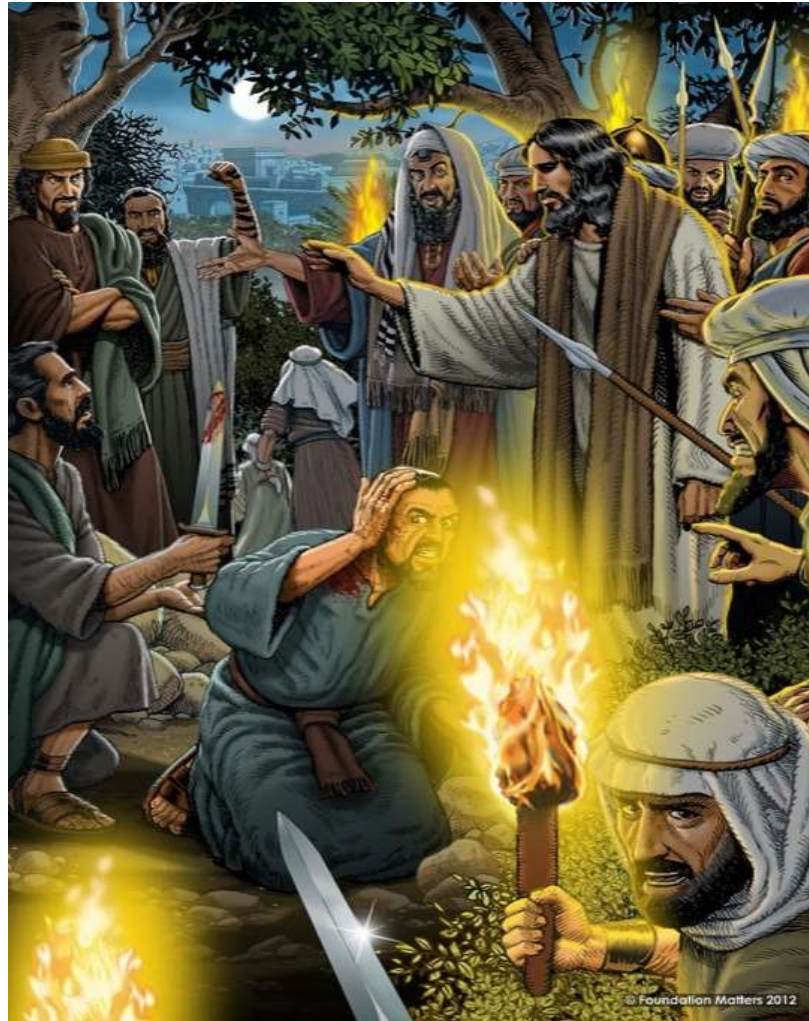


(Mark 14:37-42)

Jesus knew and told His disciples that Judas now was coming to betray Him.



2. Jesus Was Arrested (catch).



(Mark 14:43-52; Luke 22:3)

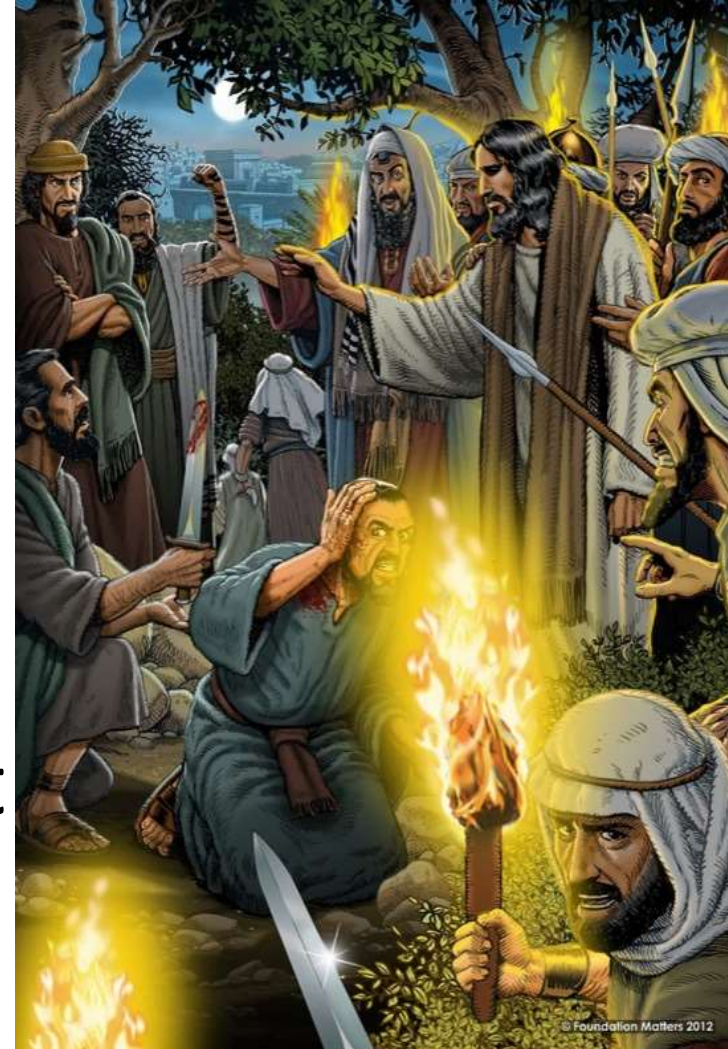
*Satan led Judas to betray Jesus.

