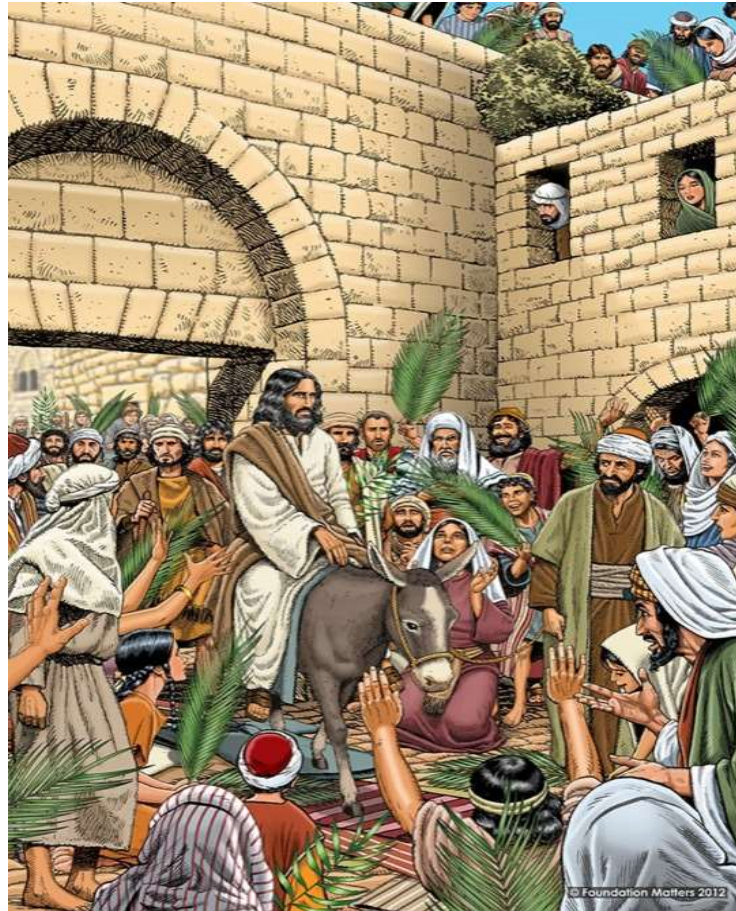


Lesson 45

Judas Betrays Jesus.



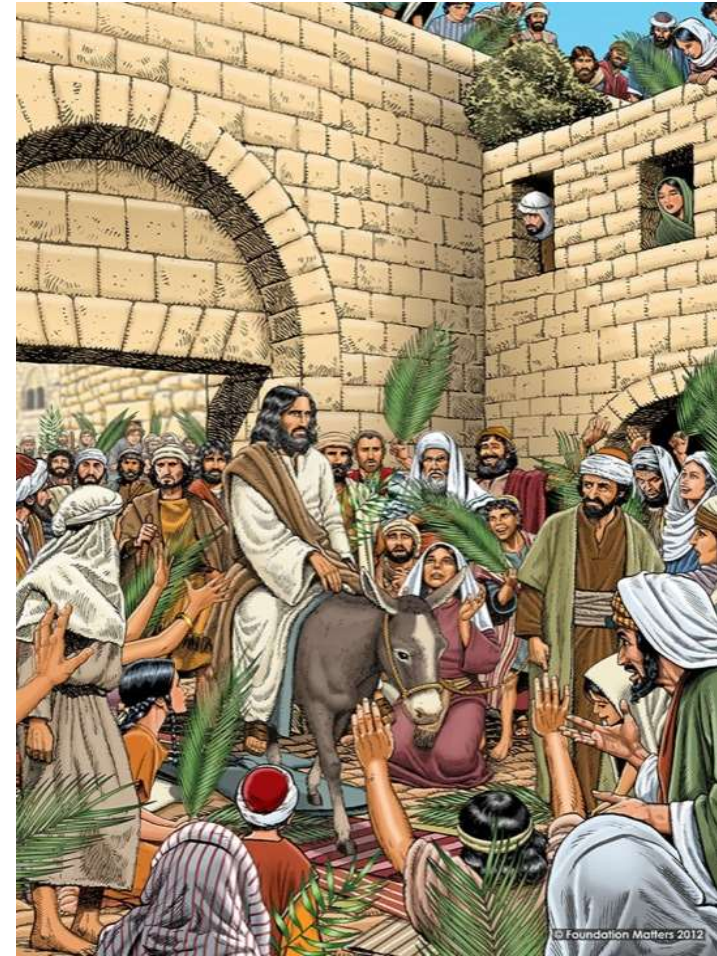
1. The People Welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem As Their King and Christ.



(Mark 11:1-10)

*Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey and was received as King. But this was the same as when Jesus fed 5,000 people.

