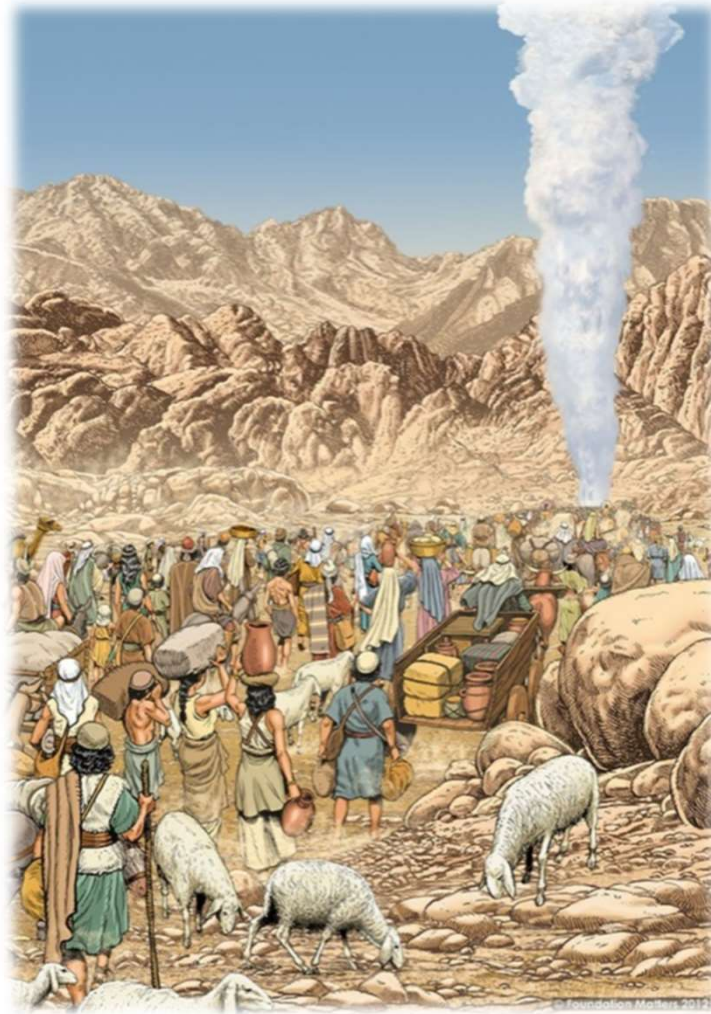

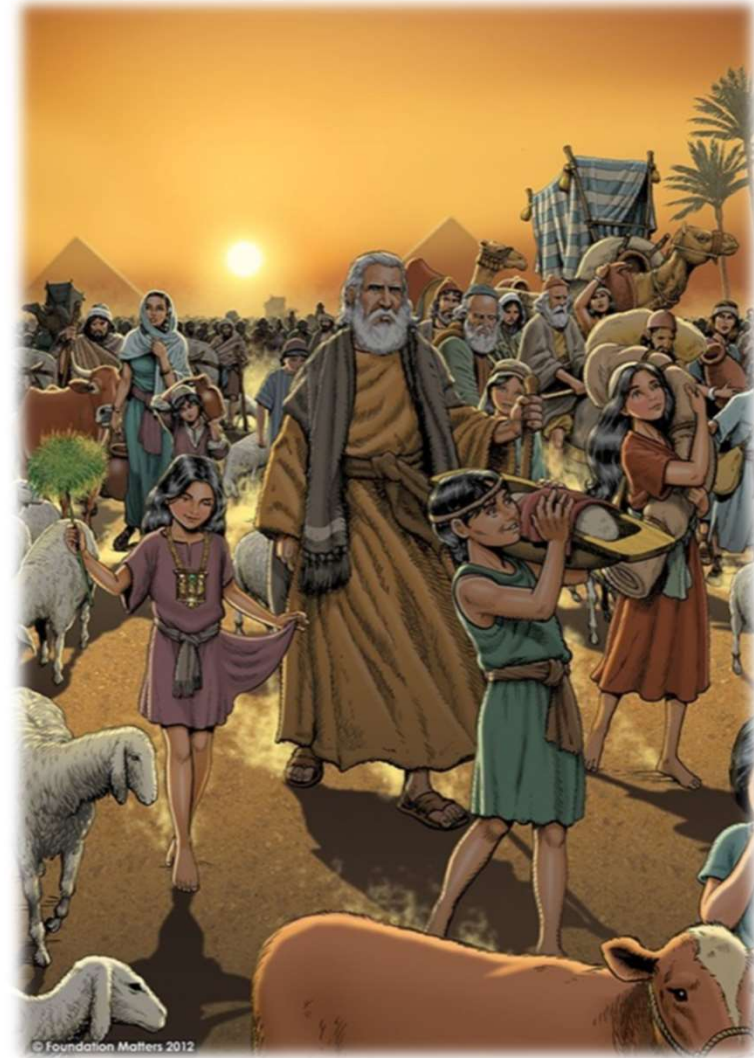

1. A Pillar of Cloud and Fire

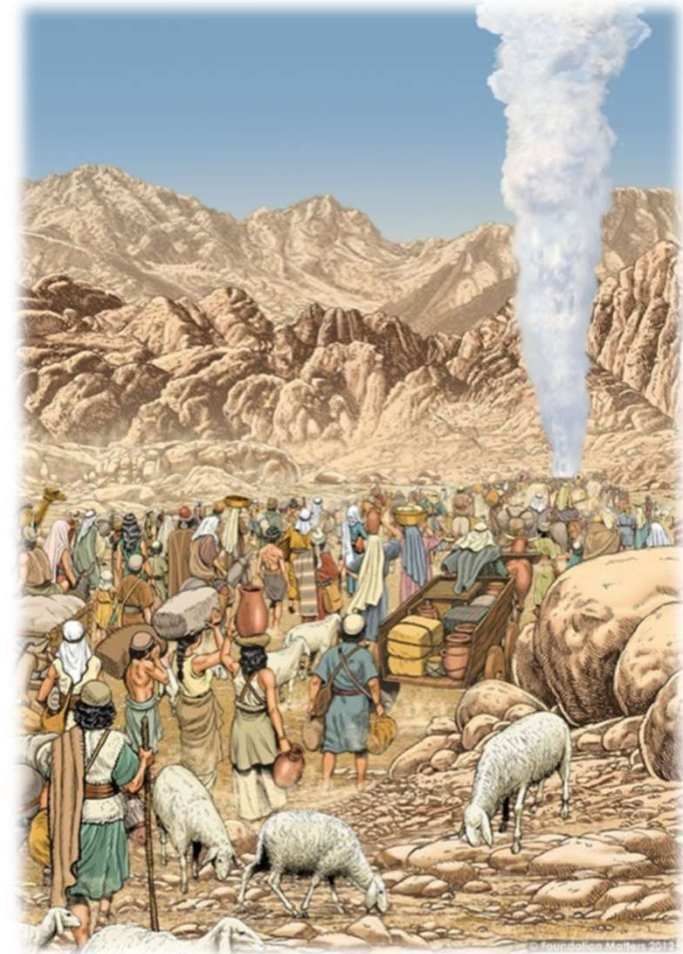


1. God was completing His promises to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob by saving Israel out from slavery in Egypt.
 2. God would send Jesus through Israel.
 3. God would give the Bible through Israel.
- *25 Lakh Israelites (25,00,000) came out from Egypt.



(Exodus 13:21-22)

Through the wilderness (**empty land**),
God Led the Israelites with a **pillar
of a cloud** during the day, and God
led them with a **pillar of fire** during
the night.