*Judas kissed Jesus showing the soldiers to arrest Jesus.

*Peter attacked the soldiers, but Jesus allowed Himself to be betrayed and arrested.

*Jesus knew Scripture (**Bible**) about the Christ must be fulfilled.

*All the disciples escaped.



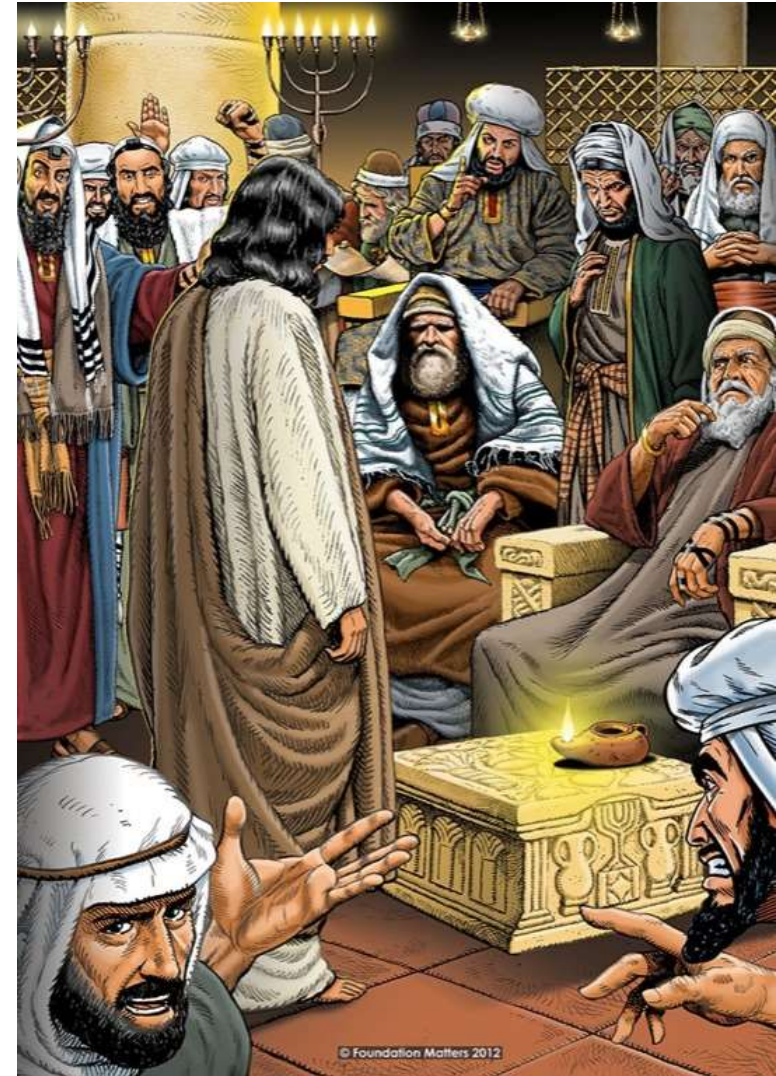
(Mark 14:53-59)

*Jesus was judged by the High Priest and Jewish leaders.

*They could find nothing wrong (sin) with Jesus.

*Jewish leaders hated Jesus because Jesus taught,

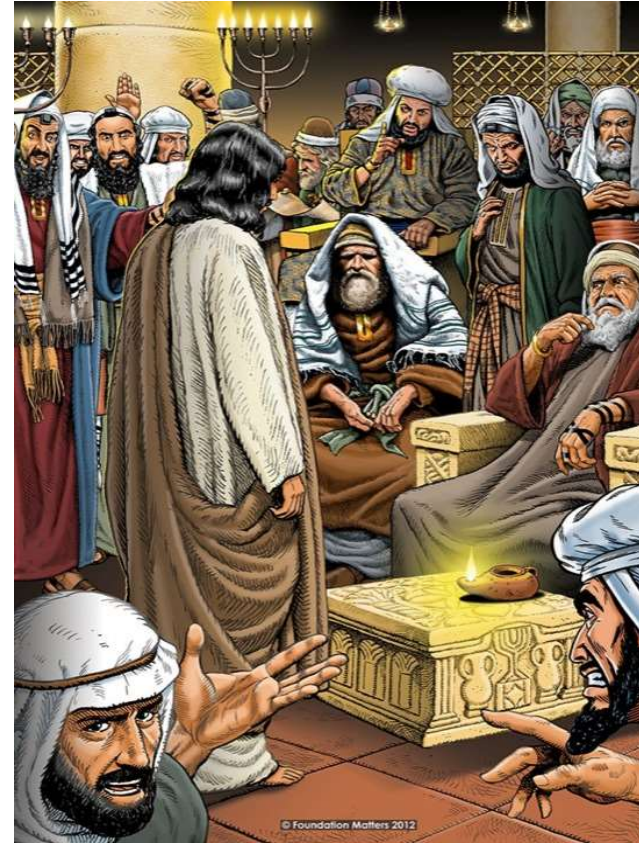
“You are sinners and hypocrites.”



