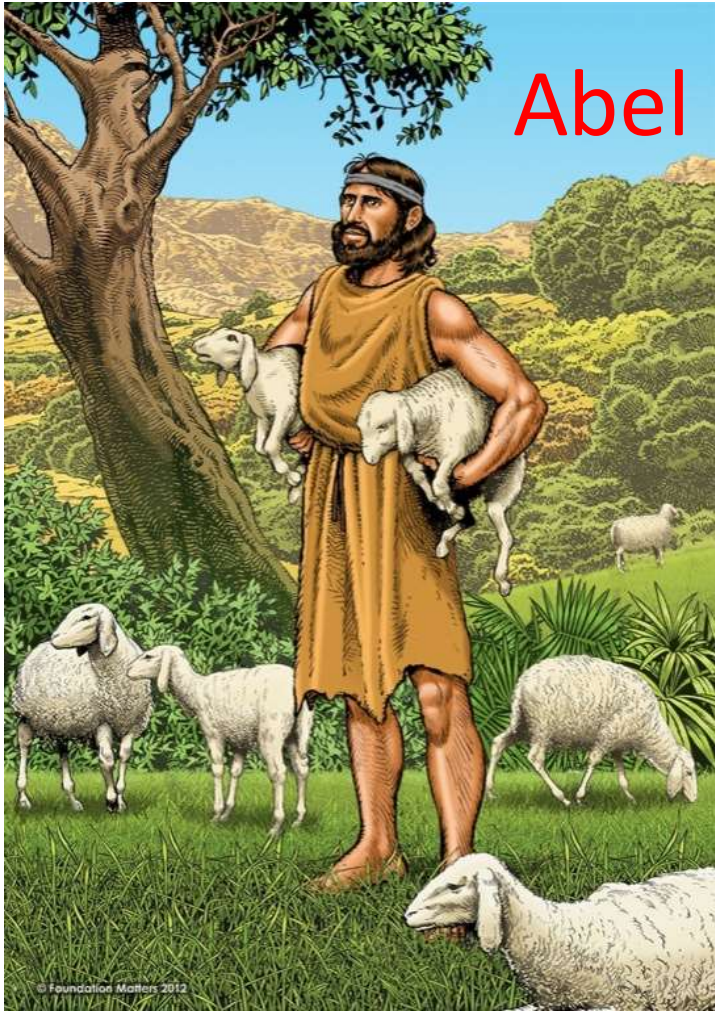
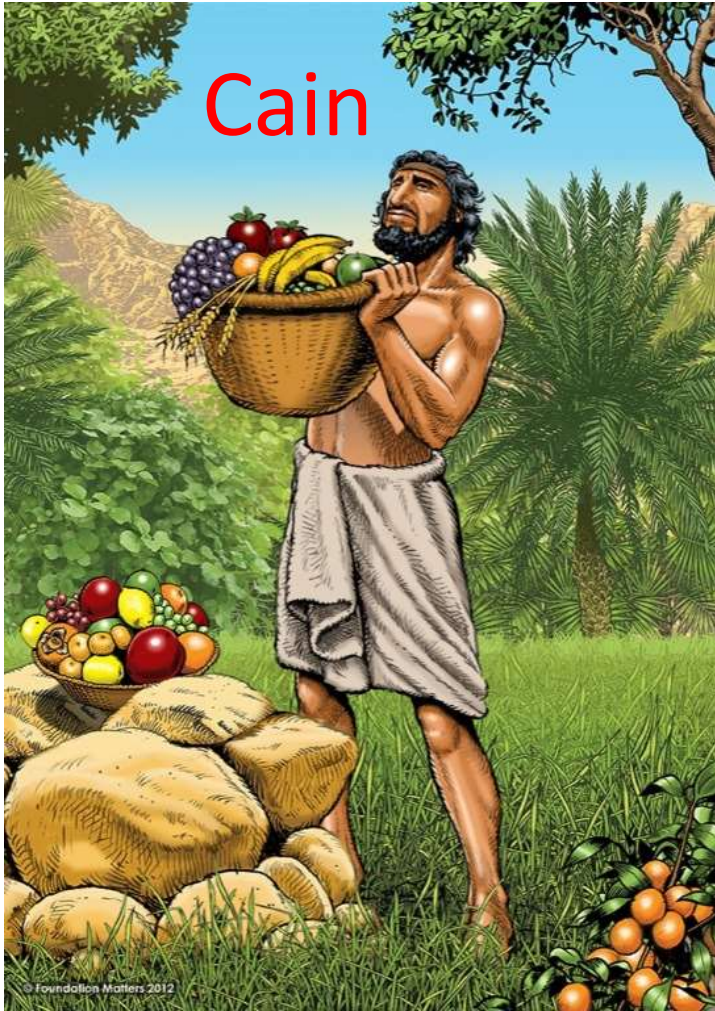

God Accepted (**good**) Abel's Offering (**gift**)



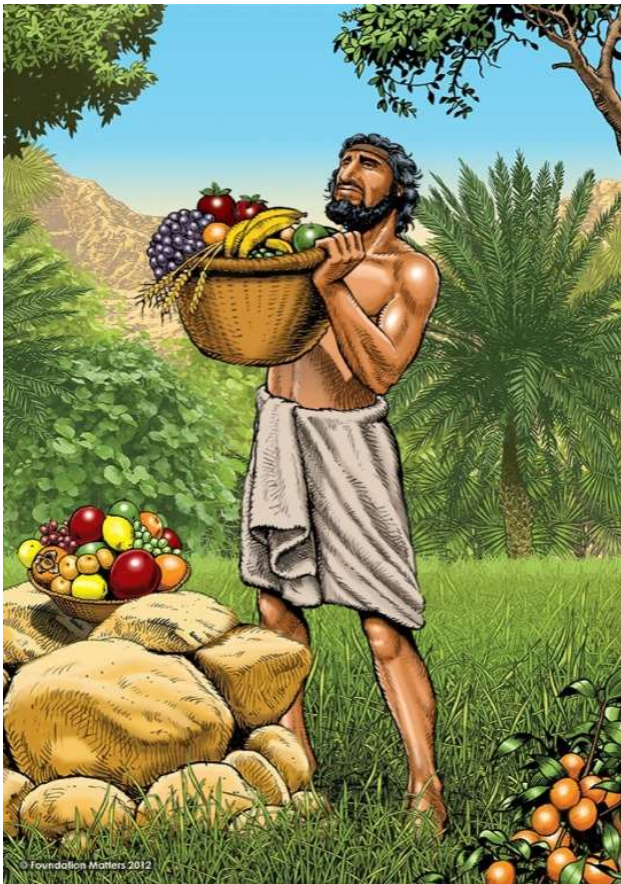
# 1. Cain and Abel Gave Offerings to God.