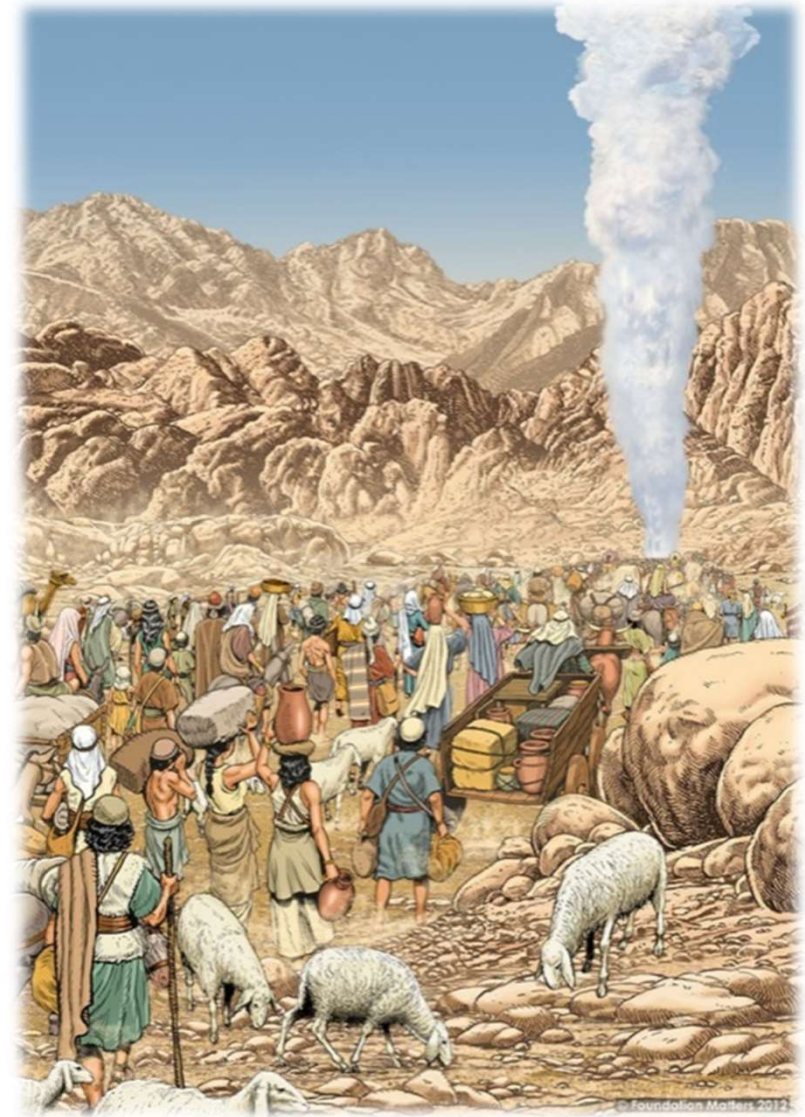


2. The Red Sea



(Exodus 14)

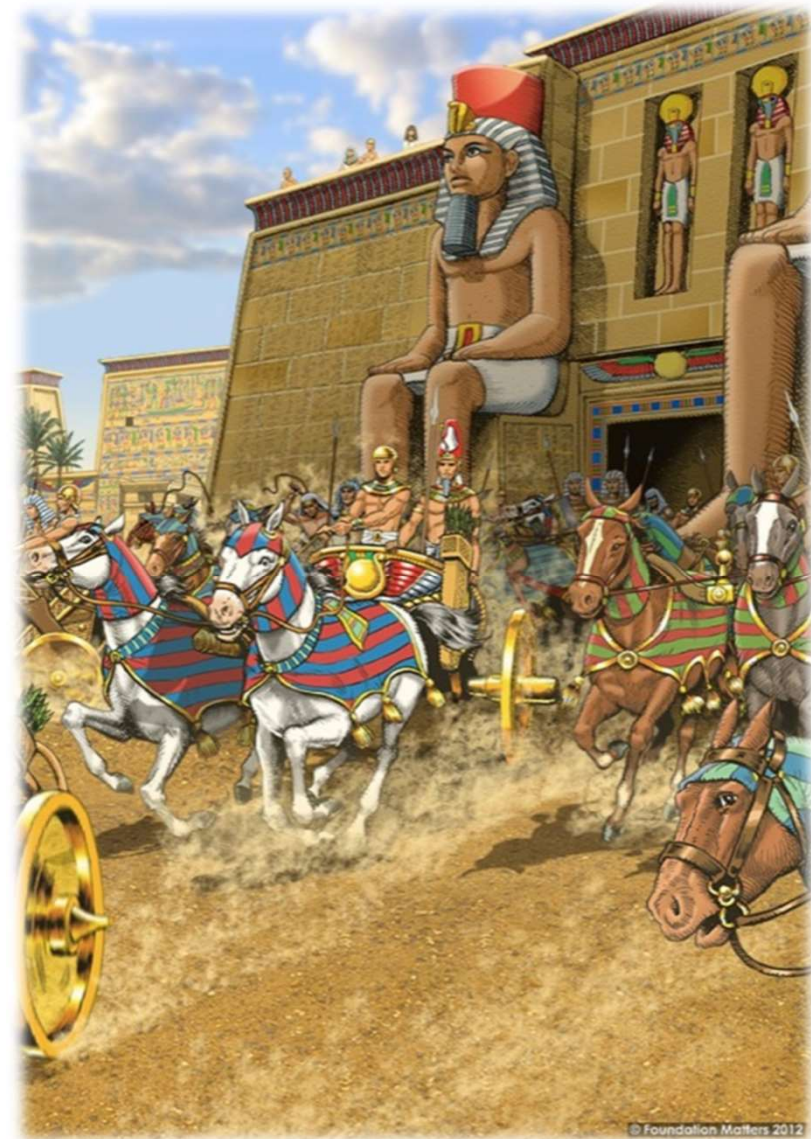
God led Israel out of Egypt
and to the Red Sea.



(Exodus 14:5-7)

Pharaoh changed his mind;
Pharaoh wanted again to take
Israel into slavery in Egypt.

