
## God Saw a Difference Between Believing and Unbelieving Israel

(Matthew 3:8-12)



(Matt. 3:8-9) John the Baptist: [You, Israelites] Bring forth therefore fruits (proof) meet (good) for repentance (turn to faith in God): And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father (Israelite): for I [John Baptist] Say unto you [Israelites], that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.

God can make people; but God has given people the responsibility to repent—chose to believe His Word.

(Matt. 3:10) And now also the axe is <u>laid</u> <u>unto</u> (ready to cut) the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth <u>good fruit</u> (proof of repentance / faith in God's Word) is <u>hewn</u> (cut) down, and

cast into the fire.

(Matt. 3:11) / (John Baptist) indeed (truly) baptize you with water unto (for showing) repentance (turn to faith in God): but he (Jesus) that cometh after me is mightier (more strong) than I, whose shoes I am not worthy (important) to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with **fire**:

## **Believing Israel** Belongs to God

(Matt. 3:12) Whose (Jesus) fan [Cross] is in his hand, and he will throughly (full) purge [judge] his floor [world], and gather his wheat [believers] into the garner (store [Heaven]); but he will burn up the chaff [unbelievers] with unquenchable (not stop) fire [Hell].



\*John the Baptist taught that God sees the Israelites as two different Peoples:

Believers (grain) and Unbelievers (chaff).