*The people wanted Jesus to give them worldly riches, but they did NOT want to repent of their sins.

Judas, a friend and disciple of Jesus, offered to betray Jesus.

The Jewish leaders gave 30 pieces of silver to Judas to betray Jesus.

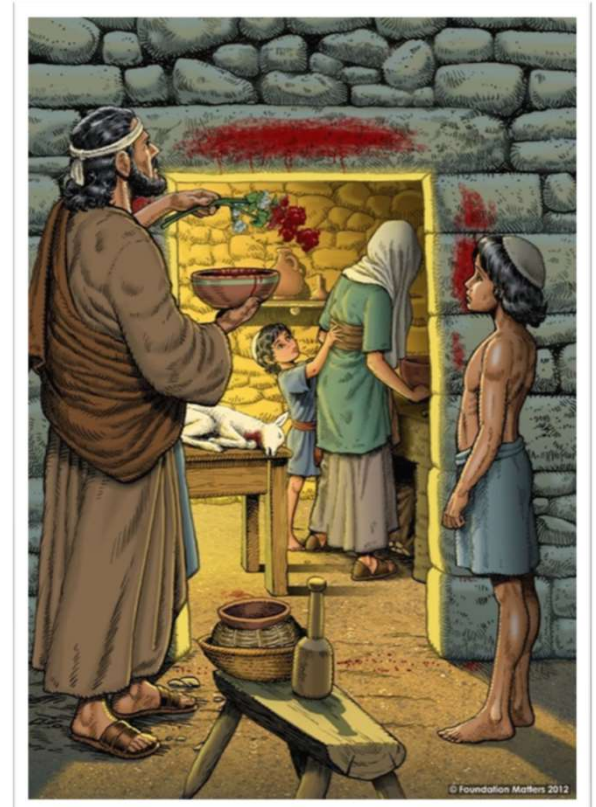

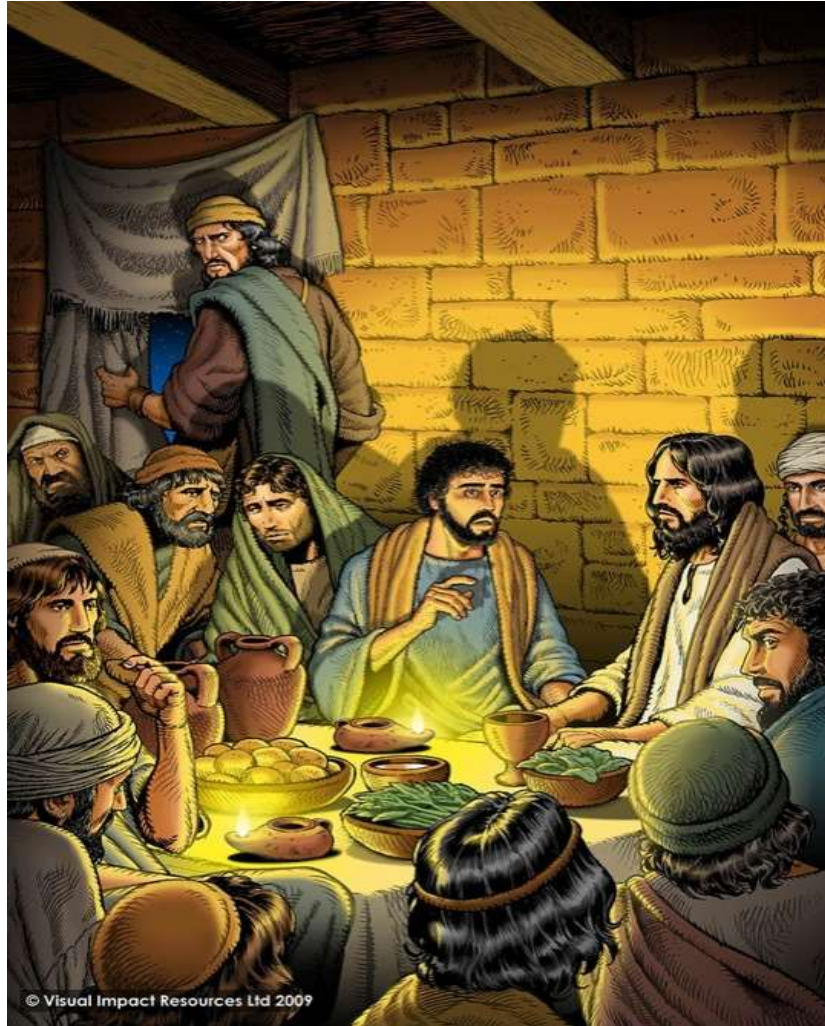
3. Jesus Sent the Disciples to Prepare for the Passover Feast.