(Mark 14:56-61)

*Many false witnesses spake lies against Jesus as was prophesied would happen hundreds of years before [Psalm 27:12].

*Jesus remained silent. He did not answer to those lying against Him.

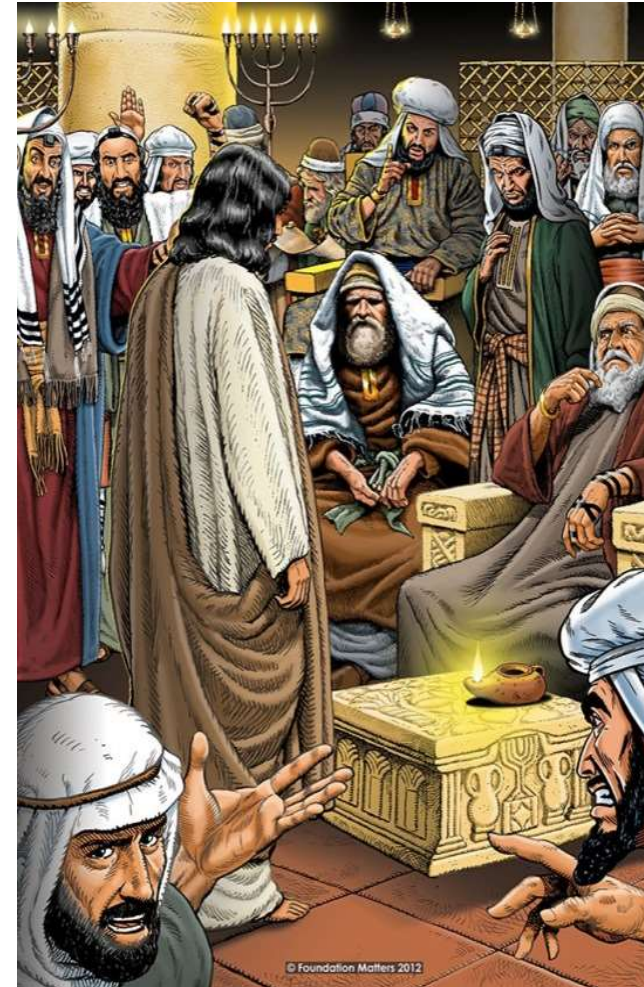
(Mark 14:61-62)

* Jewish leaders asked Jesus,
“Are **you Christ / God?**”

* Jesus answered, “Yes.”

* Jesus first coming: born as baby

* Jesus second coming: come as
Mighty God



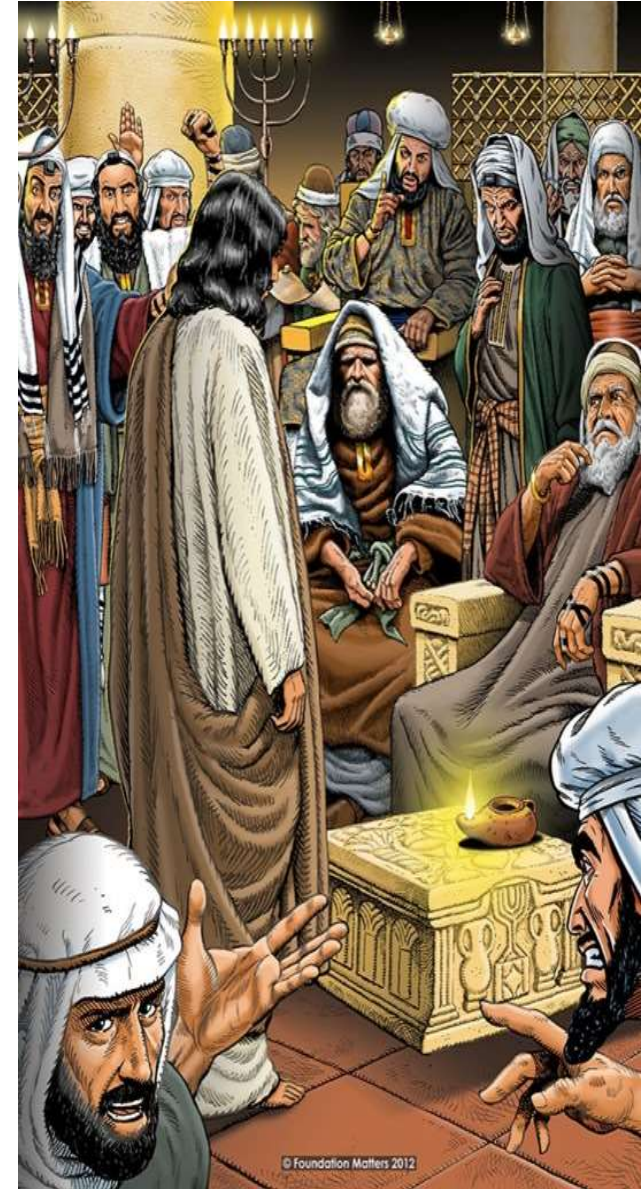
(Mark 14:63-64)

* Jewish leaders said Jesus spoke **blasphemy** (talk against/bad God).