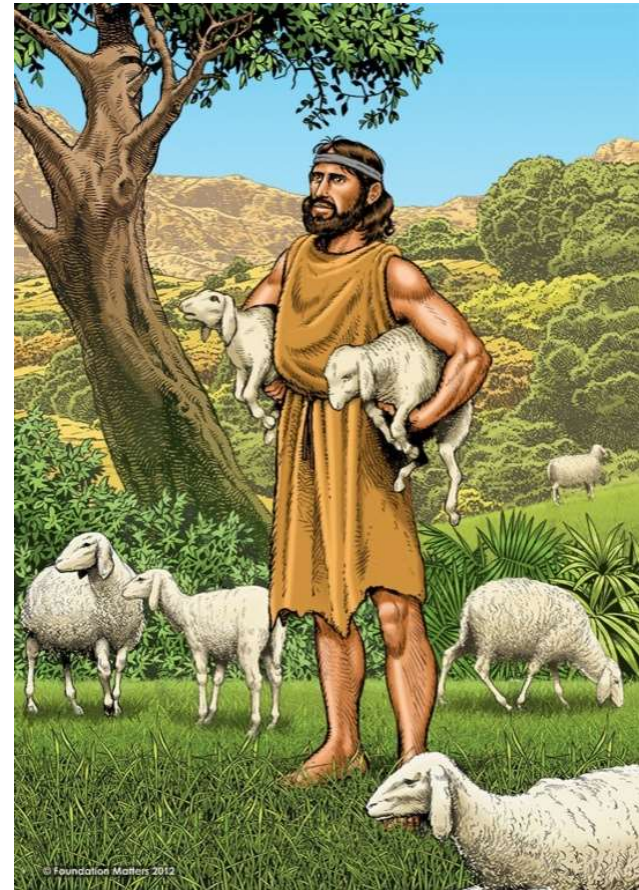


(Genesis 4:3-4)

Cain gave fruit.

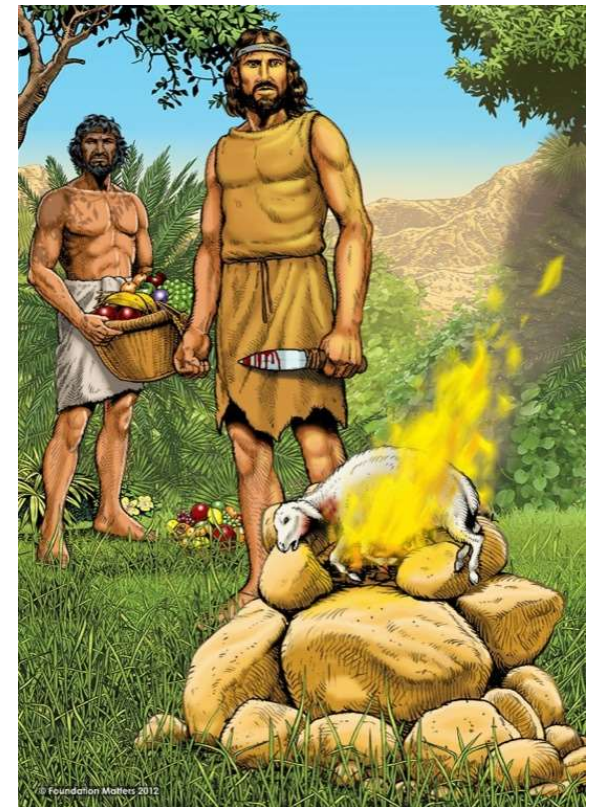
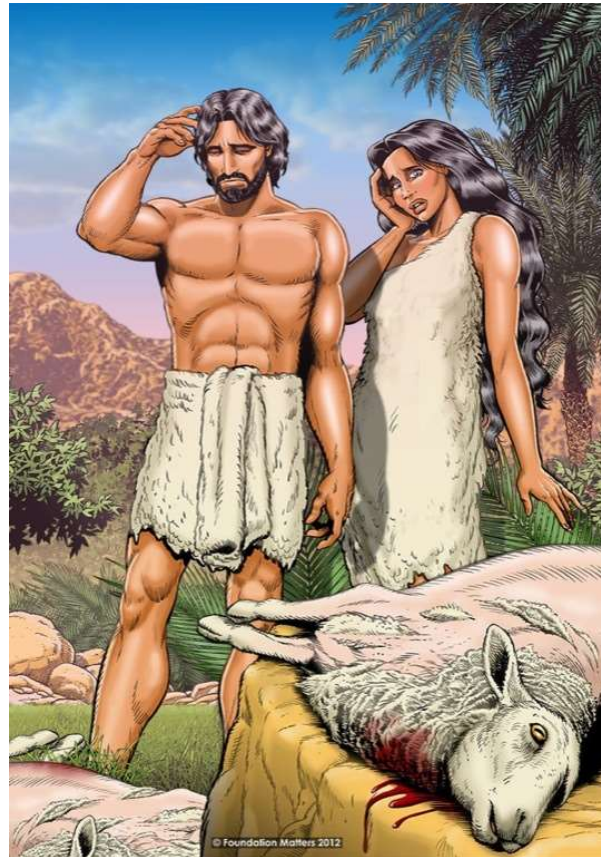


Abel gave sheep.