Passover



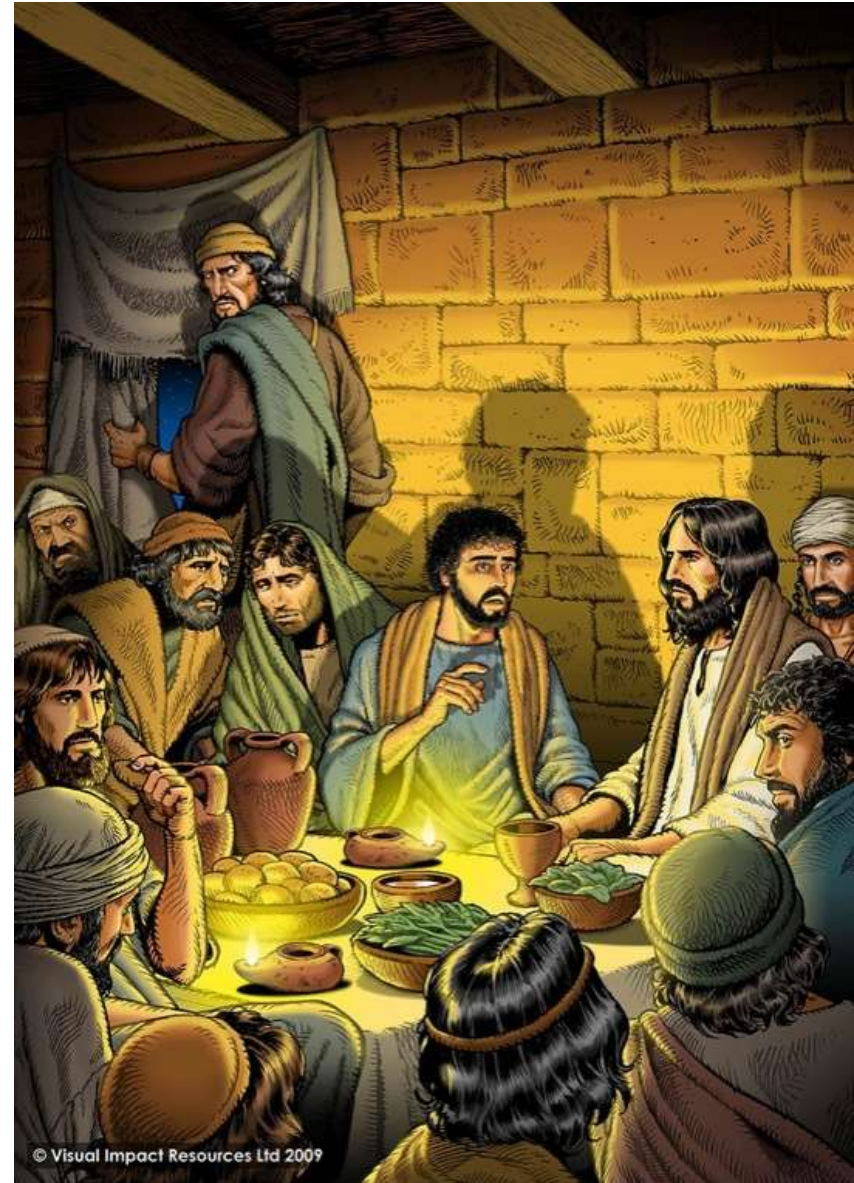
4. Jesus Knew That Judas Planned to Betray Him.



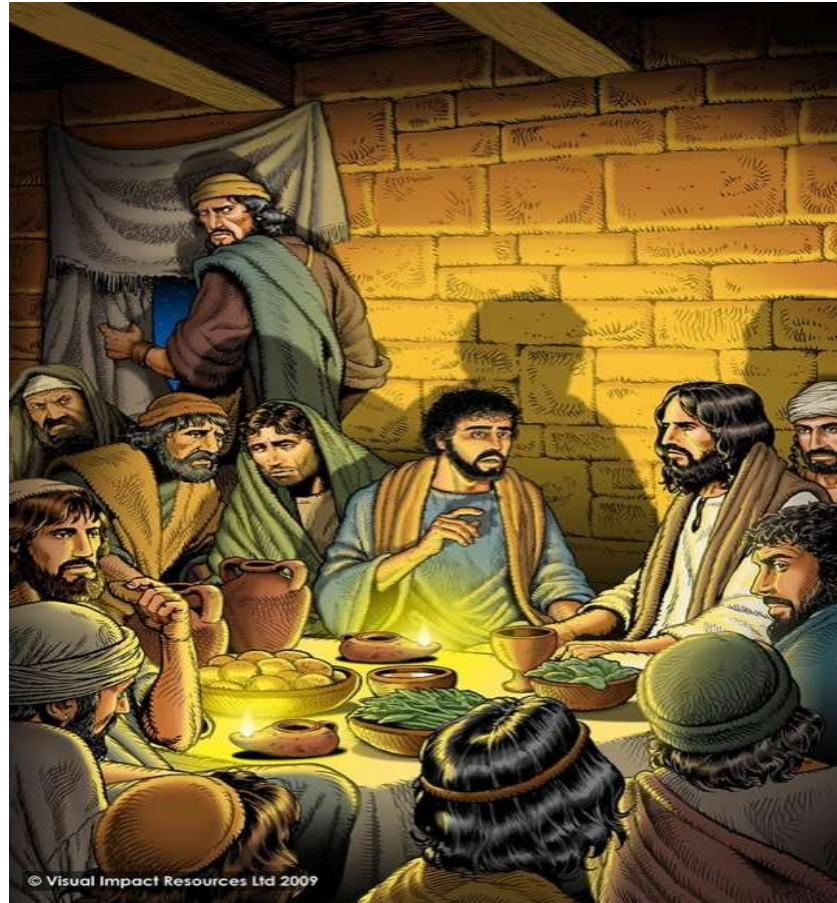
(Mark 14:18-21)