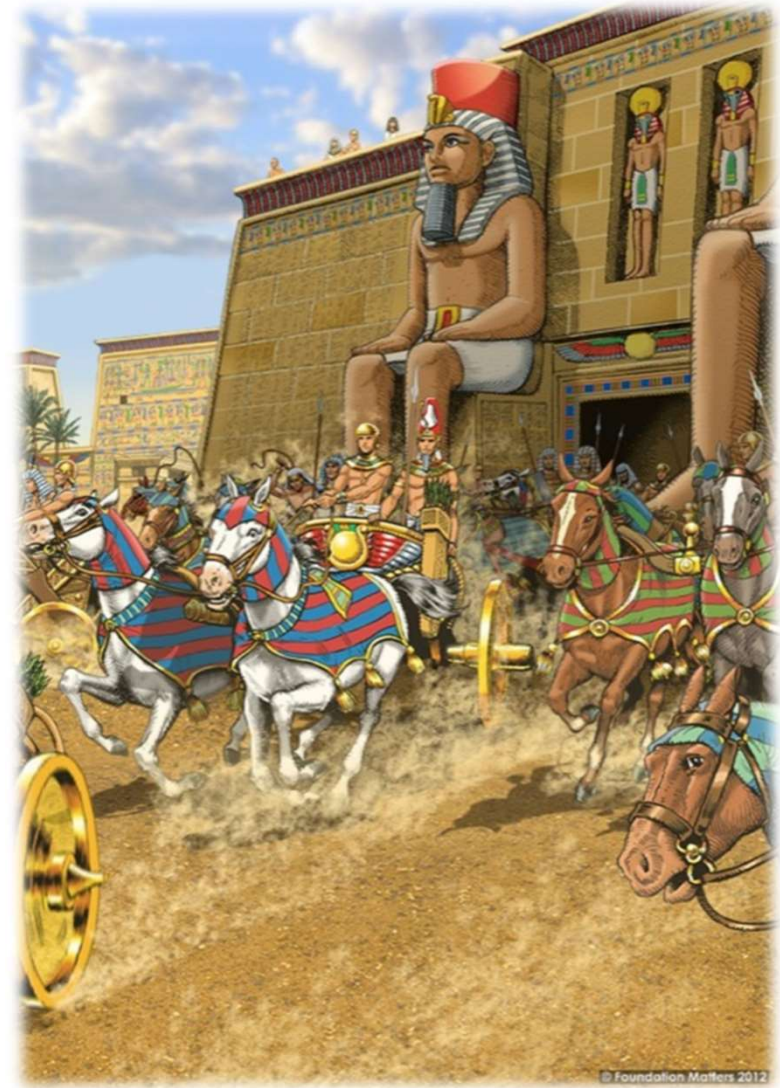
Pharaoh chased the Israelites
with his army and 600 chariots.



(Exodus 14:10-11)

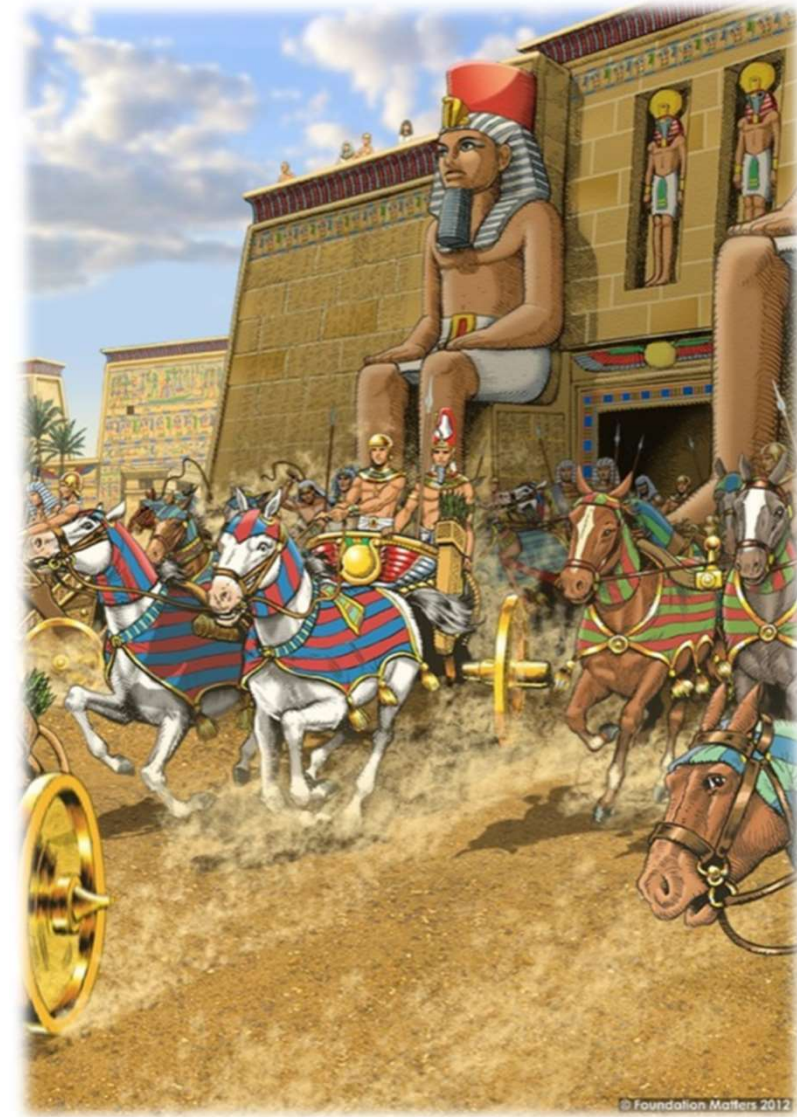
Israel was very afraid when they saw Pharaoh's army coming.

