
Lesson 43 Come to Jesus As Children With Humility and Faith

1. Jesus Loves Children.



(Mark 10:13-14)

Jesus wanted the children to come to Him.



(Mark 10:15-16)

Christians are the same as children.

Children = humble, believing, and depending

2. Jesus Taught a Rich Young Man.



(Mark 10:17)

The man asked Jesus how to have eternal life.

The man thought he was very good...

...The man thought he maybe must do

one more good thing to have eternal life.




(Mark 10:18)

Jesus answered him, "Why do you call me good?

Only God is good (holy)."


Jesus wanted the man to understand that He is God—and good/holy.



(Mark 10:19-20)
Jesus asked the young man,
"Are you perfect?"

*The man must understand that he was a sinner who had <u>NOT</u> perfectly obeyed God's laws.

*God gave to Israel the <u>Law to show all people are sinners.</u>



(Mark 12:30-31)

Jesus knew the man was a sinner. (NOT love God and others)

(Mark 10:21-22)

Test of perfection: Go sell own things and give to the poor (love others).


Test of perfection: Go sell own things and **follow Jesus** (love God).



Jesus loved this man and wanted the man to be:

- 1. Humble: "Yes, I have sinned"
- 2. Believing: "Yes, Jesus is God and Saviour"
- 3. Dependent: "Yes, Jesus only can give me

eternal life"



(Mark 10:22-24)

The man failed the test of perfection.

*The young man chose <u>NOT</u> to be <u>humble</u>, <u>believe</u>, and <u>depend on Jesus</u>.

*The man did not want to repent (change).

*It is hard for rich, strong, and smart people to have eternal life... because they trust in own riches, power, and mind... and do NOT trust in Jesus.
