[Acts] Lesson 12 Second Missionary Journey Continued

(Acts 17-18)

1. Paul Left Philippi.



(Acts 17:1) Paul, Silas, Timothy, and Luke went to **Thessalonica**.



2. Paul Preached in Thessalonica.



(Acts 17:2-4) First Paul went into a Jewish synagogue and taught them from the O.T. Bible about Jesus Christ/Gospel.



(Acts 17:4) Many in **Thessalonica** believed in Jesus.

*However, the unbelieving Jews attacked them and forced them out of

the city.



Paul later wrote two letters to the church in Thessalonica.





(Acts 17:10) Next they went to Berea.



3. Paul Preached in Berea.



(Acts 17:11-12) First they taught the Jews in the synagogue about Jesus.
*These Jews searched the O.T. Bible to see if Paul taught the truth. Many of them believed on Jesus. Also, many Greeks there believed on Jesus.



(Acts 17:13-14) The unbelieving Jews from **Thessalonica** came to **Berea** and attacked them again forcing them out of **Berea**.



(Acts 17:15) Paul first went to Athens.



4. Paul Taught in Athens.



(Acts 17:16-31) Paul saw many idols in **Athens**. They worshipped many different gods.



(Acts 17:16-31) Paul argued with both the Greek idolaters and with the Jews in the synagogue.





(Acts 17:16-31)

There were many different teachers and religions in **Athens**.

*Because Paul taught them about Jesus' resurrection from the dead, they thought Paul taught about some new, strange god.



(Acts 17:19-21) The leaders in **Athens** wanted to hear about Paul's new god (Jesus). They brough Paul to their famous Mars' hill the **Areopagus** (meeting place),



(Acts 17:22-31) Paul Preached:

- * You are very religious—many gods.
- You don't know the One True God.
- God Made all things.
- God gives life to all.



- God is Sovereign (King/controller) over all.
- God is near—You can know Him.
- God is not like idols.

(Acts 17:22-28) Paul Preached:

* God has been patient, but now commands all to repent.

• God sent His Son, Jesus, Who He raised from the dead. Jesus will judge all people.



(Acts 17:32-34) Some mocked Paul and the Gospel. They thought the teaching about Jesus' resurrection from the dead was foolish. *However, a few believed and Paul taught them more.

5. Paul Taught in Corinth.



(Acts 18:1, 8) Paul Went to Corinth.



(Acts 18:9-10) In **Corinth** many believed the Gospel and were

baptized.



* Jesus came to Paul in a dream and told him not to be afraid and to openly teach. Jesus said that there were many who would believe in **Corinth**. Paul teaches in Corinth for 1 year and 6 months (Acts 18:11)

And he (Paul) continued there a year and six months, **teaching the word of God among them**.



Paul later wrote two letters to the Corinthian church.



6. Paul Completed His Second Missionary Journey.



(Acts 18:19-21) Paul went to **Ephesus** and taught the Jews in the synagogue.



Later Paul wrote a letter to the church at Ephesus.



(Acts 18:21) Paul told the Ephesians that he would try to come again and teach them, but now he must hurry to Jerusalem.



(Acts 18:22) Paul went to **Jerusalem** and visited the church there. Then they went back to **Antioch**.