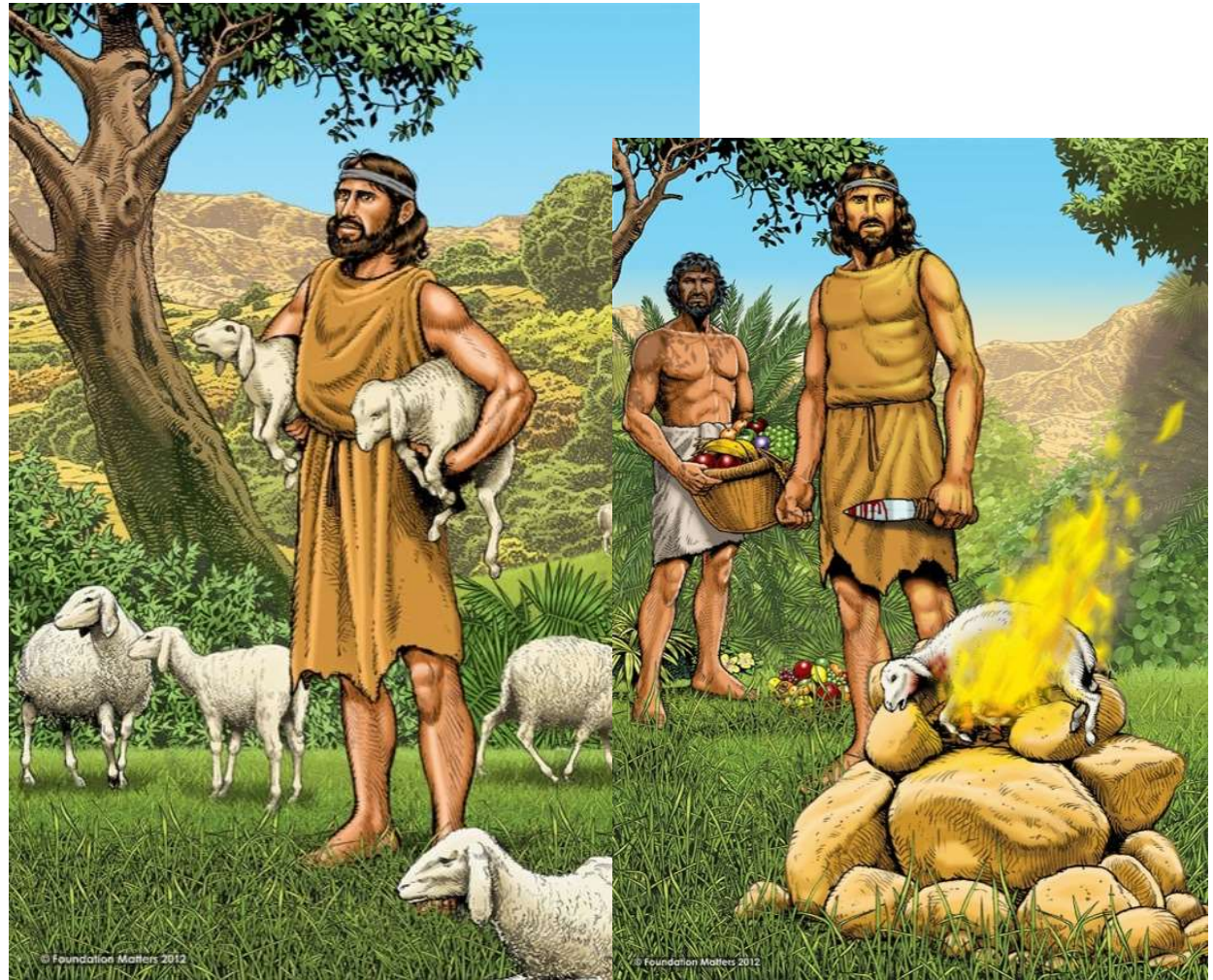
(Gen. 3:21; Lev. 17:11, Heb. 9:22)

God commanded sheep must be **killed and offered to God**, then you can come to God.





## 2. God Accepted (**good**) Abel's Offering.

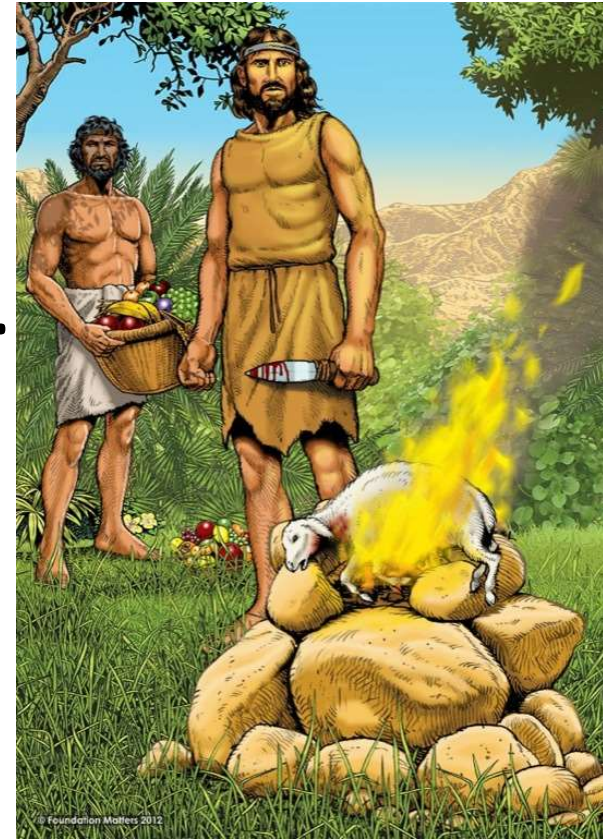


(Gen. 4:4, Heb. 11:6, Rom. 10:17, 14:23)

**Faith** that God accepts (**good faith**) is **obeying** God's Word / Command.

**Abel obeyed** God's Word / Command.

**Faith** in God = I believe God is right and true.





(Ezekiel 18:20)

The blood of animals could not cover sins.

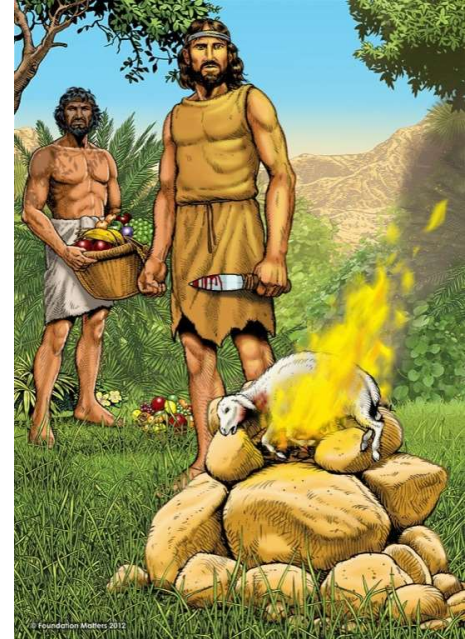
(Romans 6:23)

The punishment for sins is  
the death of the sinner.