* Because the leaders did not believe Jesus was God, they said He must die for blaspheming.

(Mark 14:65)

The Jews shamed Jesus by spitting on Him and hitting Him.

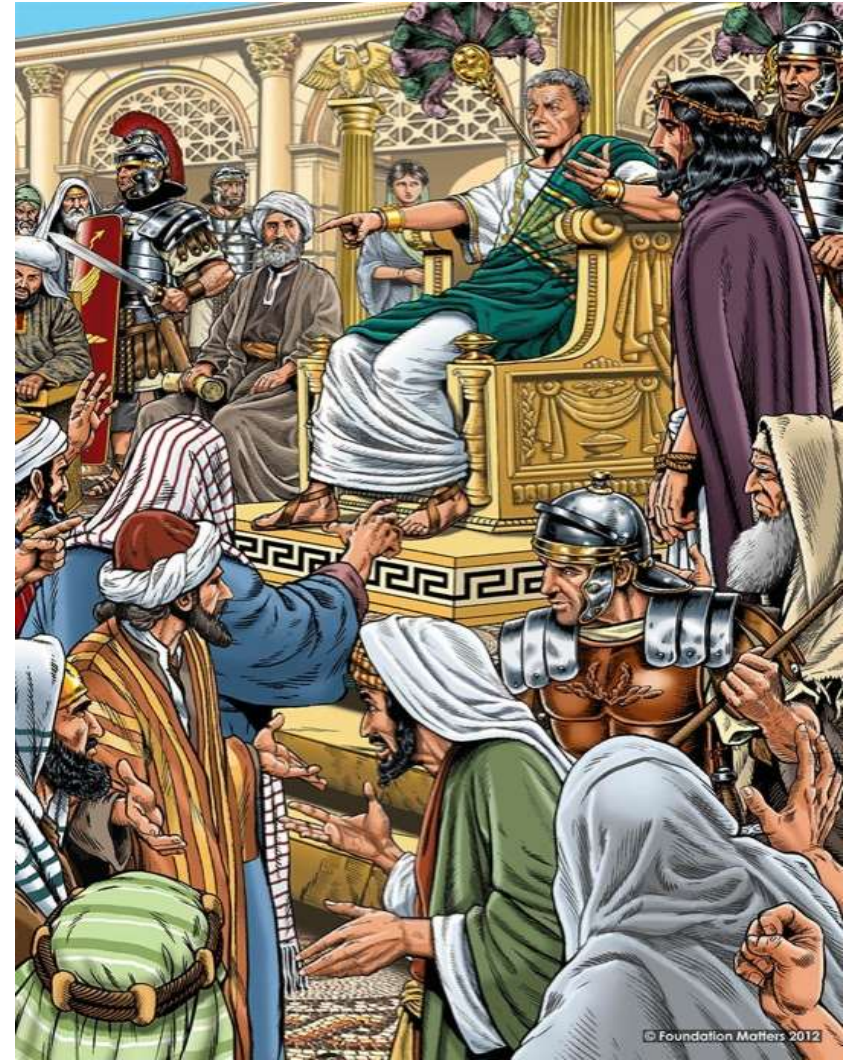
Mark 14:65

*Jesus was judged by Pilate
(**Roman governor**).

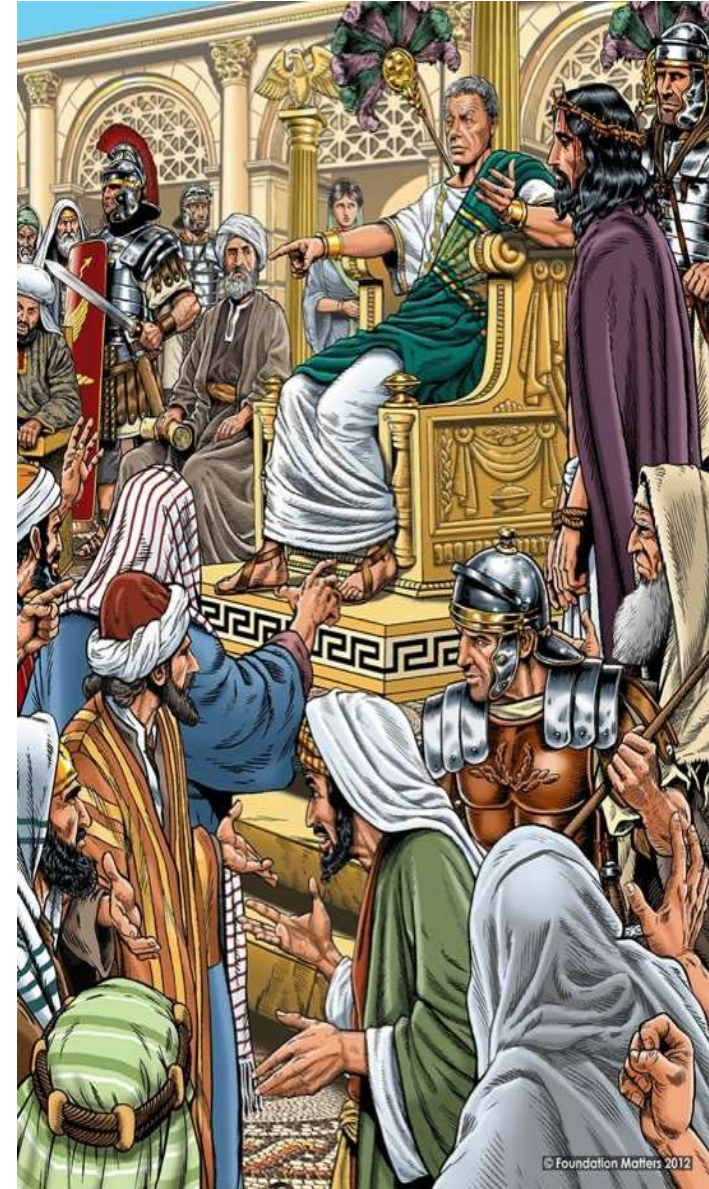
*Only Rome had authority
(**power**) to kill Jesus.