Israel was blocked by the Red Sea—no escape; Israel complained against Moses.



(Exodus 14:13-14)

Moses told Israel, “Don’t be afraid. God will fight for you; God will save you.”



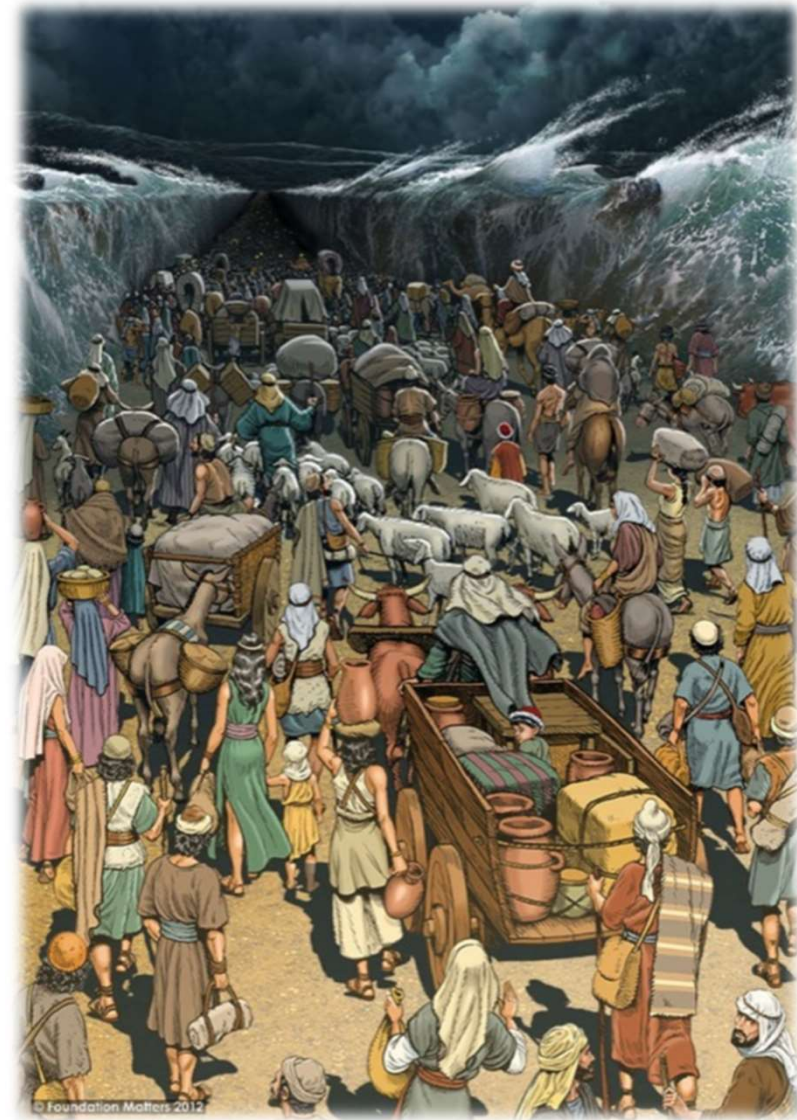
3. Through the Red Sea



(Exodus 14:19-22)

God divided the Red Sea.

Israel walked through the Red Sea on dry ground.