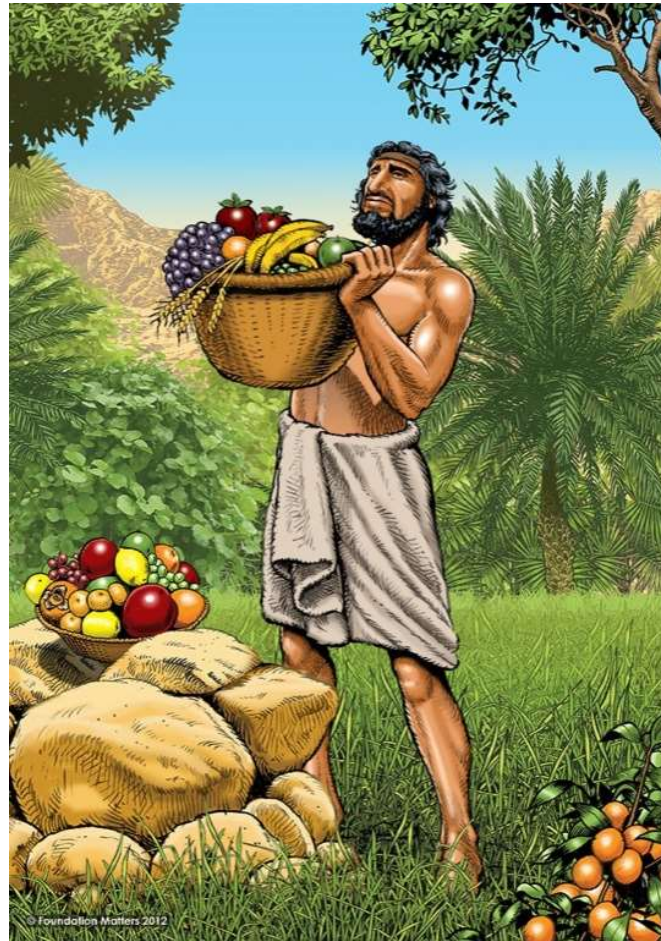
Abel trusted not Abel; Abel trusted God...

God promised to send Jesus to cover all sins.

Offering sheep showed later Jesus offering on Cross.



### 3. God Rejected (no good) Cain's Offering (gift).





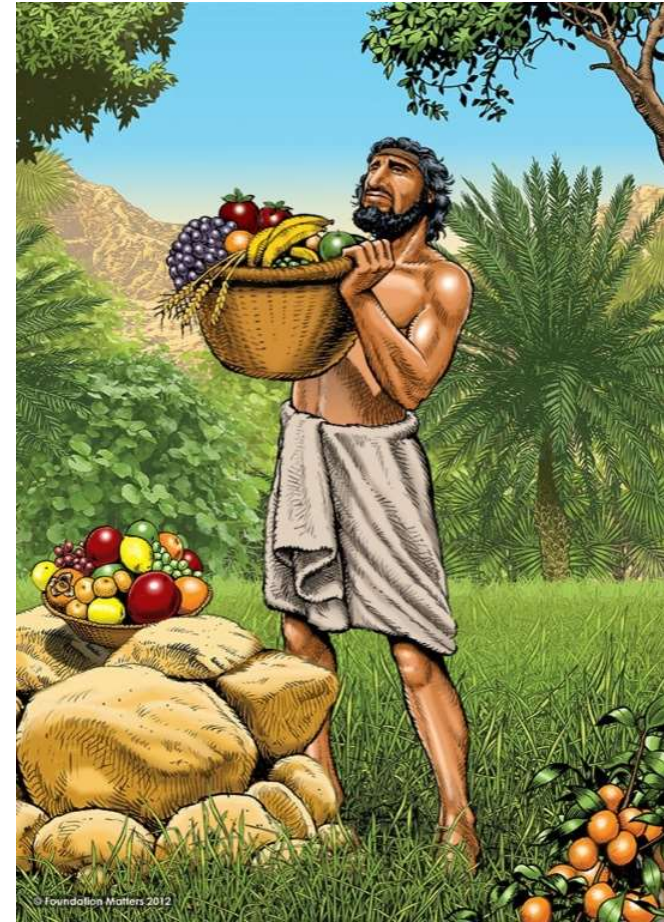
(Gen. 4:3; Heb. 11:4)

\*Cain did not bring the blood of a sheep.

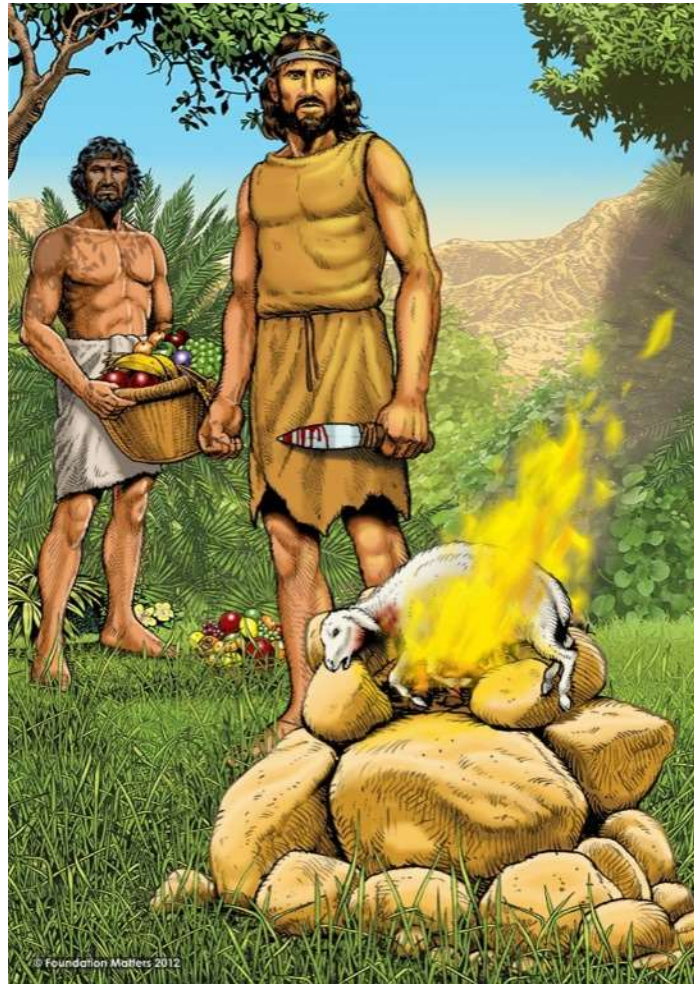
Because Cain did NOT believe God,  
Cain did NOT obey God.