(Israel was under Roman rule.)



(Mark 15:2)
Pilate asked if Jesus was
“King of the Jews.”

***Jesus said, “Yes.”**

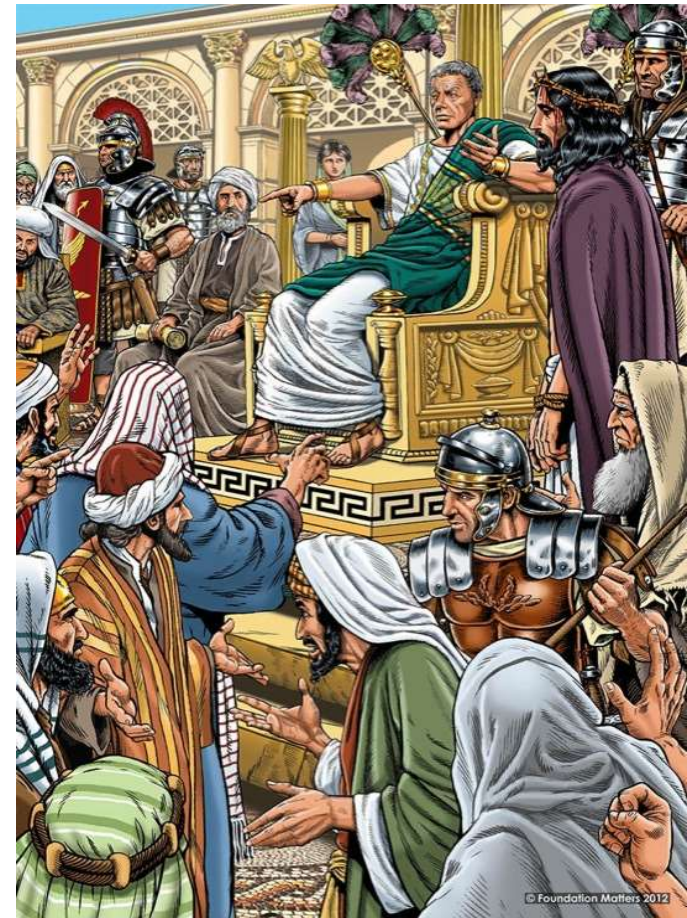


(Mark 15:3-5)

The Jewish leaders told many lies
to Pilate against Jesus.

*Jesus did not answer them.

*Jesus was silent before
the false accusers.