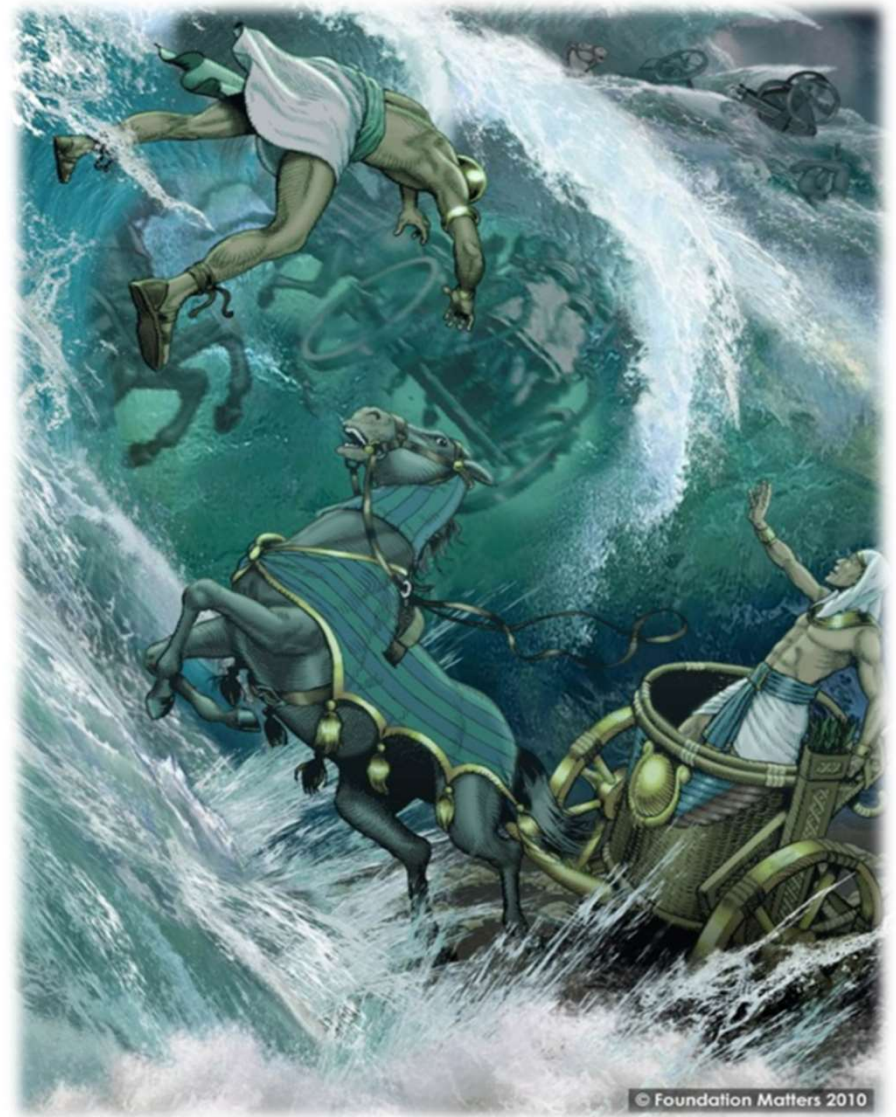
(Exodus 14:23-25)

The Egyptians chased Israel
through the Red Sea.



(Exodus 14:26-28)

God crashed the Red Sea upon the Egyptians and destroyed them.

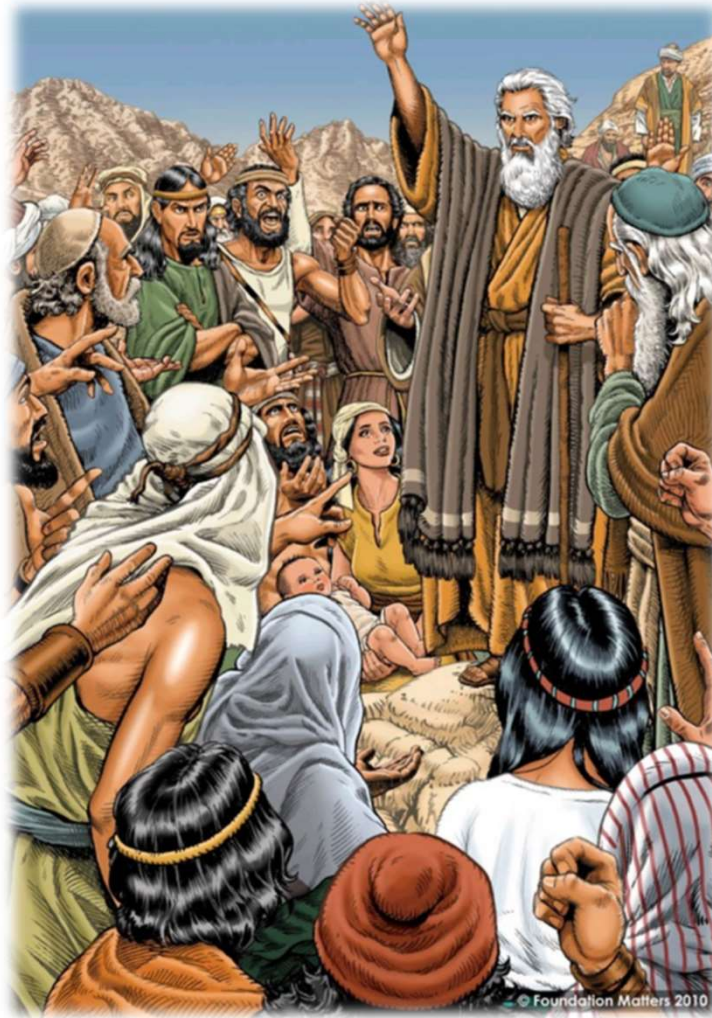


(Exodus 14:31)