\*Cain trusted his way / idea  
for salvation.

Cain did not trust God's way  
for salvation.



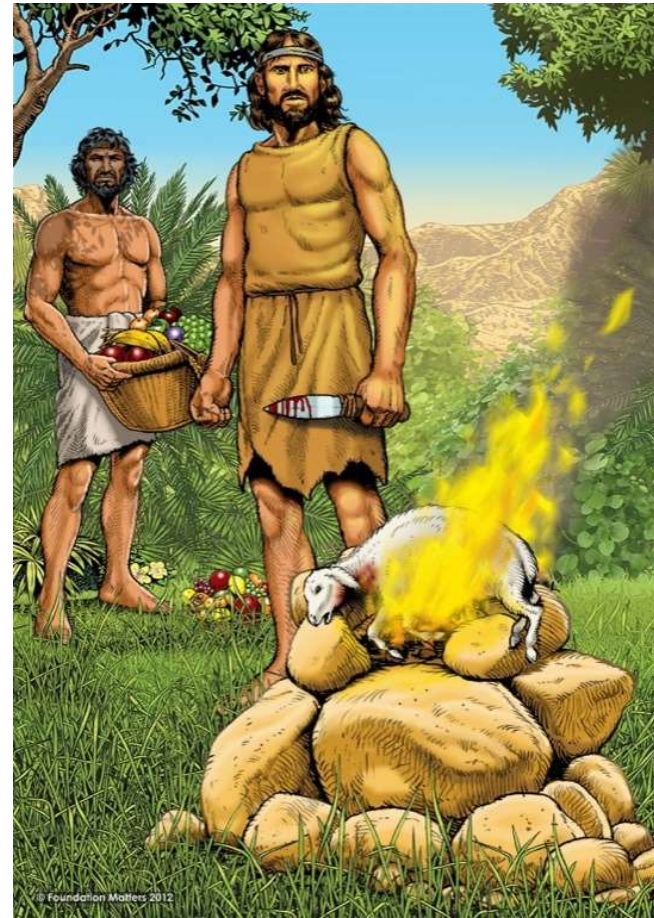
## 4. Cain Refused (no) to Obey God.





(Genesis 4:5-7)

God talked with Cain and tried to help Cain because of God's grace and mercy.



(Genesis 4:8)

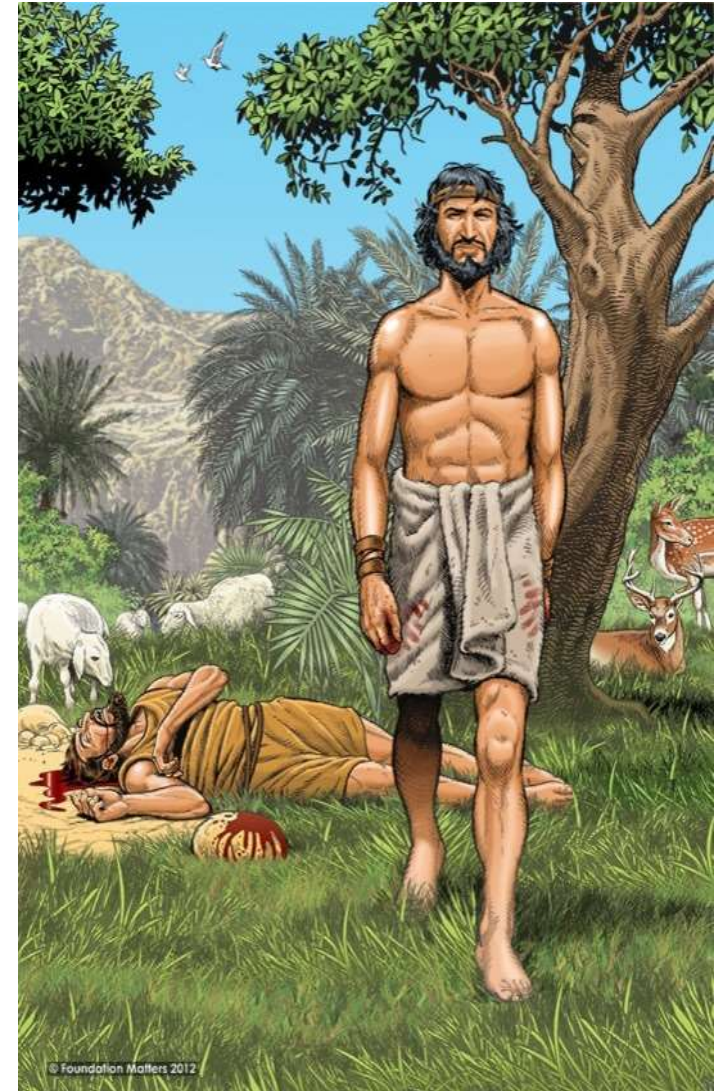
Cain did not want to obey God.

(John 8:44; 1 John 3:12)

Cain was like Satan.

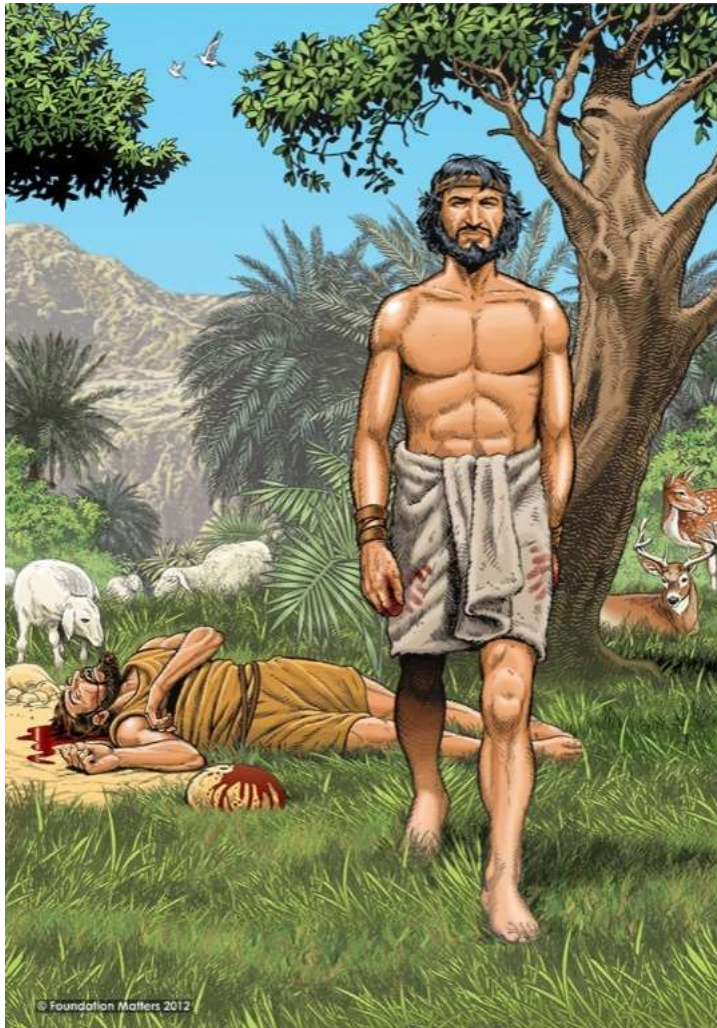
Cain killed his brother, Abel.

