



1. God Gave Clothes to Adam and Eve.

*They made their own clothes (leaves) to cover their nakedness / sin.




(Genesis 3:21)

*God did <u>NOT</u> accept (good) Adam and Eve's clothes (leaves) / works. Man's work is not good.

*God only accepts <u>God's work</u> (clothes of skin). Only God's work is good.

*All people try many different <u>own</u> works—not good.






*Animals need to die to give clothes (skins) to Adam and Eve.

*This was the first time they saw death.

*Death came because of Adam and Eve's sin.



God covered their shame / sin.


God did not quickly destroy them.


Mercy

God sent Adam and Eve out from the garden, away from the Tree of Life.




3. God Removed the Blessing of the Garden from Adam and Eve.

God put an angel to stop Adam and Eve from entering the Garden.




4. God Gives Life.


(Genesis 4:1)