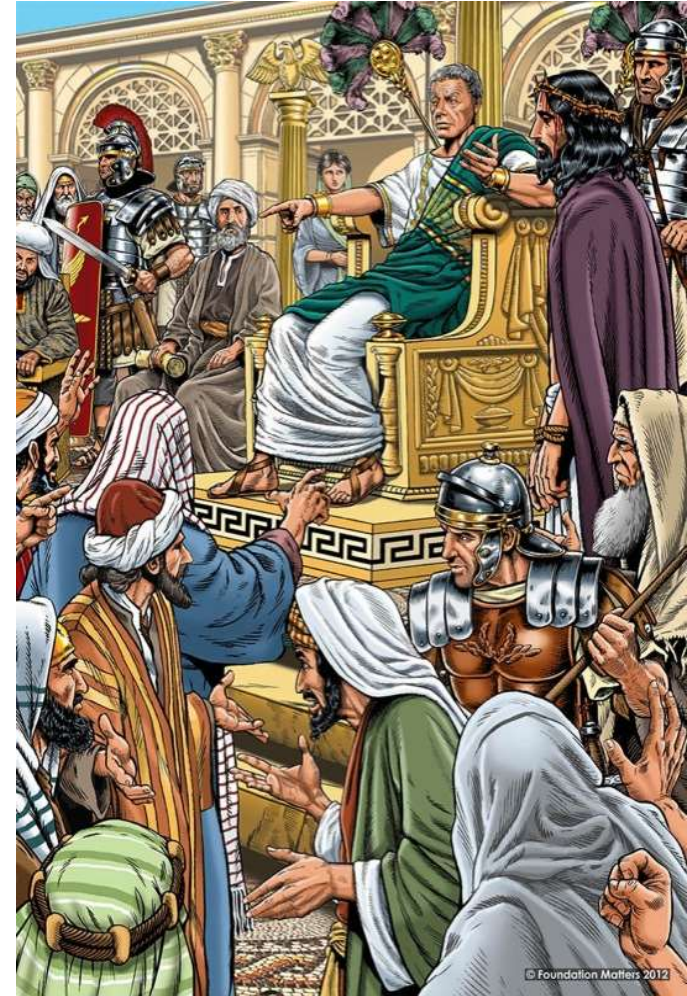
Mark 15:3-5

Pilate asked the Jews: “Should I free Barabbas or Jesus?”

(Barabbas was a murderer.)

The Jews asked for Barabbas to be freed; they **rejected** Jesus.

*Pilate found no wrong (**sin**) in Jesus. He asked, “Why kill Jesus; why do you hate Jesus?”

*The Jews gave no good answer.

*They hated Jesus and wanted Him to be crucified.

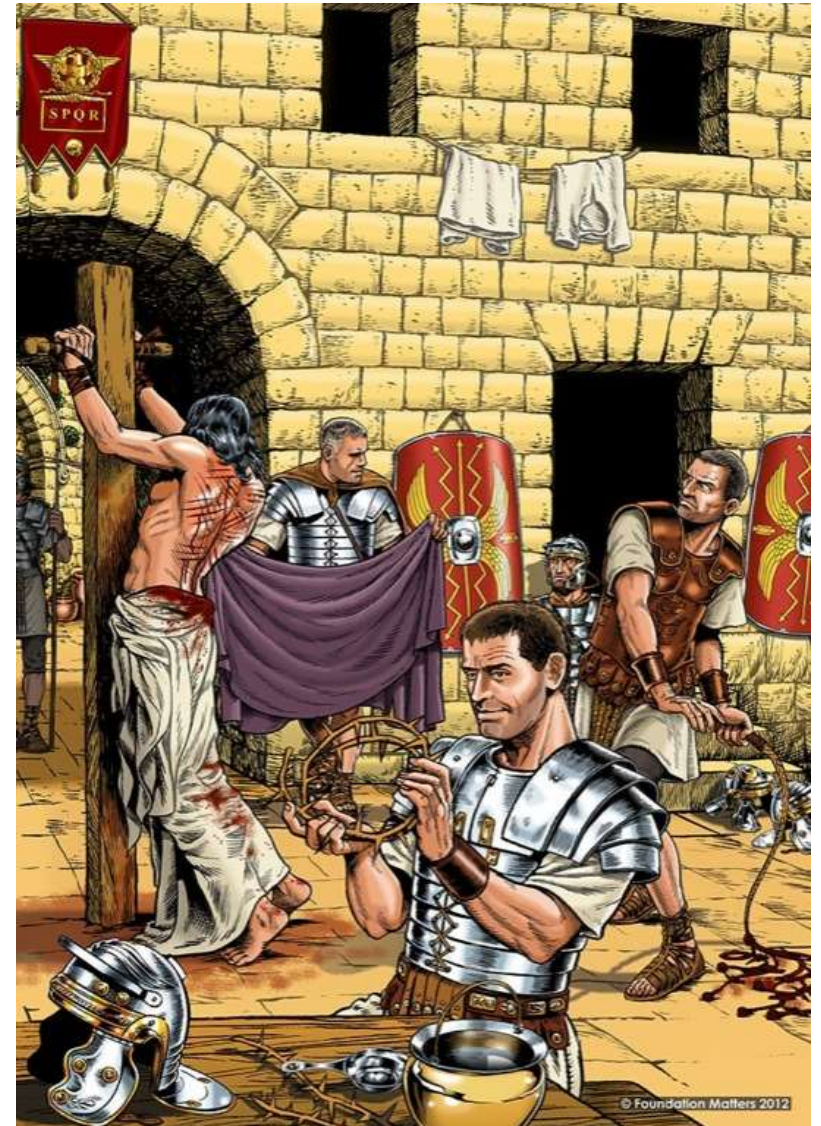
Be hated without cause

*Jesus was whipped.

*The Roman soldiers put a purple robe and a crown of thorns on Jesus and worshipped him as a king.
(laughing at Jesus)