Satan wants to destroy all things  
that God loves (all people...  
Adam and Eve, Cain and Abel.





## 5. God Punished Cain for Killing Abel.

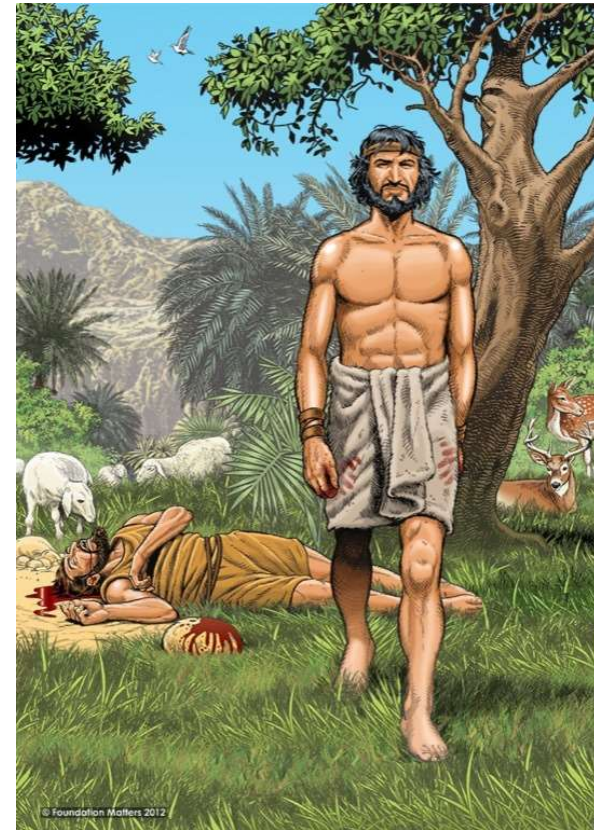


(Genesis 4:9)

God questioned Cain giving him a time to say “sorry” and repent (**change**).

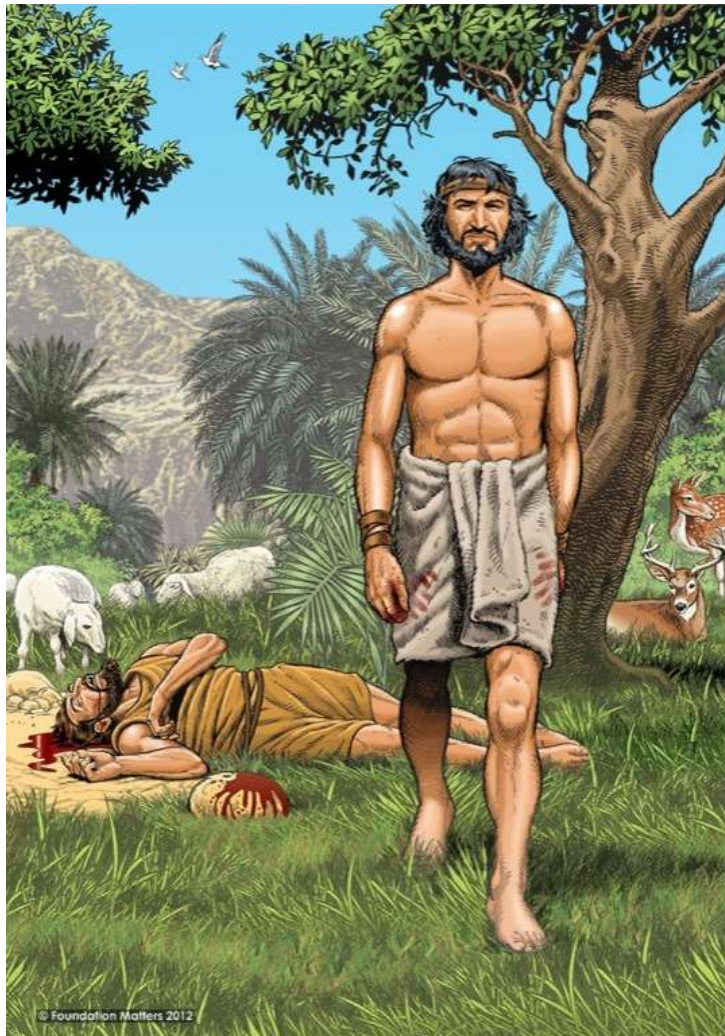
(Genesis 4:10-16)

Cain did not repent. When Cain died, Cain was separated from God eternally in Hell.