*Jesus knew Judas's heart.

*During supper Jesus said that one of His disciples would betray Him.



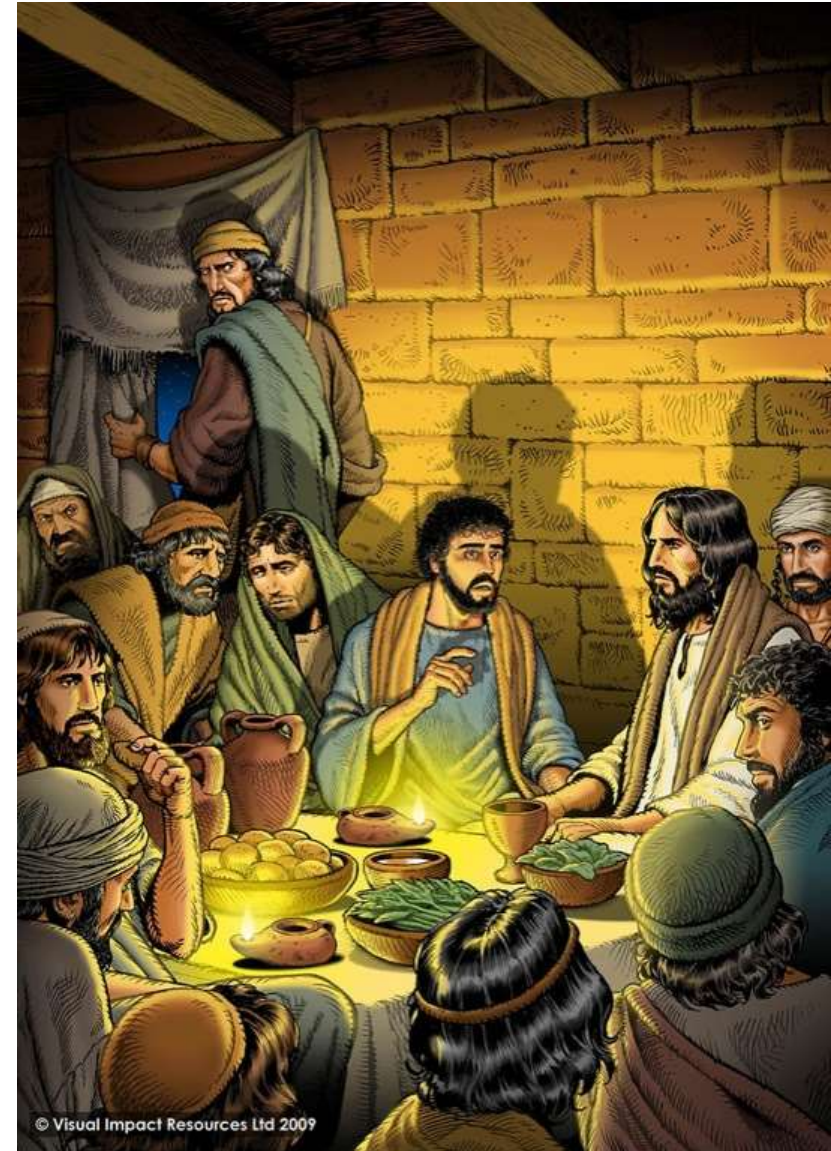
**5. Jesus Started “Lord’s Supper”.
He Taught About the Bread and Cup.**



(Mark 14:22)

Bread = Jesus body broken

As the Passover lamb was killed and **eaten** (received), so also must Jesus be killed for the sins of the world and **believed upon** (received).



(Mark 14:23-24)

Cup = Jesus blood

*Jesus bought us with
His own blood.

*Jesus's blood is the promise
of our salvation.
