

God's Wisdom Vs. World's Wisdom (1 Corinthian 1:19-31)


## 1. God Makes Foolish the World's Wisdom.




(1 Corinthians 1:19) For it is written, I (God) will destroy the wisdom of the wise [world], and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent (smart) [world]. (20) Where is the wise? where is the scribe (teacher [Jew])? where is the disputer (arguing person [Greek]) of this world? hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?


Where? = What happened? "made foolish" = show it is worthless (no good) or lacking (not have/missing).

#### God made foolish Cain's wisdom.




#### God made foolish Tower of Babel wisdom.






God made foolish Josephs brother's wisdom.

(Genesis 11:4)




# God made foolish Egypt's wisdom.

#### 2. God Saves People By Easy <u>Faith</u> in His Easy <u>Word</u>.

(World thinks: *Easy = foolish [worthless/lacking]*)



(1 Corinthians 1:21) For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased (happy) God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

- \*God's wise/good plan to save people.
- \*Man's ideas cannot give eternal life.
- \*Teaching the Bible can give eternal life.

Faith in God's Word is most easy.

(1 Corinthians 1:22) For the Jews require (must) a sign [proof from Heaven—angel/power], and the Greeks seek after wisdom [good idea/arguing good]: (23) But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock (fall over stone), and unto the Greeks foolishness;

\*God let His Son die = not a sign to Jews.

\*God let His Son die = not good idea to Greeks.

\*Paul only preached the Gospel—same for us.

### God only gave Noah/people His **Word**; God gave no **sign** or **argument**.

(Genesis 6:13-18)



(1 Corinthians 1:24) But unto them which are called (give job/office [become Christian]), both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God.

\*God's wise and powerful plan to save believers from the power of Satan, sin, and death.



(1 Corinthians 1:25) Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

\*Proud men think it is foolish that

God would let His enemies kill His Son.

\*\*But the death of the Son of God was the only way to save sinners from eternal death.

\*Jesus on the cross looked weak to mockers. [Mark 15:29-32]

\*\*But God was in control providing salvation for all the world.

#### 3. God Chose Weak and Simple People to Shame the Powerful and Proud.



(1 Corinthians 1:26) For ye see your calling (give job/office [become Christian]), brethren, how that not many wise men after the flesh (world's wisdom), not many mighty [king...], not many noble (respected person), are called:



(1 Corinthians 1:27) But God hath chosen
[God's plan] the foolish (worthless/lacking)
things of the world to confound (shame)
the wise; and God hath chosen the
weak things of the world to confound
(shame) the things which are mighty;


[Acts 4:10-13] God chose to use uneducated fishermen to put

to shame the proud religious leaders.

(1 Corinthians 1:28) And base (low/poor) things of the world, and things which are despised (hated), hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not (nothing/worthless), to bring to nought (nothing/worthless) things that are [great]: (29) That no flesh (people) should glory in his (God's) presence.

\*God must receive 100% glory.

#### 4. Jesus Is All We Need.



(1 Corinthians 1:30) But of him (God) are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:

- \*With Jesus, we can think right. [Eph. 5:17-18; Rom. 12:1-2]
- \*With Jesus, we are declared right [Rom. 5:1; 8:1].
- \*With Jesus, we can serve God. [Rom. 6:11-13]
- \* With Jesus, we are free from sin and death. [Eph. 6:17]

(1 Corinthians 1:31) That, according as it is written, He that glorieth (show great/good), let him glory in the Lord.

\*God must receive 100% glory.

\*\*We should not boast (glory) in ourselves, our church, or any man; all our boasting (glory) should be in God and His work—the Cross of Christ.