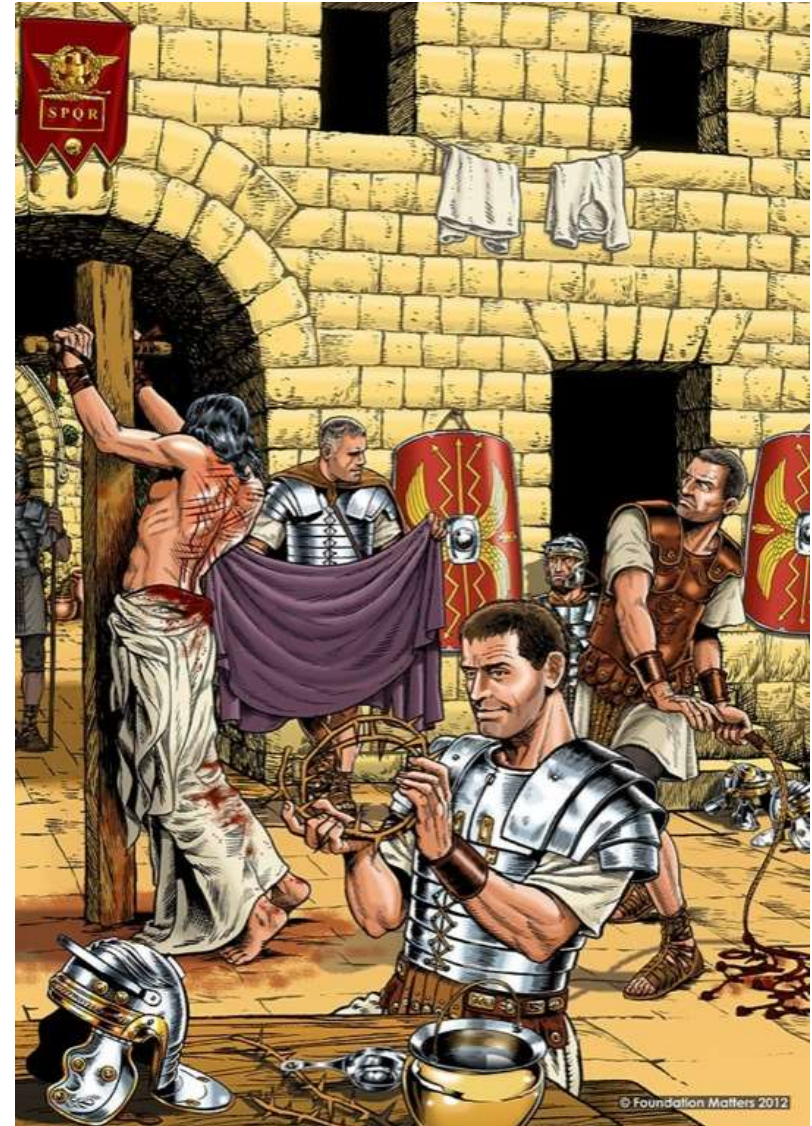
(Mark 15:15-19)

*Why was Jesus whipped?

(Isaiah 53:5)

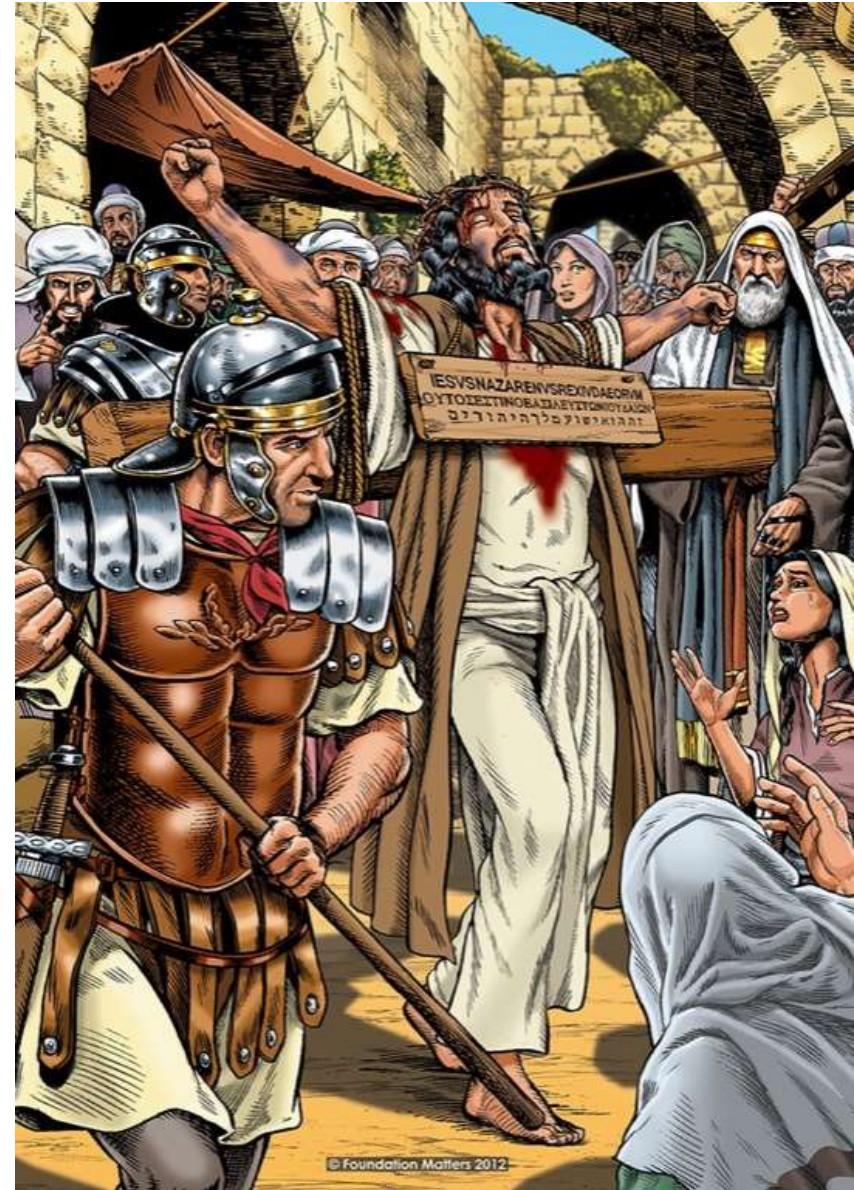
*“But he was wounded for **our transgressions**, he was bruised for **our iniquities**: the **chastisement** (*punishment*) of our peace (*resulting in our good*) was upon him (*Jesus*); and with his (*Jesus’s*) stripes we are **healed.**”*