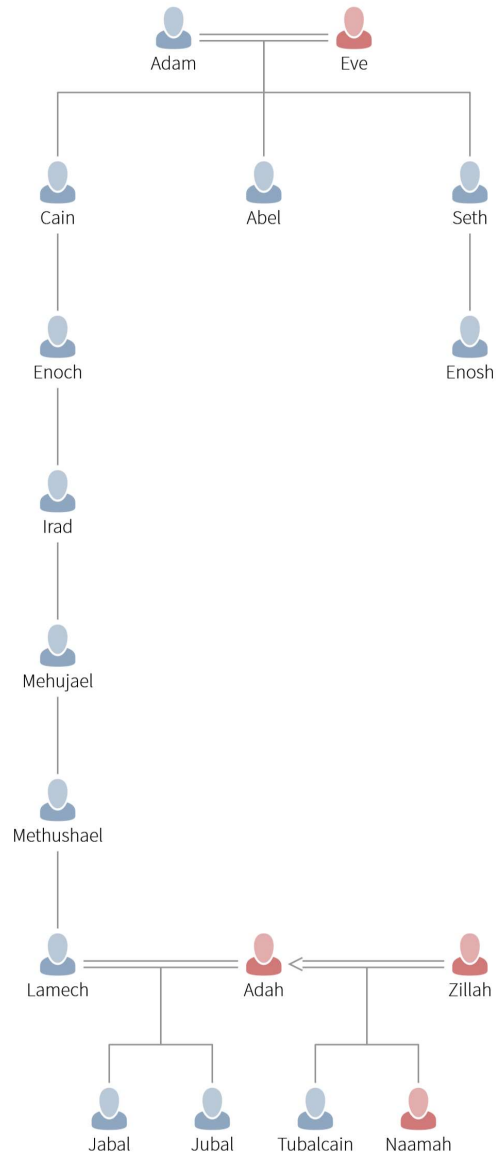

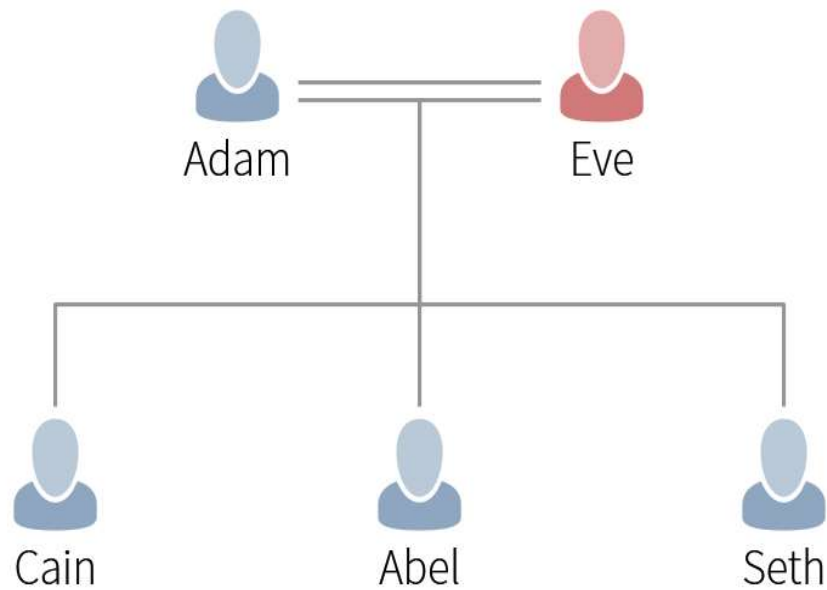

## 7. God Gave Seth (Adam and Eve's new son).





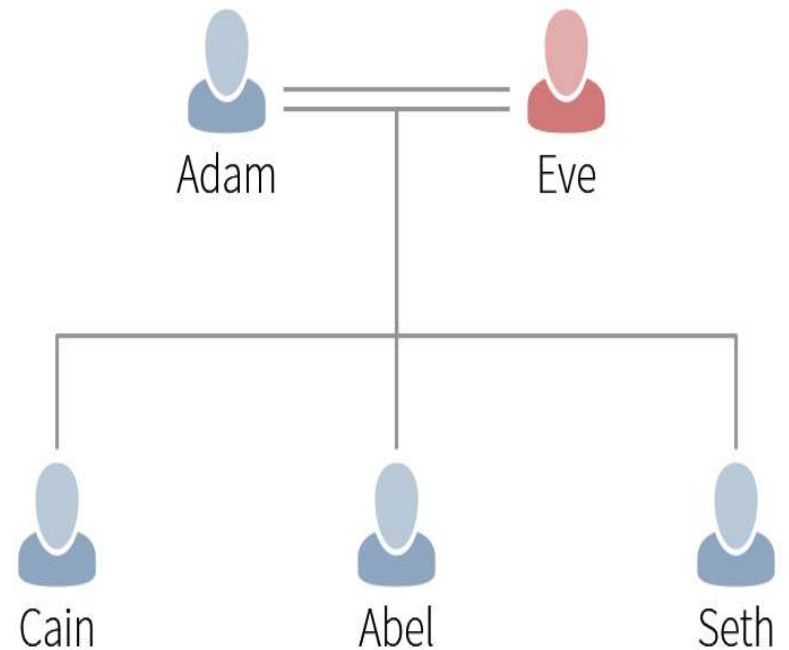
(Genesis 4:25)

\*God gave Adam and Eve another son, Seth.

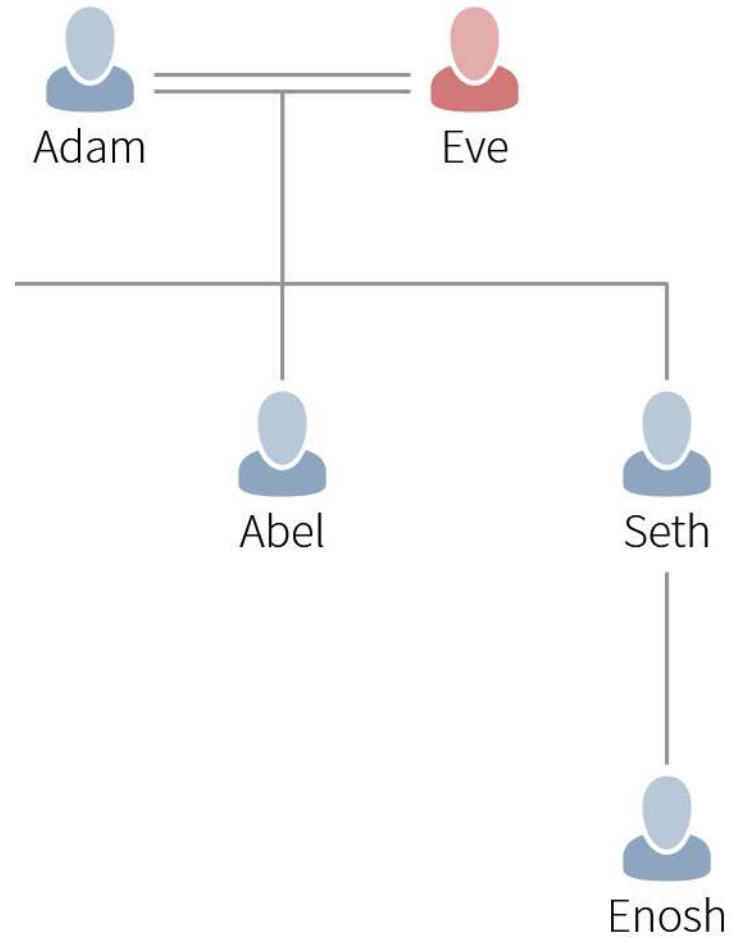
Seth believed God.