*(31) And Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and **the people (Israel)** feared the LORD, and believed the LORD, and his servant Moses.*

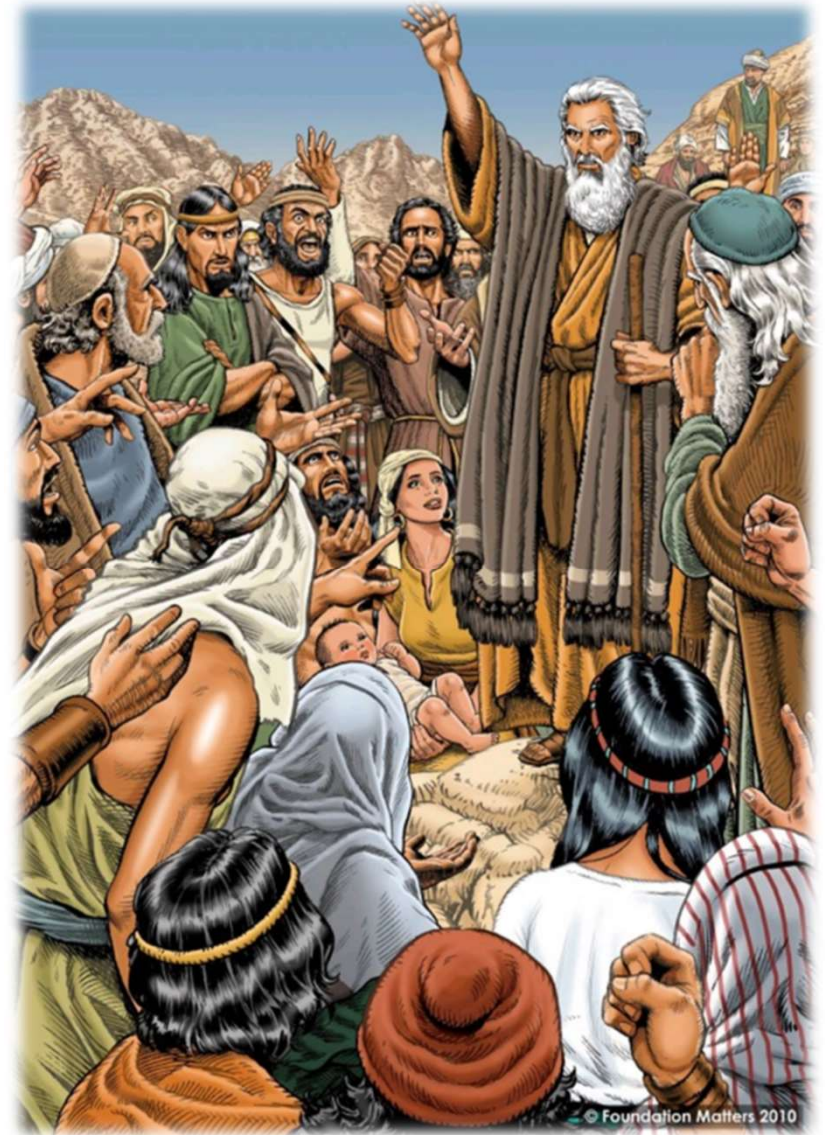


4. God's Provision in the Wilderness



(Exodus 16:2-3)

Because there was no food, Israel complained against Moses.