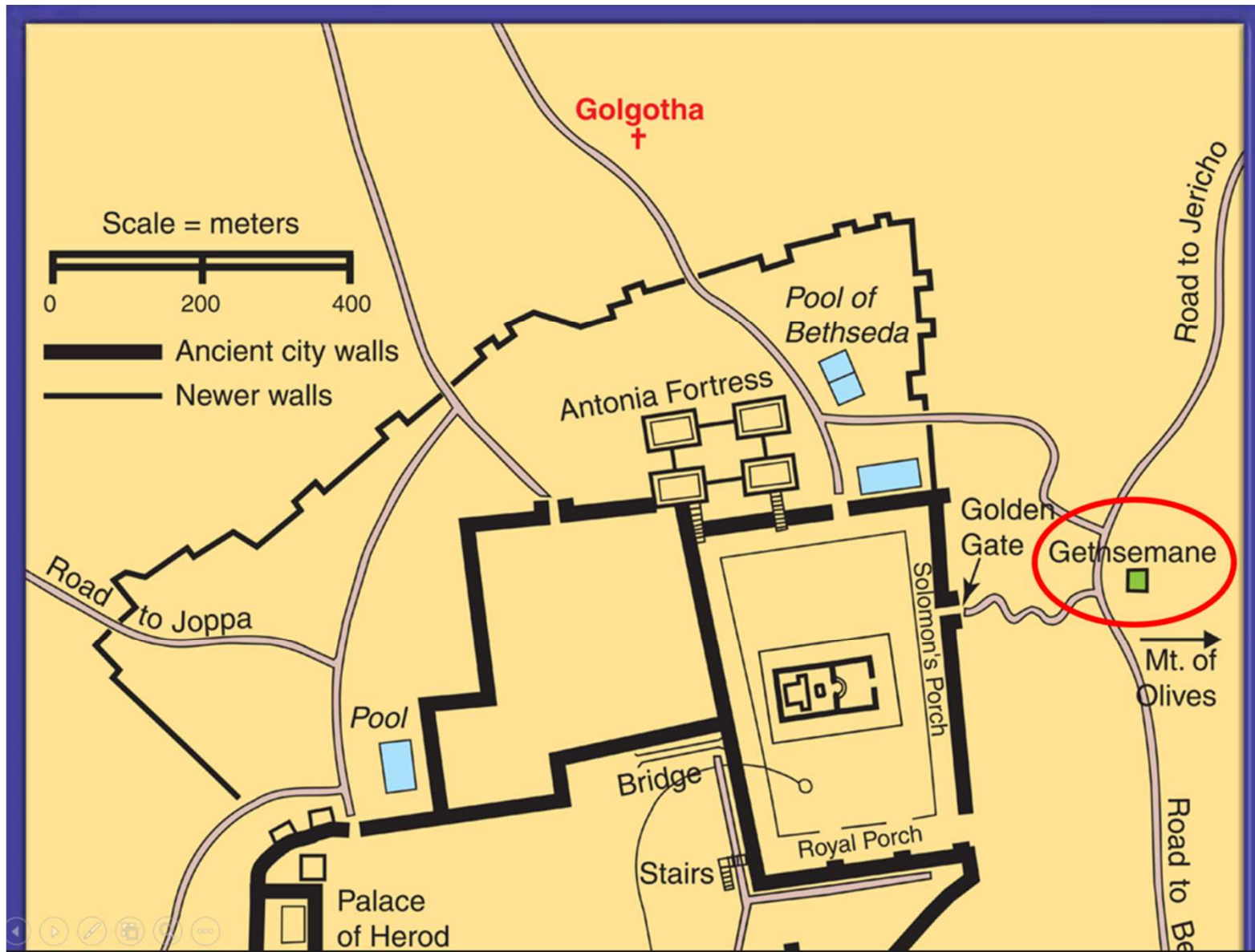
(Save us from our sins.)



(Mark 15:20)

The Roman soldiers put a cross on Jesus back and took Him to a hill to be crucified.





Why did Jesus die (**crucified**) for us?

(John 3:16)

*“For God so loved the world, that he (**God**) gave his only begotten (**come from Heaven**) Son (**Jesus**), that whosoever (**all people**) believeth in him (**Son/Jesus**) should not perish (**die**), but have everlasting life.”*