## 8. Seth's Son Was Enos(h). Many People Believed God.



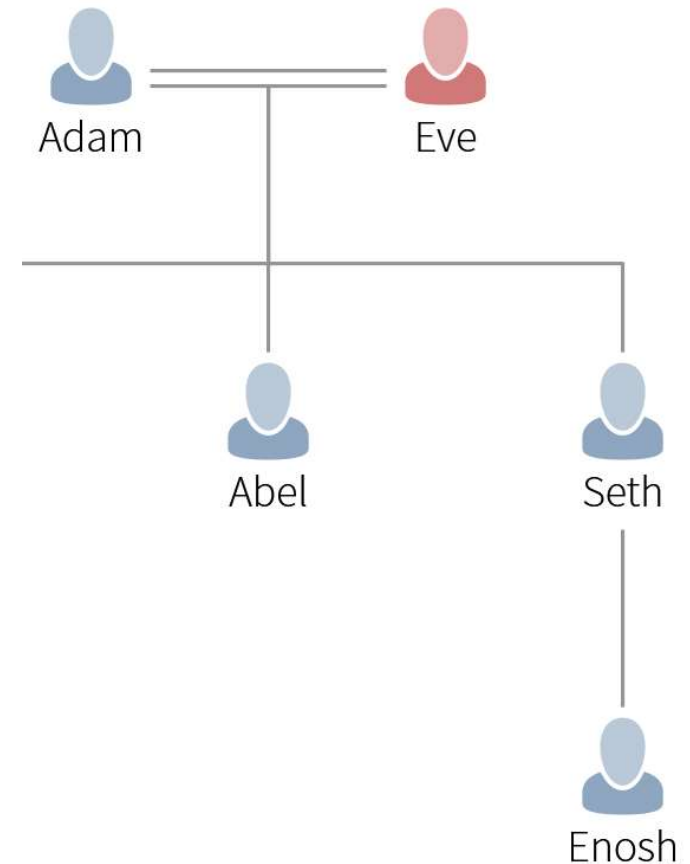


(Genesis 4:26)

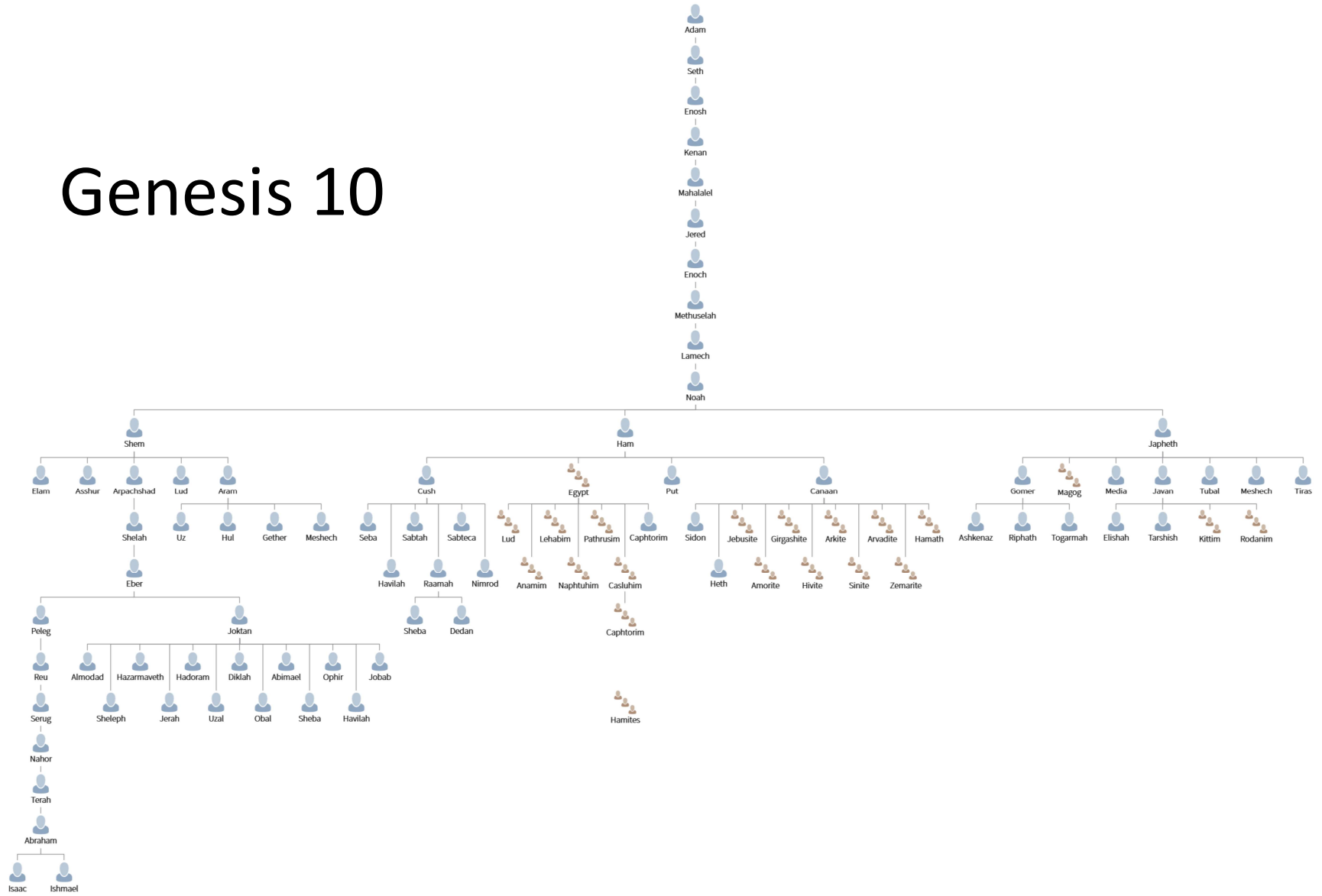
\***Seth** had a **son** named **Enos**.