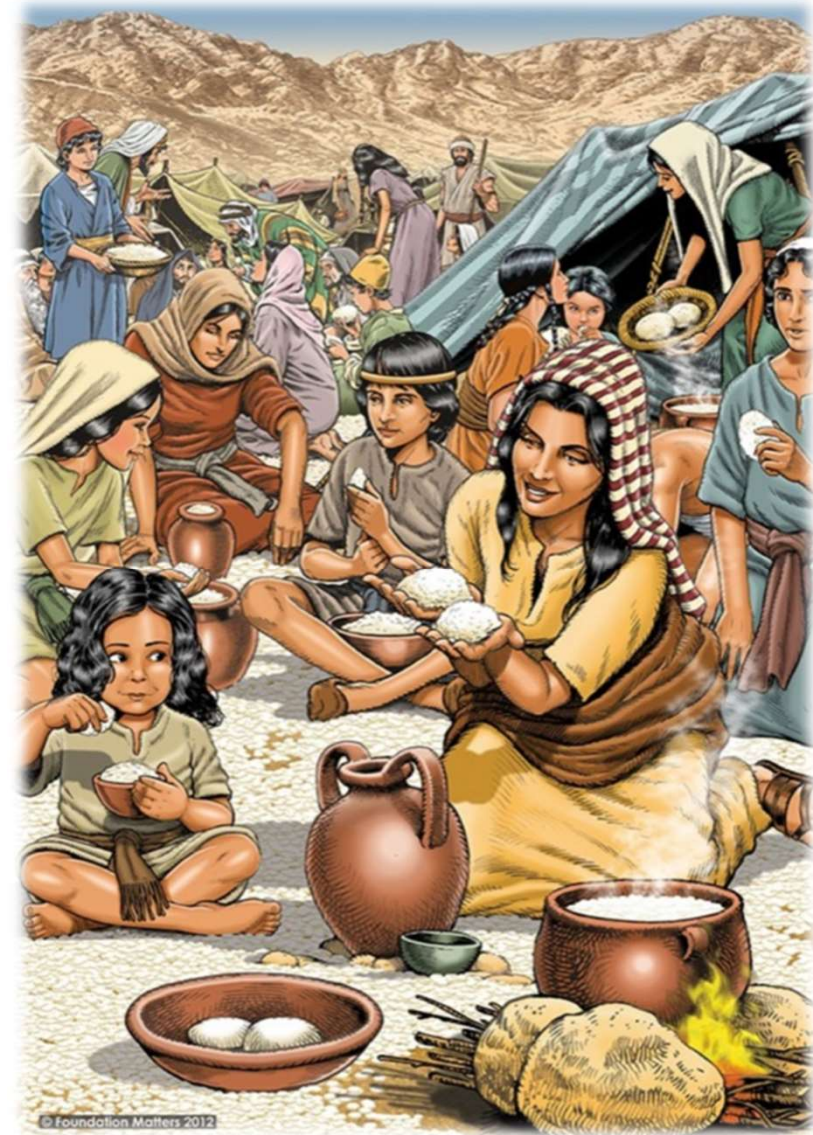


(Exodus 16:14-15, 35)

God sent Israel food from Heaven.

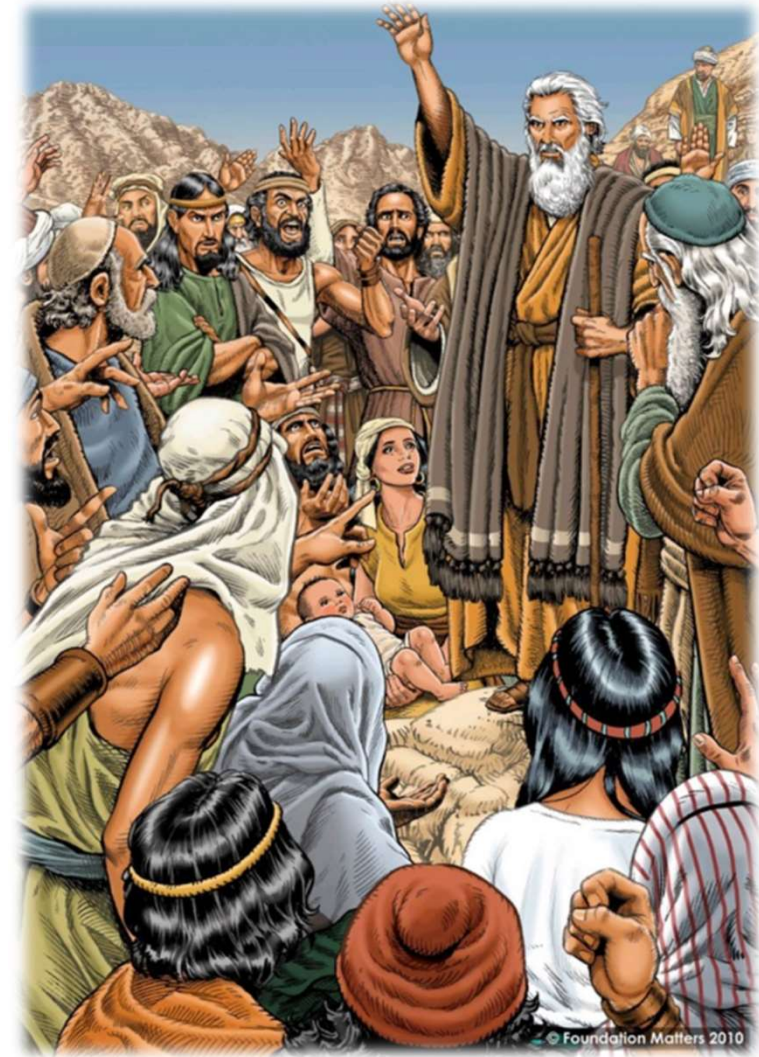
The food was like bread—its name was **manna**.

God gave this manna to Israel to eat every day for forty years.



(Exodus 17:1-4)

Because there was no water,
Israel complained against Moses.



(Exodus 17:5-6; Psalm 105:41)

God told Moses to hit the rock.

After Moses hit the rock, much water came out of the rock.

All Israel drank the water.
